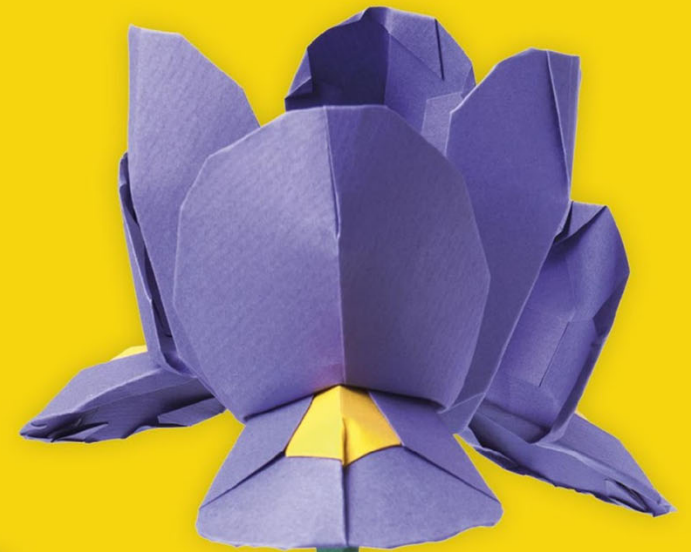

These two photos are organised and disorganised. I opened a few drawers to look disordered and all closed for ordered. Changed the contrast.

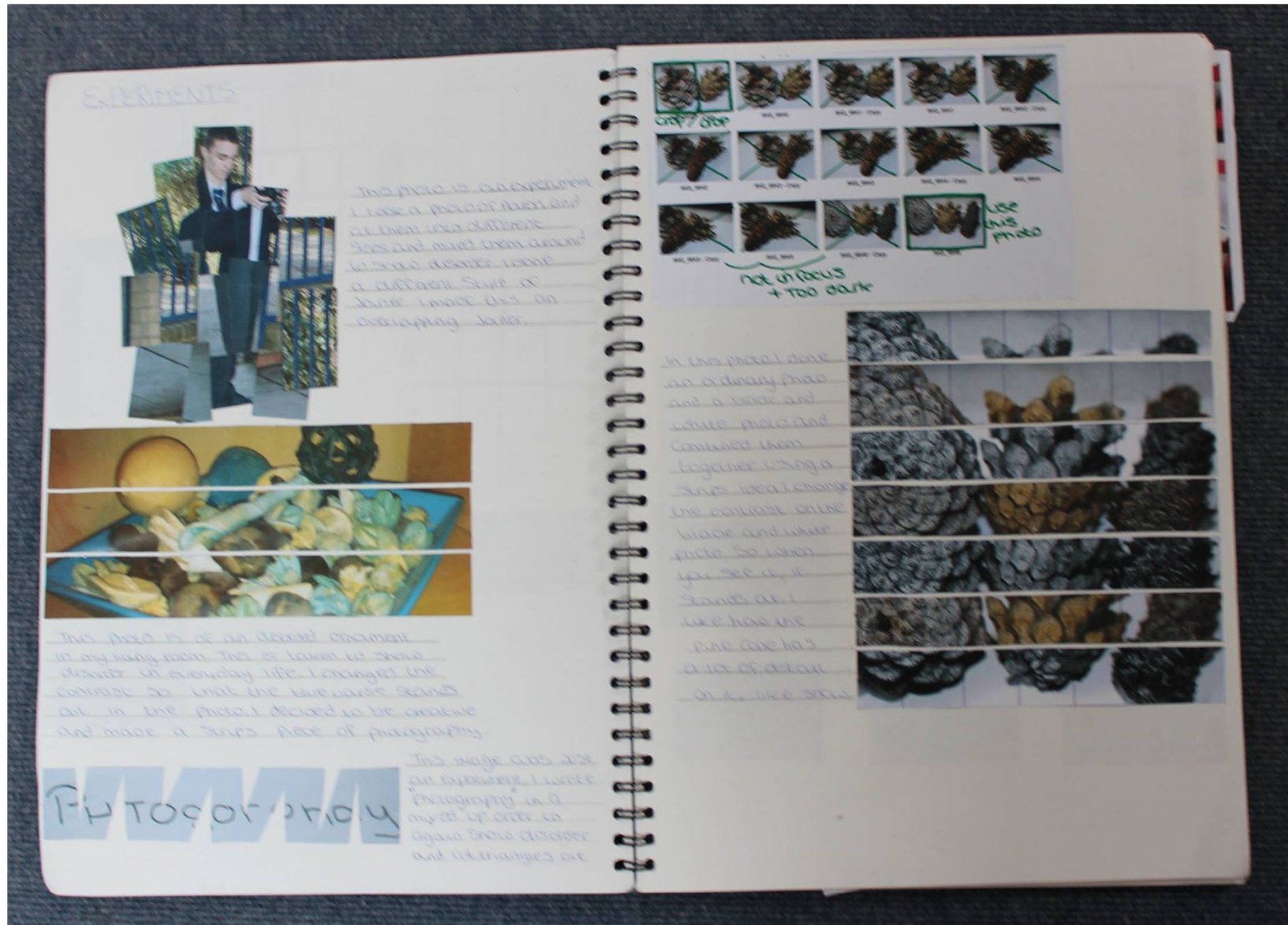
I changed the situation right down to black and white and changed the contrast to make it darker. ordered the books and mixed the around in size.

