#### **Purpose**

BTEC Level 2 Technicals Age 16+ learners

## **Purpose**

BTEC Level 2 Technicals are practical, hands-on qualifications designed to help your post-16 learners master the industry-specific skills, knowledge and professional behaviours they will need to start and succeed in their careers.

They can be taught as part of a full-time 16-19 study programme alongside other qualifications such as GCSES or as the technical qualification within an apprenticeship or employment.

#### **Progression**

- Further technical study at Level 3 such as BTEC Level 3 Nationals
- Apprenticeship
- Employment

BTEC Nationals Age 16+ learners

## **Purpose**

BTEC Level 3 Nationals are career-based qualifications designed to give learners the skills and practical knowledge they need to move on to higher education or go straight into employment.

They can be taught alongside other level 3 qualifications as part of a wider programme of study or as the main focus of study over two years.

- Higher education
- Apprenticeship
- Employment

BTEC Higher Nationals Age 18+ learners

## **Purpose**

Level 4 BTEC Higher Nationals Certificates (HNCs) and Level 5 BTEC Higher National Diplomas (HNDs) are professional, technical higher education qualifications, and offer specialist vocational pathways.

They are designed to equip learners with the professional skills, techniques and personal attributes they will need for the future.

## **Progression**

- Level 4 HNC students can progress to further study at Level 5
- Level 5 HND students could progress to a higher education degree course
