







Level 4 and 5 Higher Nationals Under Licence

Licensed Higher Nationals allow Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) with degree-awarding powers, such as Universities, to award their own HNCs and HNDs. Licensed Higher National partners have responsibilities for the quality assurance of their own Licensed Higher National programme.

HEIs wishing to offer Licensed Higher Nationals must first be approved by the Licensed HN Partnerships Manager. This approval process is different from the regular Pearson BTEC Higher National centre approval or programme approval.

There are two licences:

The **Trademark** licence allows the licensed partner to award the HNC and HND in its own name, using their own naming conventions and curriculum. The fees on the next page include the discounted price that HEIs pay.

The Intellectual Property licence allows the licensed partner to award the HNC or HND in its own name, using the programme and curriculum content of the Pearson Higher National programme. This is available for both Higher Nationals RQF and Higher Technical Qualifications. The fees on the next page include the discounted price that HEIs pay.

Top-up fees & drop-down refunds for 2023/24

Top-Up

A top-up fee is charged when a learner who has completed a qualification and received a certificate wants to extend this to a larger qualification from the same specification.

Please note the below fees are calculated on the basis that both the initial and the top up registrations are processed in the 2023/24 price list year (1 August 2023 - 31 July 2024).

Drop-down refunds

Pearson provides a refund to those centres who have had learners move to, and complete, a shorter (BTEC) qualification of the same subject and level. The refund due is calculated as the difference between the cost of the larger and smaller qualification, minus an administration fee of 50% of the difference. The administration fee is capped at £26.15.



BTEC registration fees, timelines and refunds

Late Registration Fees

For programmes following the academic year cycle, late registration fees will be charged according to the dates below:

- Registrations received between 16 November 2023 and 23
 December 2023 will be charged at 1.05 x fee.
- Registrations received between 24 December 2023 and 31 January 2024 will be charged at 1.1 x fee.
- Registrations received on or after **1 February 2024** will be charged at 1.25 x fee.

For programmes that do not follow the academic year (i.e., programmes where learners have enrolled between November and August), or for any programmes of less than one academic year in length, late registration fees will be charged four (4) weeks after enrolment at 1.25 x fee for all qualifications.

Pearson reserves the right to make additional quality assurance checks (at the customer's cost), if the volume of late registrations is abnormally high.

Deletions

Deletions for all Higher Nationals, regardless of whether your programme follows an academic year, *must be made* within 49 days of the student starting the programme of study (not from the date of registration). Any deletions made 50 days or more after the student's start date will not be eligible for a full refund.



FAQs and centre fees

Are these fees final?

Fees are not likely to change during the period covered by this document (August 2023 – July 2024). As new products are launched, the Fee Booklet will be updated. Please check our website for the latest updates.

What to do in the event of transfers?

A transfer is where the learner transfers their registration from one qualification to another before they have been certificated for the original qualification. No additional fee will be due where the fee for the new programme at the time of registration is the same as that paid for the original registration. Where the fee for the new programme is higher than that paid for the original registration, an invoice for the difference between the two fees will be issued.
