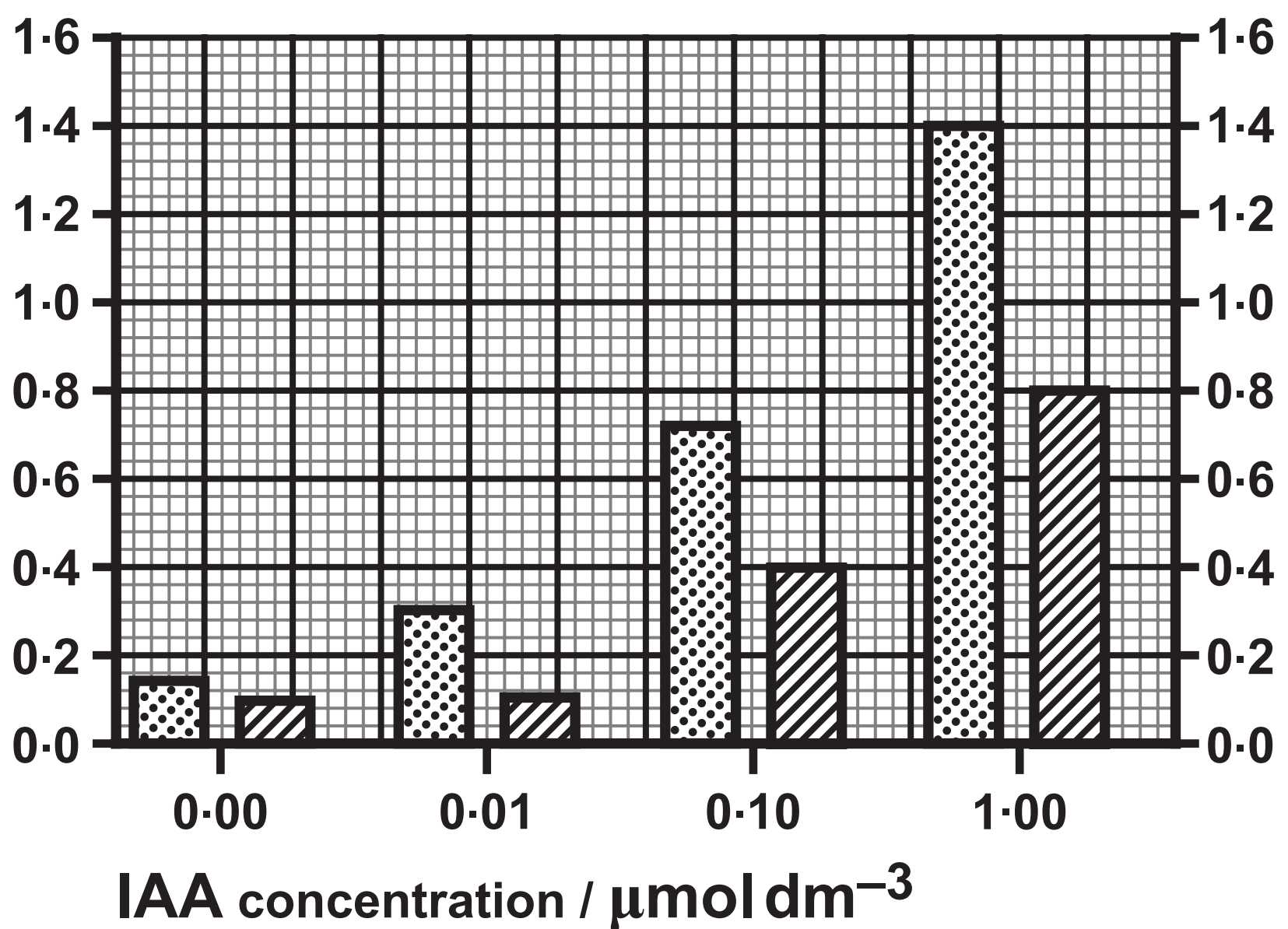

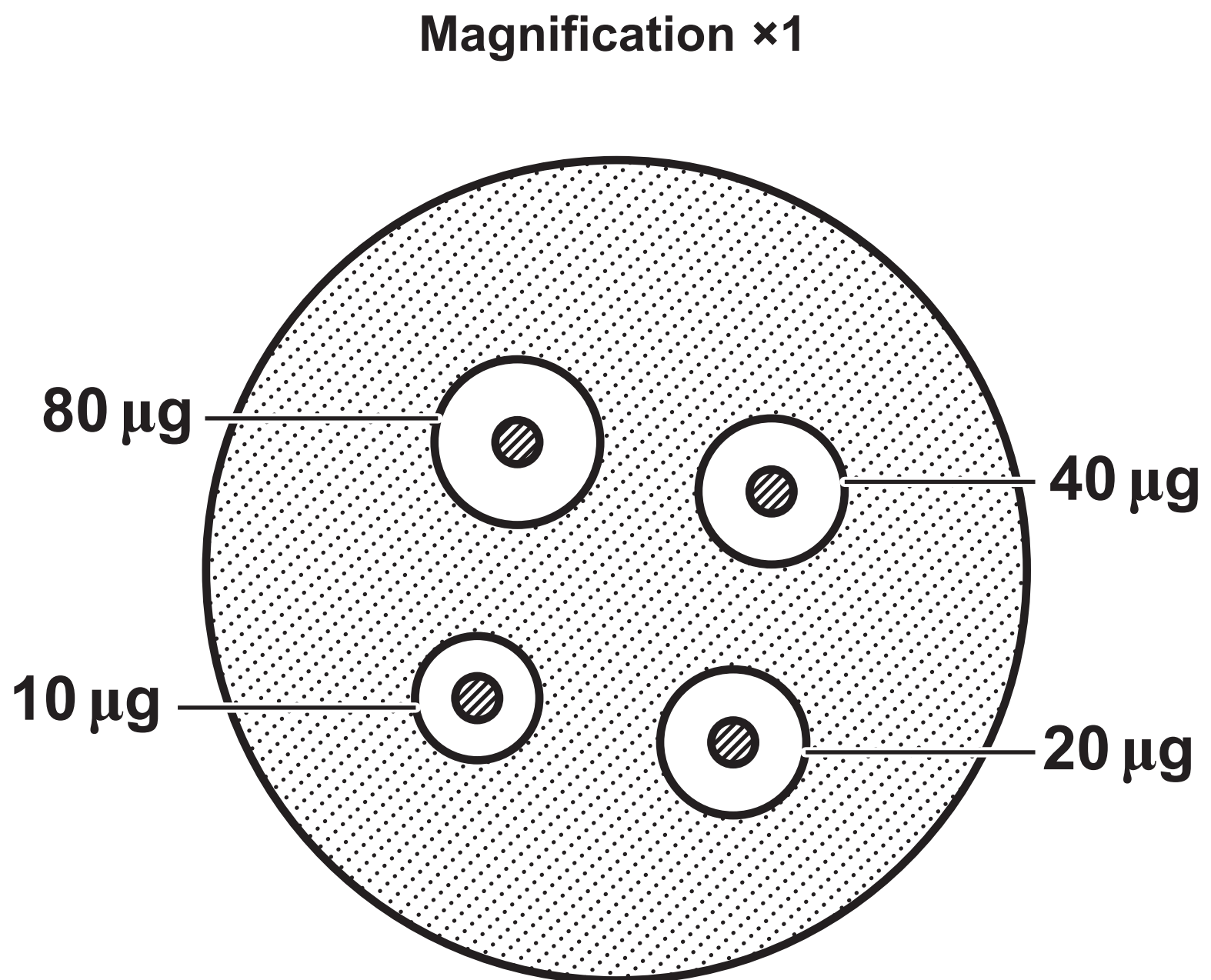

