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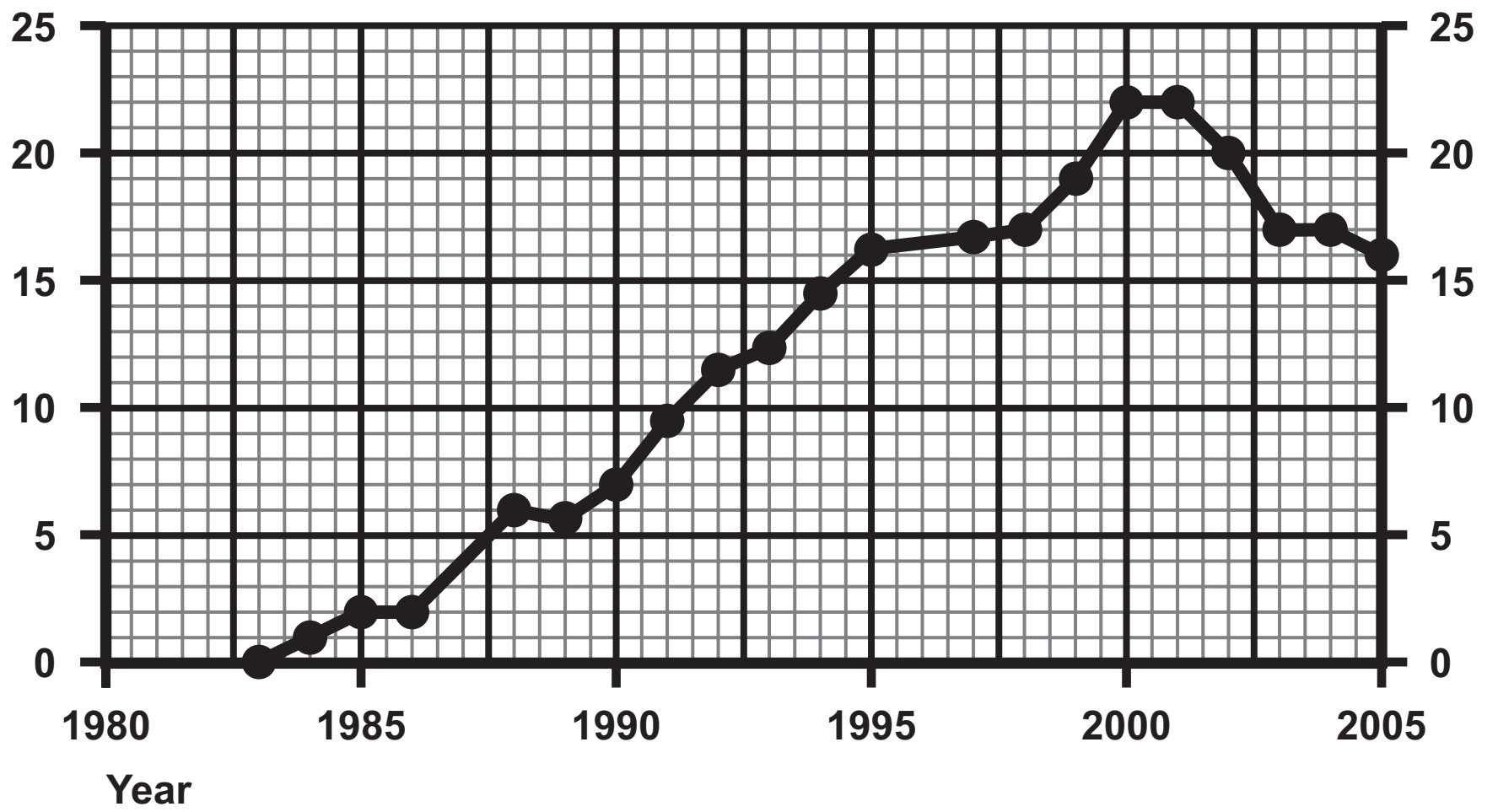
