# Athletics

- Weaknesses in structure
- Lacking in accuracy and detail
- Limited technical language
- Lacking research
- Explanations weak



# Netball

- Sound structure throughout
- Some knowledge demonstrated
- Strengths and weaknesses identified
- Some good descriptive work but more analysis needed
- Lacks depth and detail
- More research needed



# Basketball

- Sound structure
- Some accurate work
- Limited research and data
- Mainly descriptive
- Basic level of analysis
- Lacking depth and detail overall



# Cycling

- Well-structured throughout
- Extensive use of data
- Advanced sport specific knowledge
- Input from coach to underpin key points
- Very good understanding of personal strengths and weaknesses
- Excellent descriptive work but less depth in analysis



# Swimming

- Well-structured throughout
- Extensive use of research
- Technical language used throughout
- Carefully referenced
- Detailed descriptions underpinned by thorough analysis
- Marginally over the word limit





# Summary

- The work shows work of varying standards
- Best work includes evidence of contemporary research, uses technical language and offers detailed analysis
- Candidates who score less well fail to provide evidence and focus on descriptive work
- Higher scoring candidates more fully justify conclusions
- Weaker work lacks detail and depth
