

Scope of work lists

These lists have been created in 2024 with a view to making the qualification even more inclusive and supporting teachers looking for resources for works beyond the traditional canon. These lists are not exhaustive. They are designed to suggest a range of sources to inspire students. The original lists produced in 2017 at the beginning of this specification remain valid. Given the huge range of global work available, only a tiny selection of works can be cited here. For the most part, these have been selected because there are freely accessible materials to support teaching and learning.

Smart History (<u>www.smarthistory.org</u>) is an online source with a huge number of short videos and articles which are ideal for teachers to share with students during lessons.

Art History in Schools (www.arthistoryinschools.org.uk) is another source of freely available material written by teachers to support this A Level.

The **Pearson A Level mark schemes** also contain a huge amount of relevant material and these have been cited with the appropriate year of examination <u>here</u>.

Resource links were checked at the time of going to press, but should also be easily accessed by entering the name of the work/ artist into any search engine.

As always, teaching and learning needs to focus on the selection and discussion of relevant parts of the work to suit the investigation required by the specification. Examination questions will always require a student to select and explore the significance of specific information or choices, not merely to regurgitate a list of general facts.