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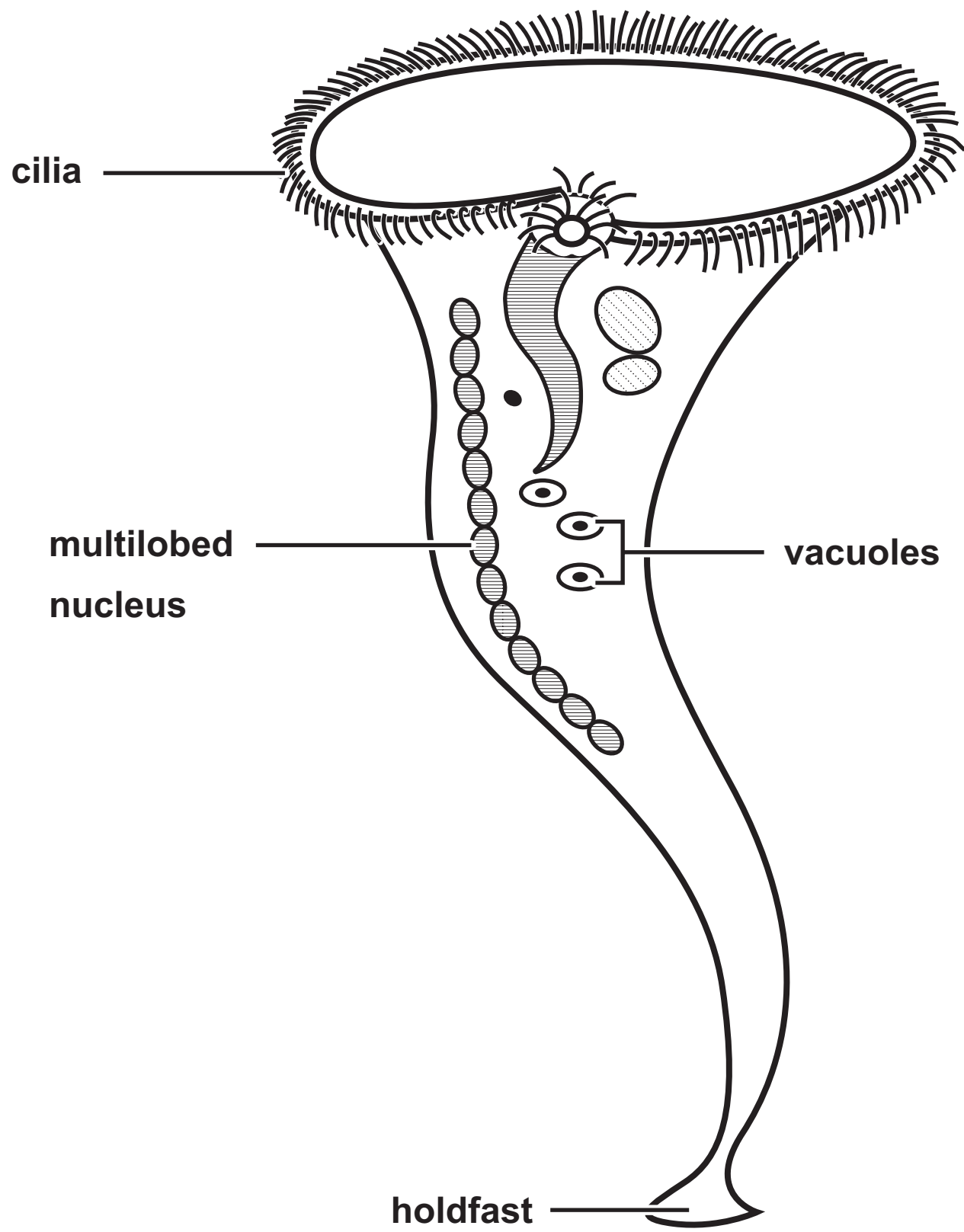

