AS level Further Mathematics

<p>Paper 1: Core Pure Mathematics 50% 1 hour 40 mins, 80 marks</p>	<p>Compulsory AS further mathematics content</p>
<p>Paper 2: Further Mathematics Options 50% 1 hour 40 mins, 80 marks</p>	<p>Students take one paper (made out of two sections) with two of the following four options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Further Pure Mathematics • Further Statistics • Further Mechanics • Decision Mathematics

A level Further Mathematics

<p>Paper 1: Core Pure Mathematics 1 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 75 marks</p>	<p>Compulsory</p> <p>Any further pure mathematics content can be assessed on either paper</p>
<p>Paper 2: Core Pure Mathematics 2 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 75 marks</p>	
<p>Paper 3: Further Mathematics Option 1 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 75 marks</p>	<p>Students take two optional papers with options available in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Further Pure Mathematics • Further Statistics • Further Mechanics • Decision Mathematics
<p>Paper 4: Further Mathematics Option 2 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 75 marks</p>	

AS and A level Further Mathematics options

For Paper 2 in AS and Paper 3 in A level Further Mathematics students choose a pair of options, either

- ✓ any two from column A, or
- ✓ a matching pair from columns A and B
