Composition

The learner communicates opinions on the proposal to ban the sale of meat and fish in the canteen with consistent clarity. The piece is effective for audience and purpose, balancing strongly held views with some acknowledgment that there are valid counterarguments. It is concisely expressed with appropriate detail included. For Composition, the first bullet point in the mark band determines the mark given and so a top band mark (7-9 for the shorter Task 2) is awarded.

Consideration is then given to the other three bullet points to determine whether the piece merits 7, 8 or 9 marks. How well does the learner handle format, structure, cohesion and paragraphing, as well as register, sentence and vocabulary range?

The piece is clearly structured and cohesive. There are no specific formatting requirements for an online feedback form, though name has helpfully been given. There is a wide, if not extensive, range of vocabulary and various sentence types are used accurately and sometimes effectively. Paragraphing is accurate. The level of formality is appropriate, though tone occasionally tilts towards the hectoring. A mark at the bottom of the top band is merited.