Mean species richness

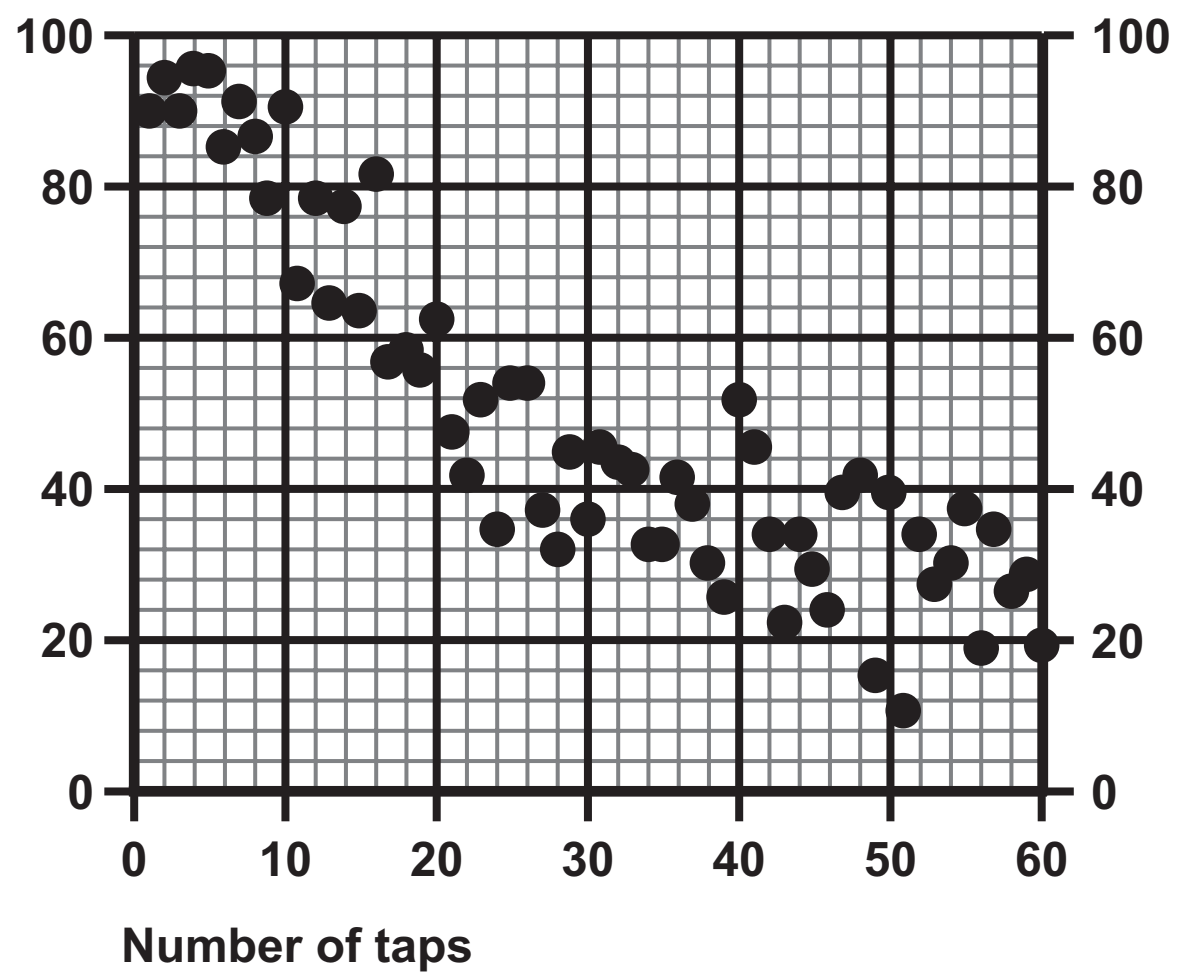