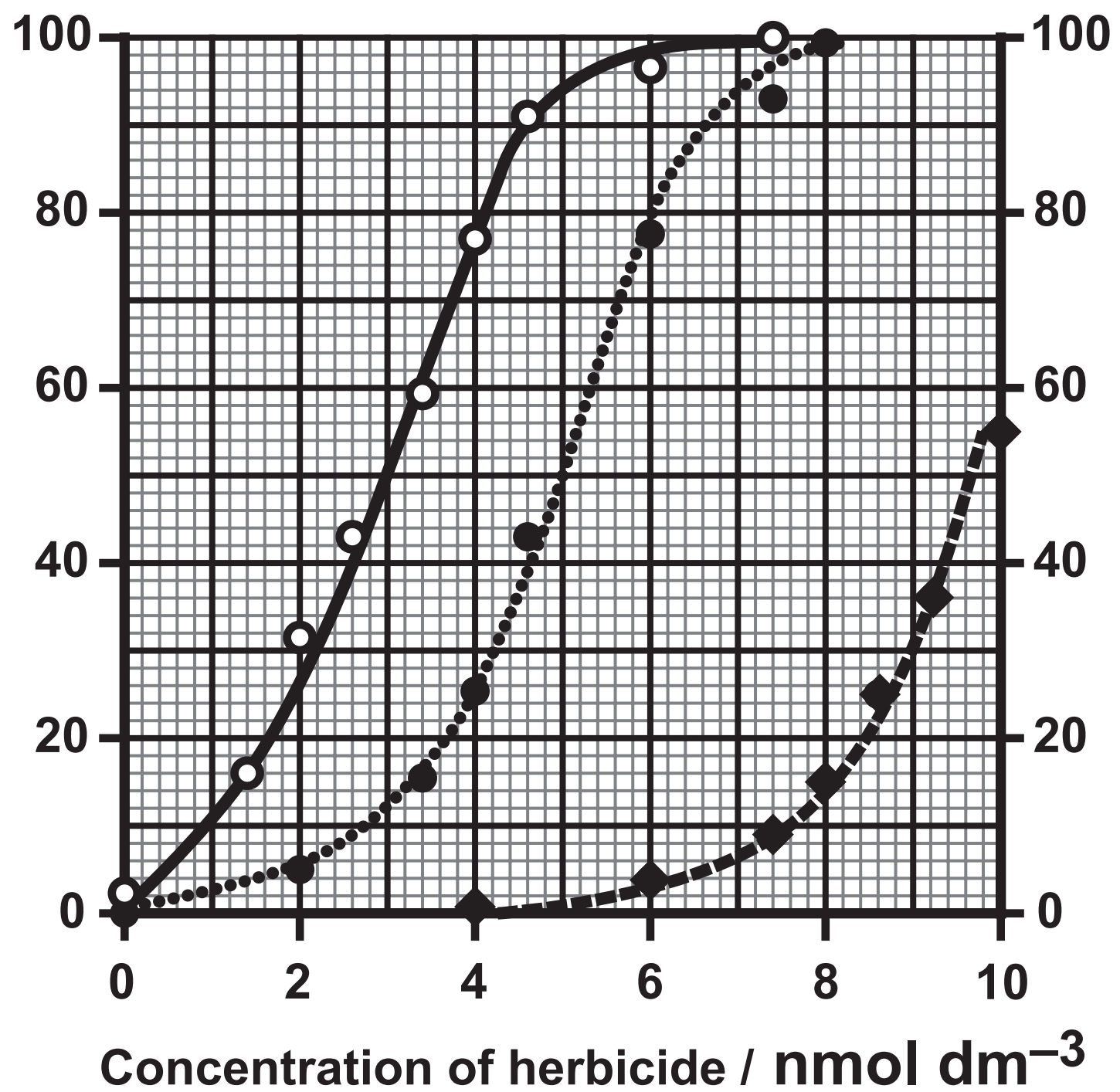

