

How to order Edexcel anthologies for English qualifications

Any anthologies not listed here are download only, or published texts such as 'Poems of the Decade', purchasable from booksellers.

Order on the Pearson stationery website: https://pearson-exam-stationery.com/

The access code is KEHSY.

Please note, the stationery website requires a login that is different to any of your other Pearson logins. When you access the site for the first time, set up a new login.

Please note, students do not need clean copies of any of these anthologies in exams.

The anthologies are provided free of charge, one per student with an entry for the relevant qualification.

The following anthologies are available:

- GCSE English Literature (1ETO) poetry anthology
- International GCSE 9-1 anthology for English Language specification A and English Literature (issue 7).

Pease note, if you have a stock of issue 5 or issue 6 anthologies, there is no need to order issue 7 anthologies. You should only order new hard copy anthologies when you have used up your issue 4, 5s or 6s. All hard copies ordered will be issue 6 until existing stocks are exhausted. There are no content changes to issue 7 other than in some introductory text. Issue 7 has a pink front cover on the stationery website. The pink anthology is for both linear and modular routes.

- Shakespeare critical anthologies (comedy or tragedy) for A level English Literature
- Voices in Speech and Writing anthology for A level English Language and Literature.

Delivery usually takes one to two weeks to UK destinations.

Please note that all the poetry anthologies for A level English Literature/A level English Language and Literature and for IAL English Literature are published texts, purchased from booksellers.