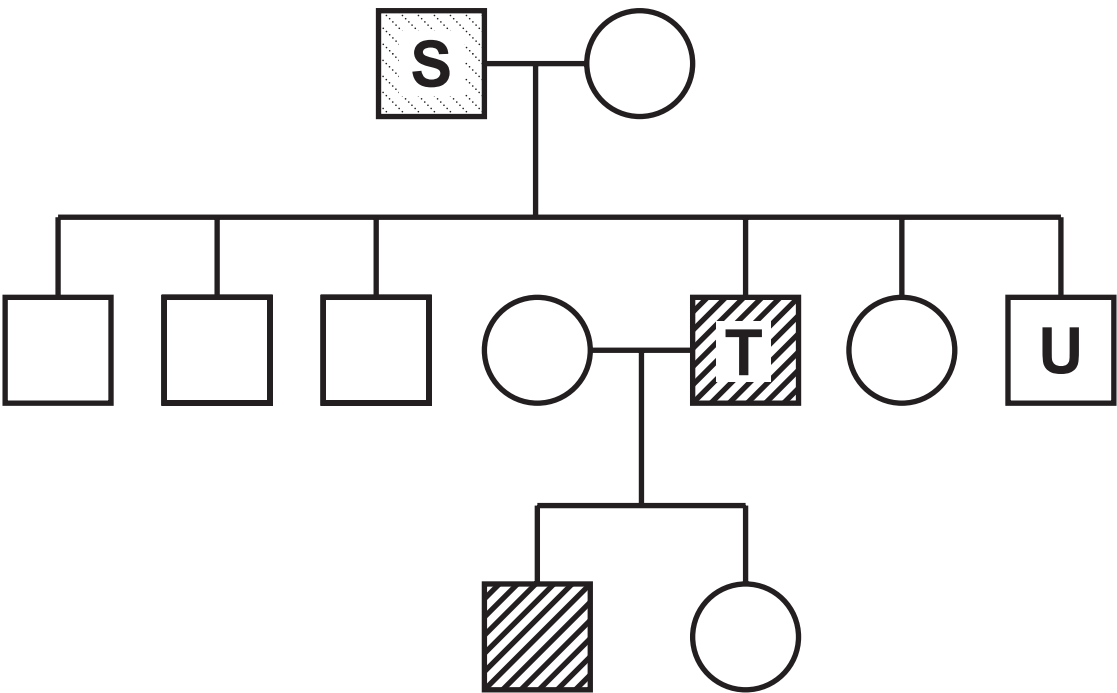
Percentage of Stentors

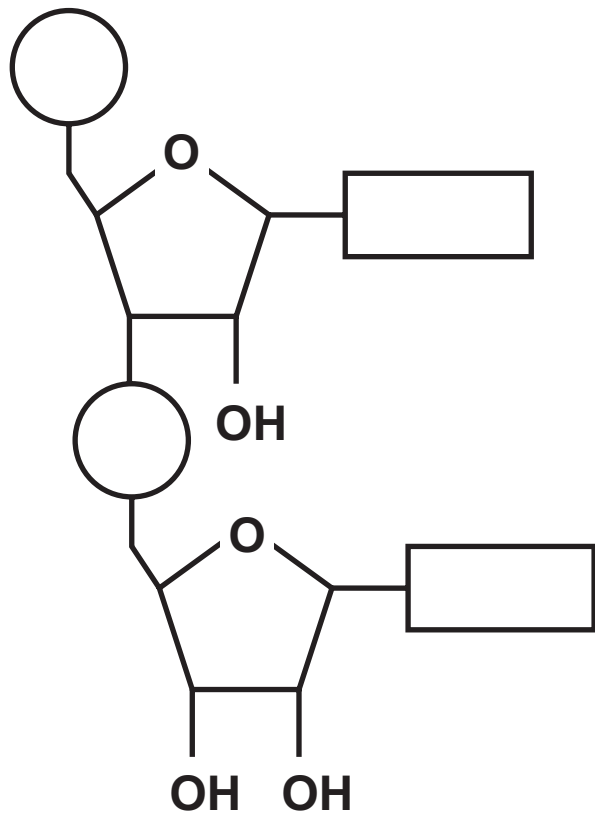

