

Jewish responses believe that Jewish children should be educated in Jewish schools as secular schools may influence their opinions. However, this is criticised as this can result in the children feeling very alienated and may not want to ~~continuing~~ continue pursuing Judaism. Reform and Conservative Jewish responses may argue that Jewish people may have to adapt their beliefs to the society they are in to avoid anti-Semitism. It is also argued that in modern secular Judaism that they should believe in the communities that they are in rather than believing in God, which this can be argued to be an in-between between strict Jewish views and secular views.

Tikkun Olam means to repair the world. Some Jewish responses believe tikkun olam is a way to challenge secularisation as ~~be~~ by doing imitatio dei meaning to walk in God's way may



influence others to convert to judaism.