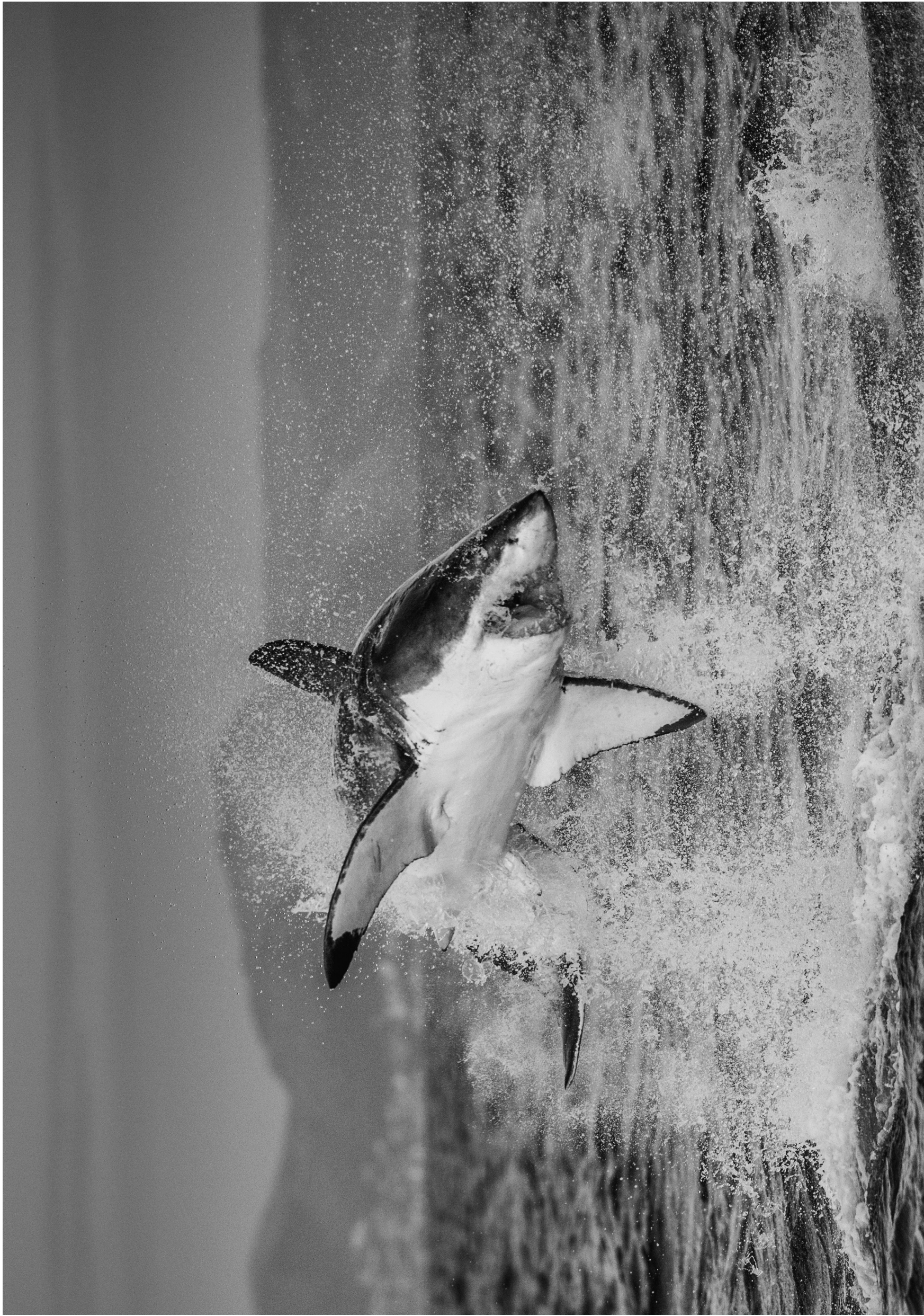

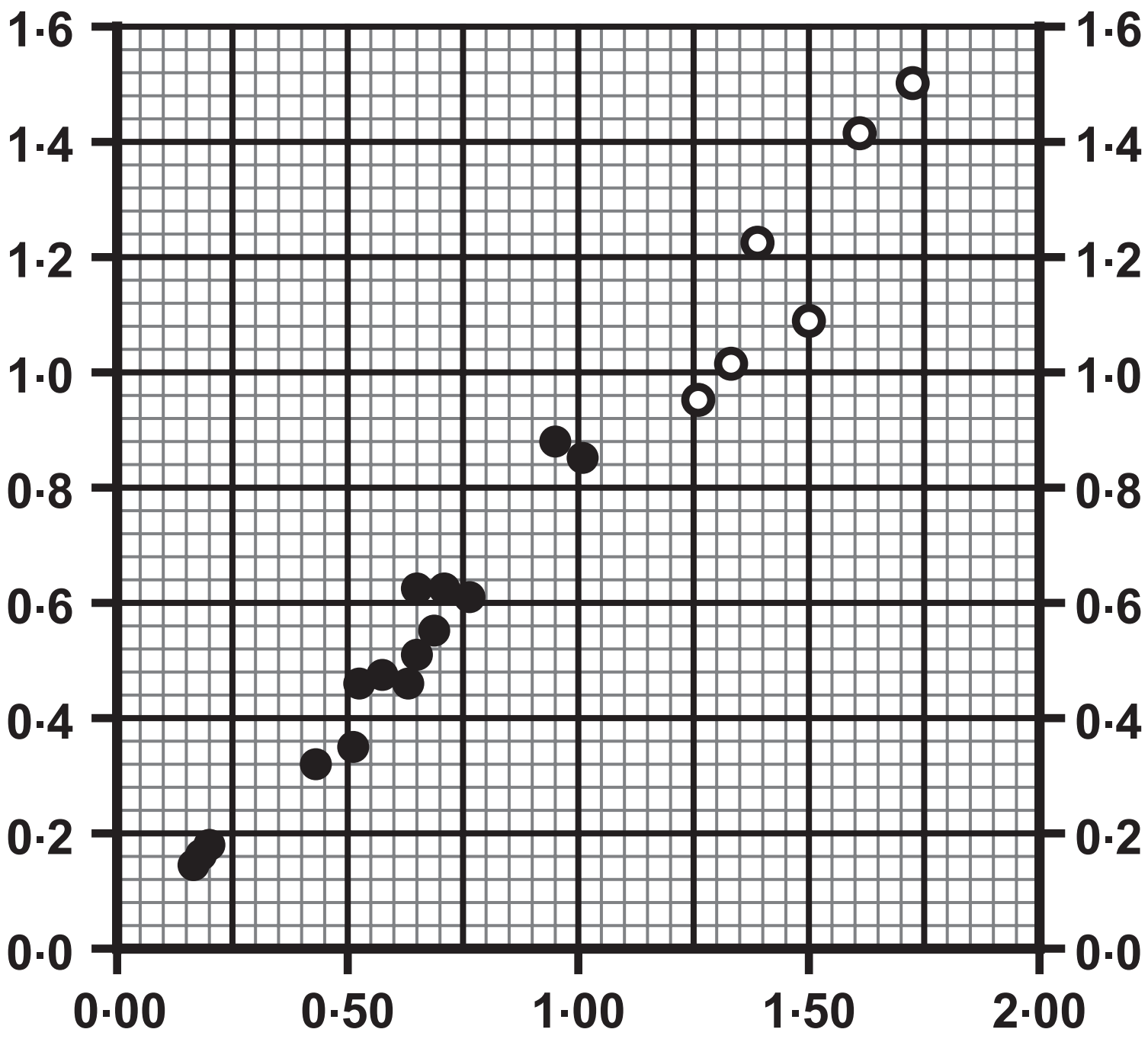

