


Progression in assessment from the new Edexcel GCSE (9-1)* to A level

The mark schemes for the new Edexcel History GCSE* and the new Edexcel History AS/A level have descriptions of performance separated into 'traits', with progress for individual traits building across the levels. Here we show how the mark schemes for AO1 and AO2 at GCSE build into the AO1 mark scheme for AS and A level.



In the new GCSE, marks for spelling, punctuation and grammar are awarded separately.

For A level, there is also a fourth trait relating to organisation and communication of argument, not shown in this table.
