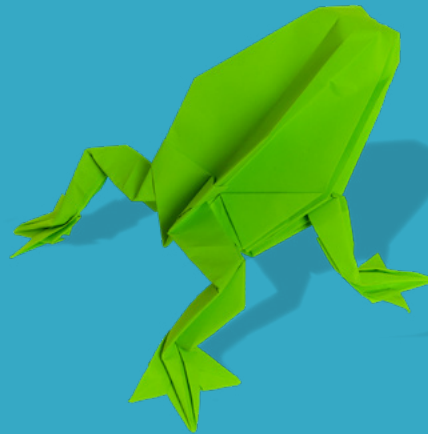
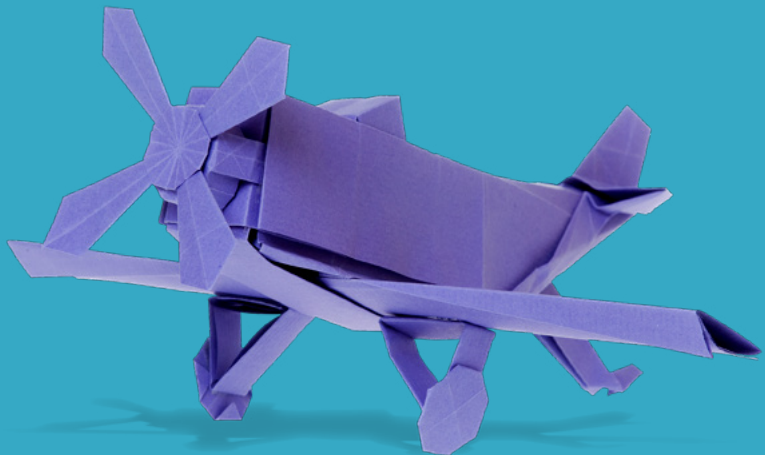

A famous scientist I admire is Alexander Fleming who discovered penicillin in 1928. This led to the development of antibiotics which have saved millions of lives.

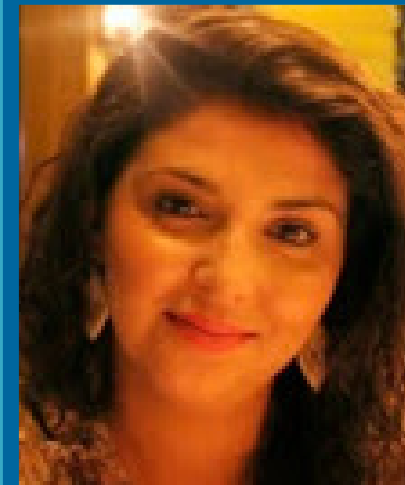
Stephen Nugus