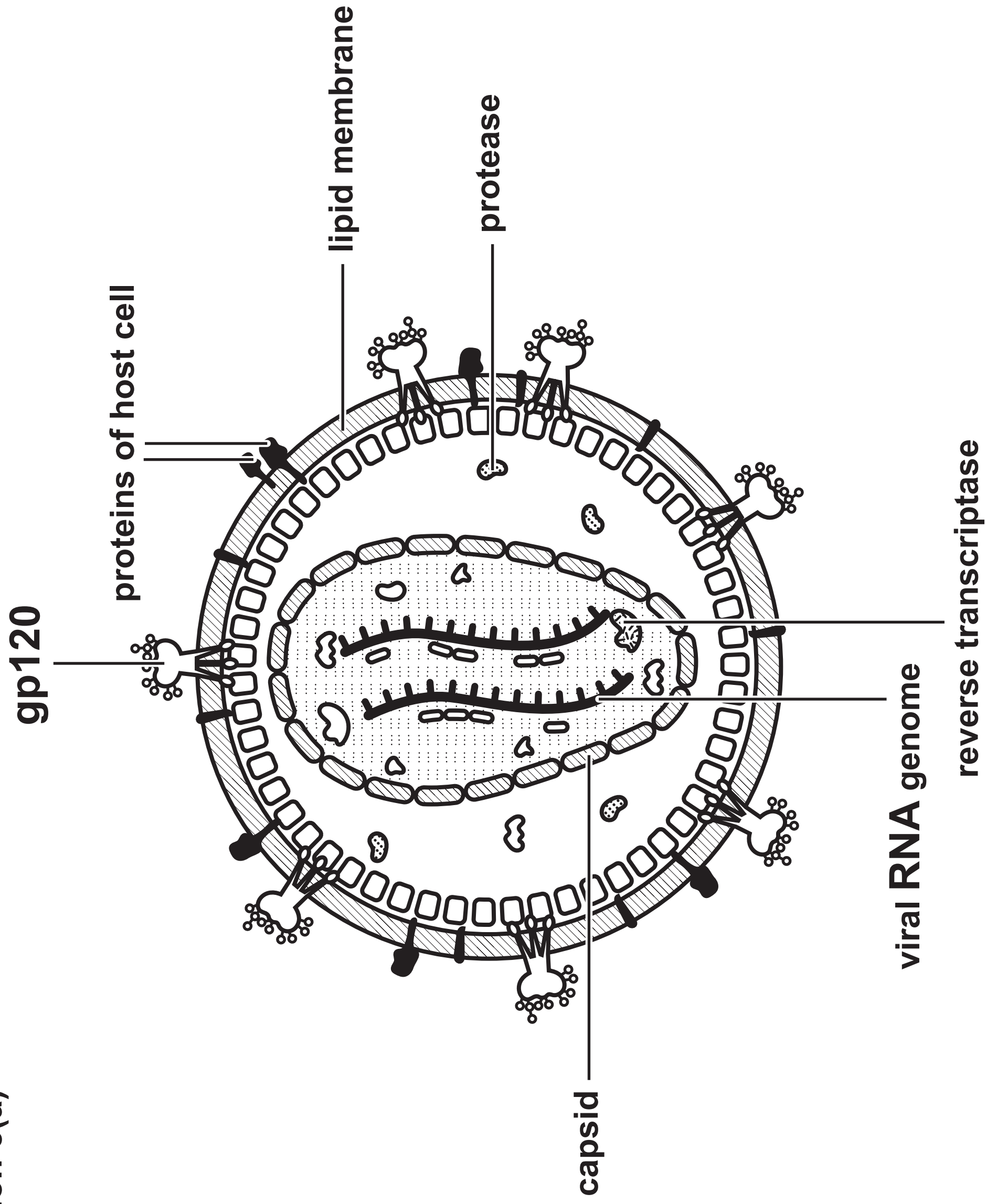

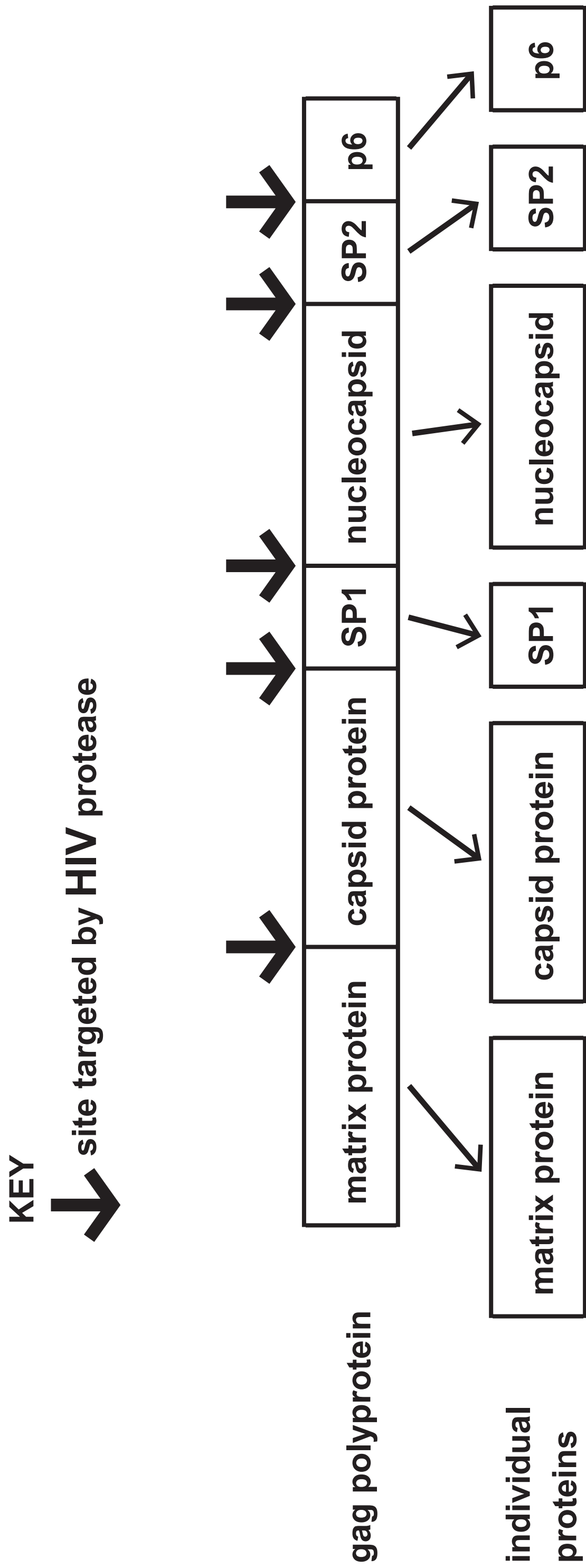