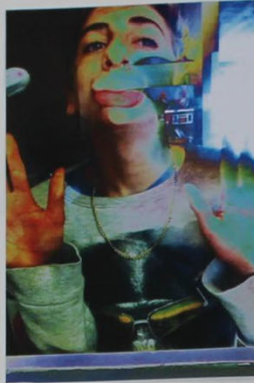




## EXPERIMENTS

This is my favourite photo because it has so much detail along with colour. It is related to my artist because his face is all disordered.



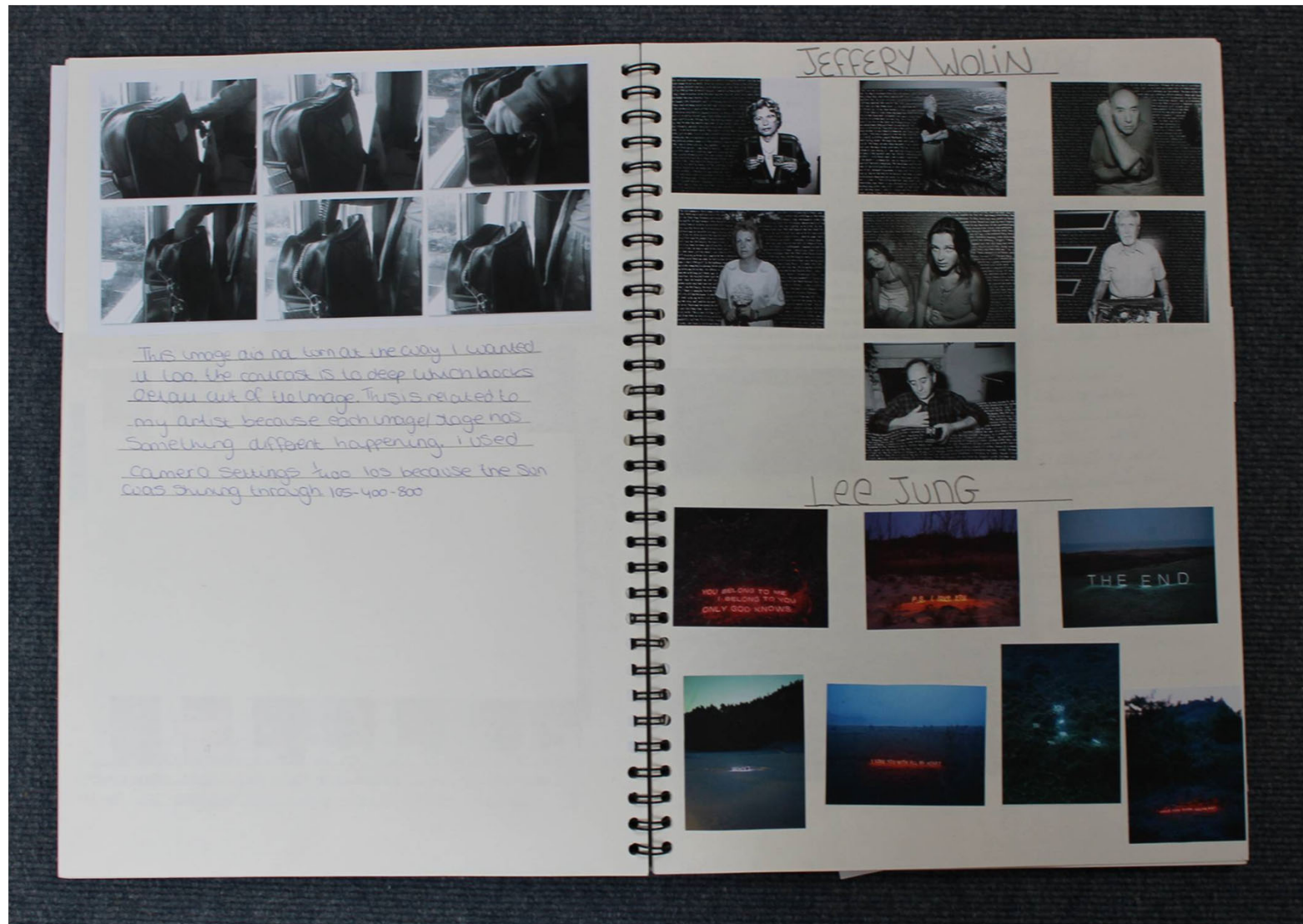
This photo stands out because the contrast is so deep and has plenty of detail. This image is aimed to catch the audience eye.