Uptake of O₂ per individual / $\mu\text{m}^3 \text{ hour}^{-1}$





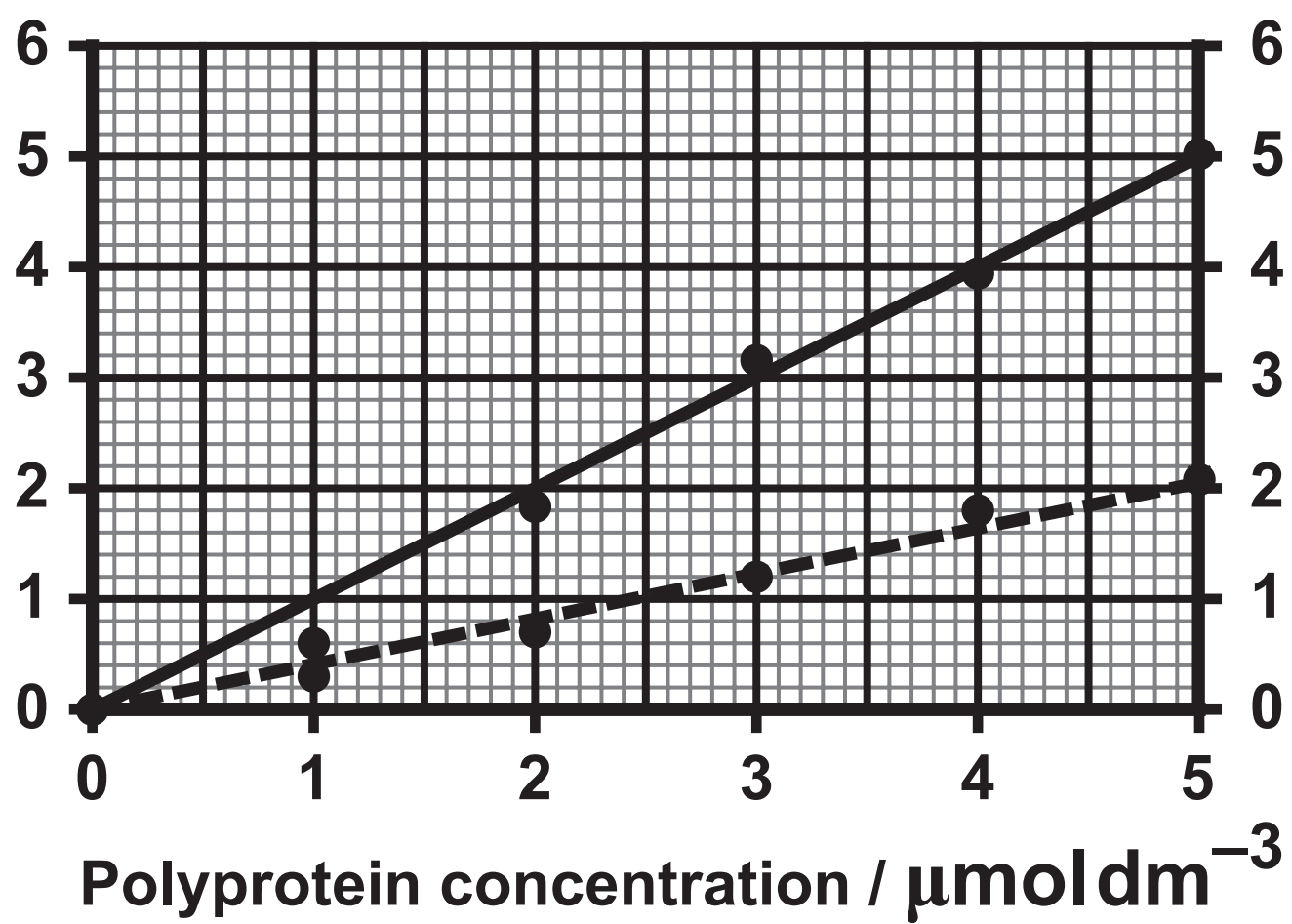

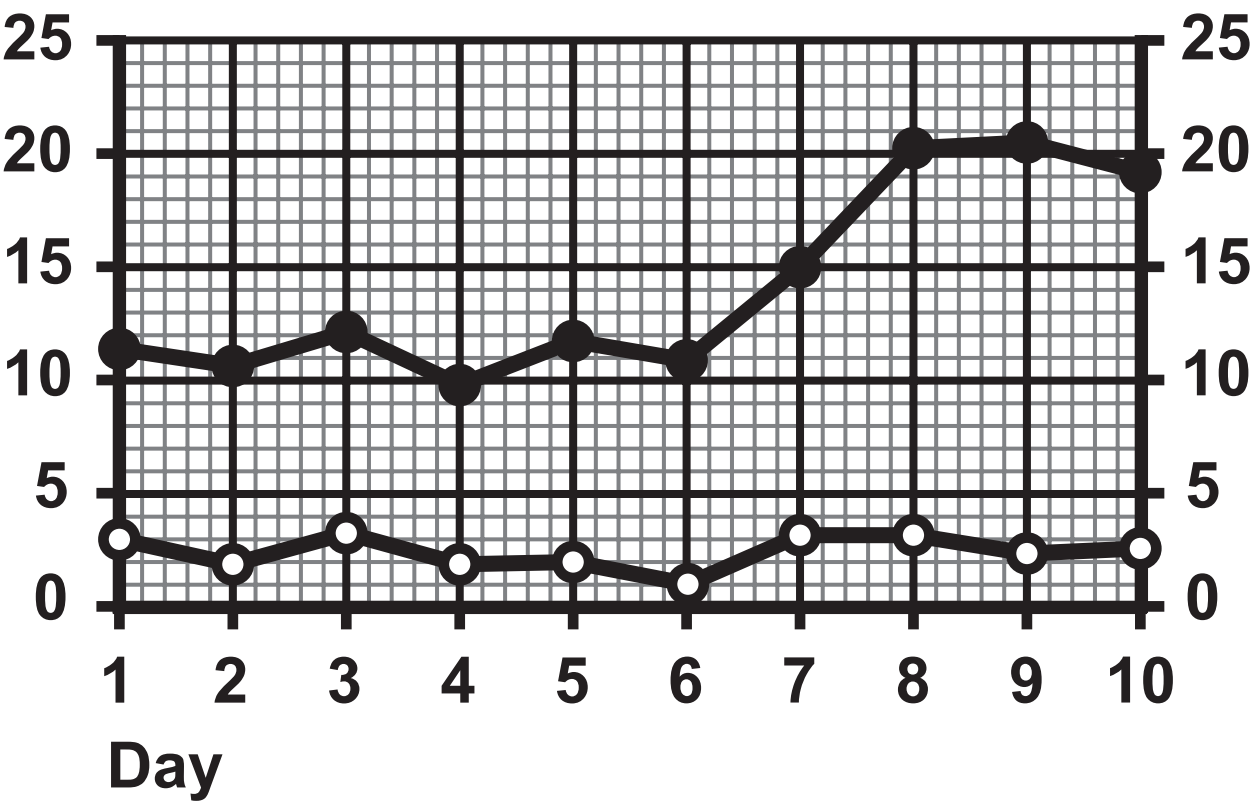
Initial rate of reaction

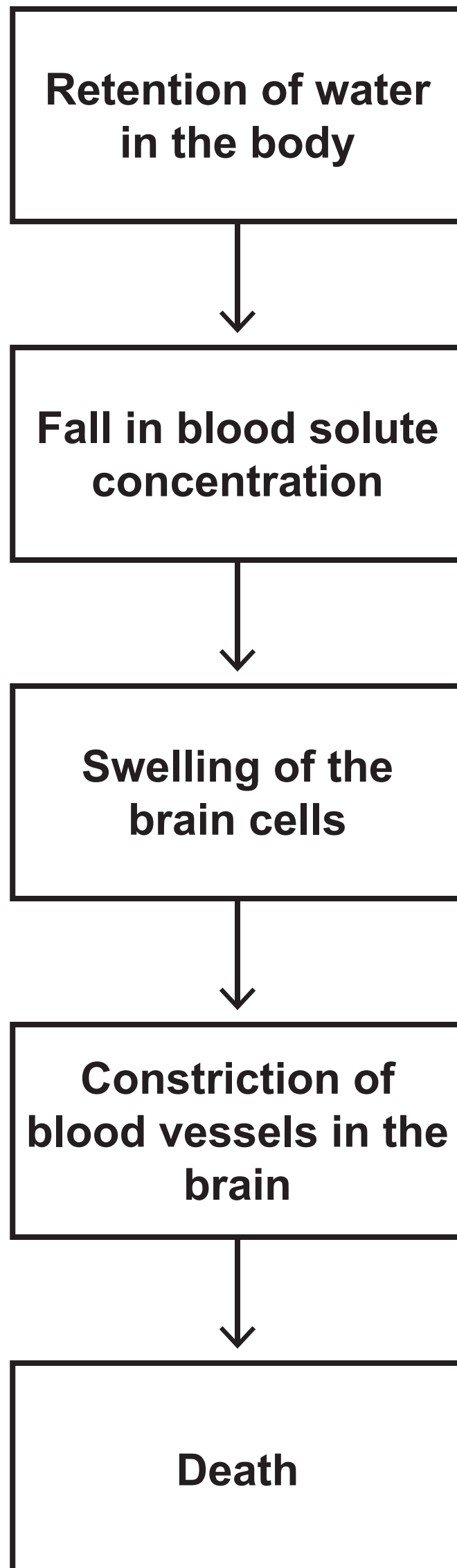

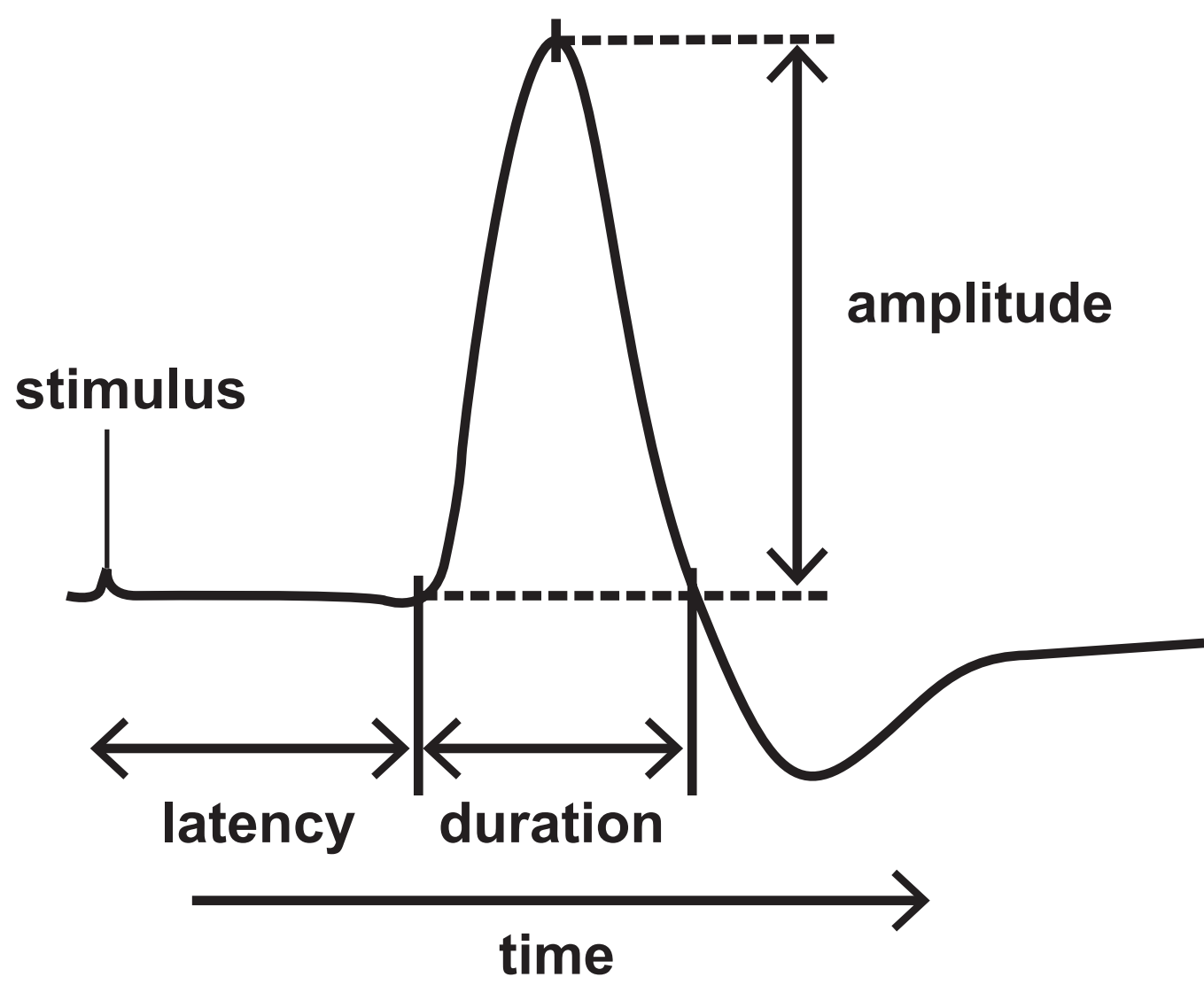