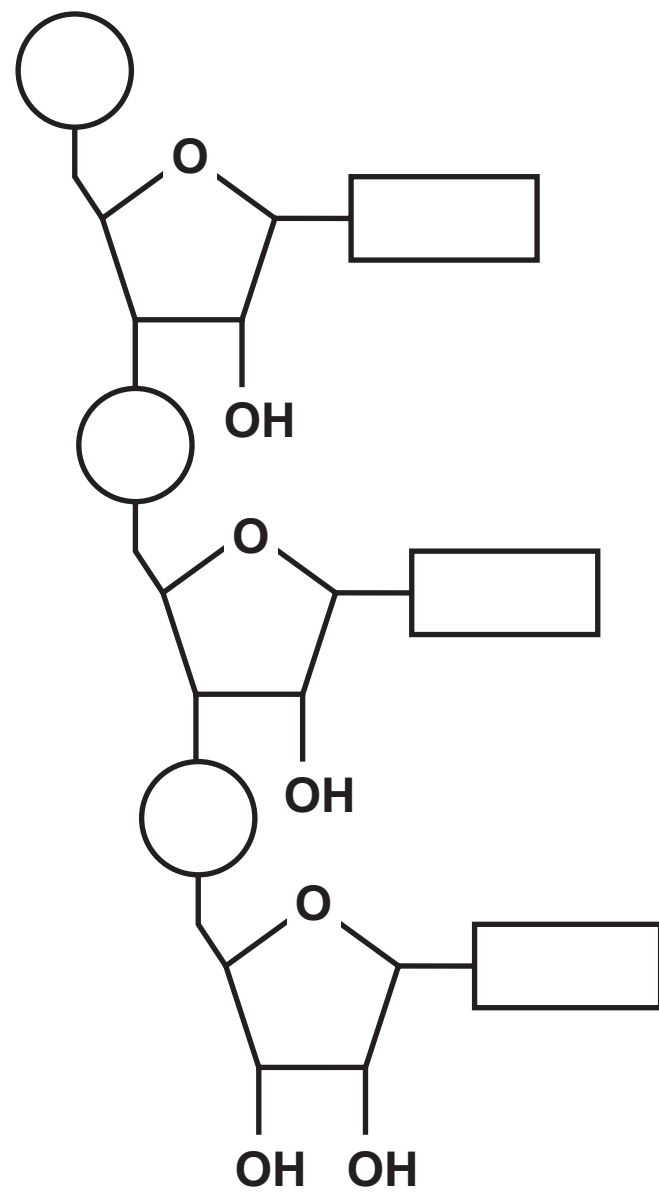

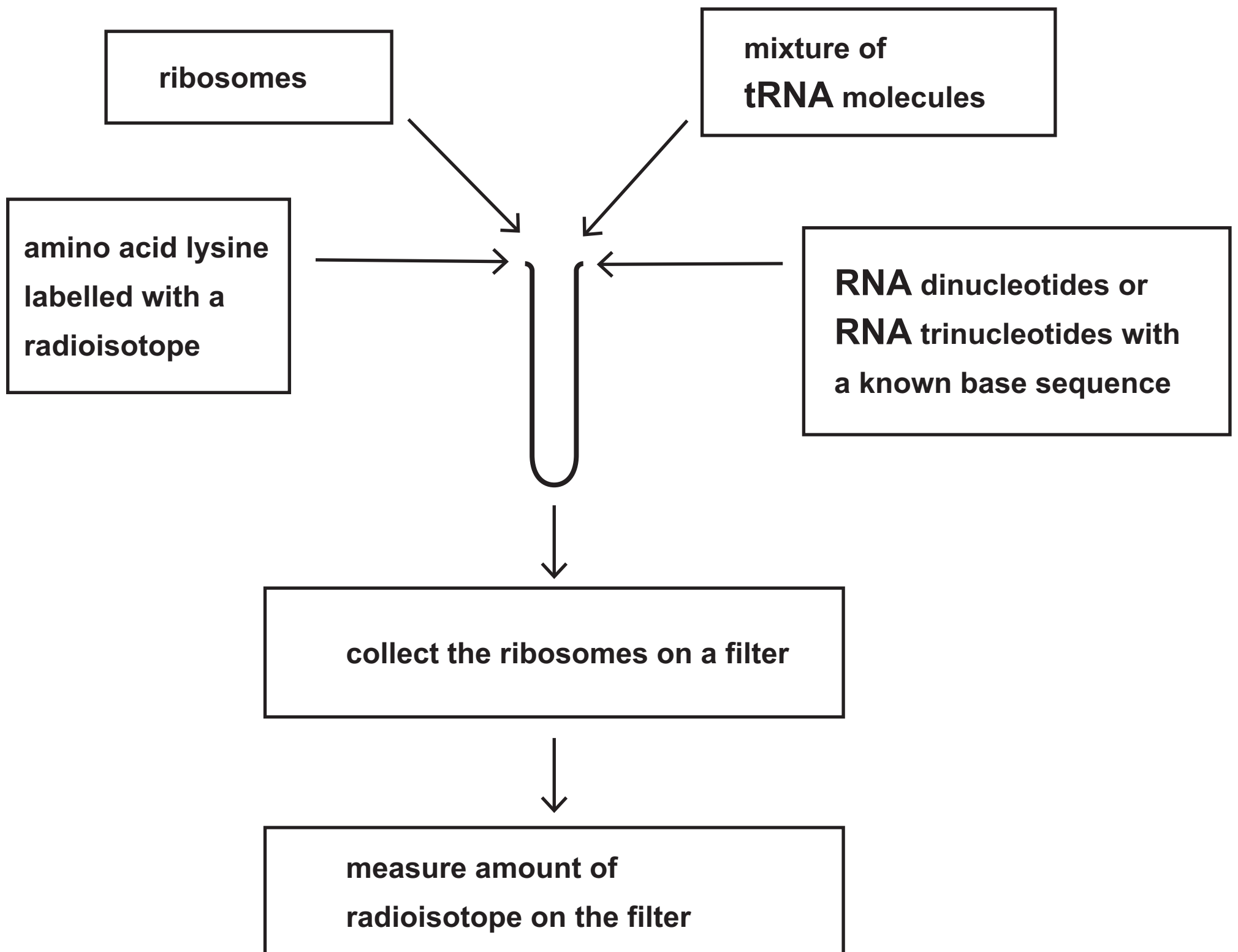

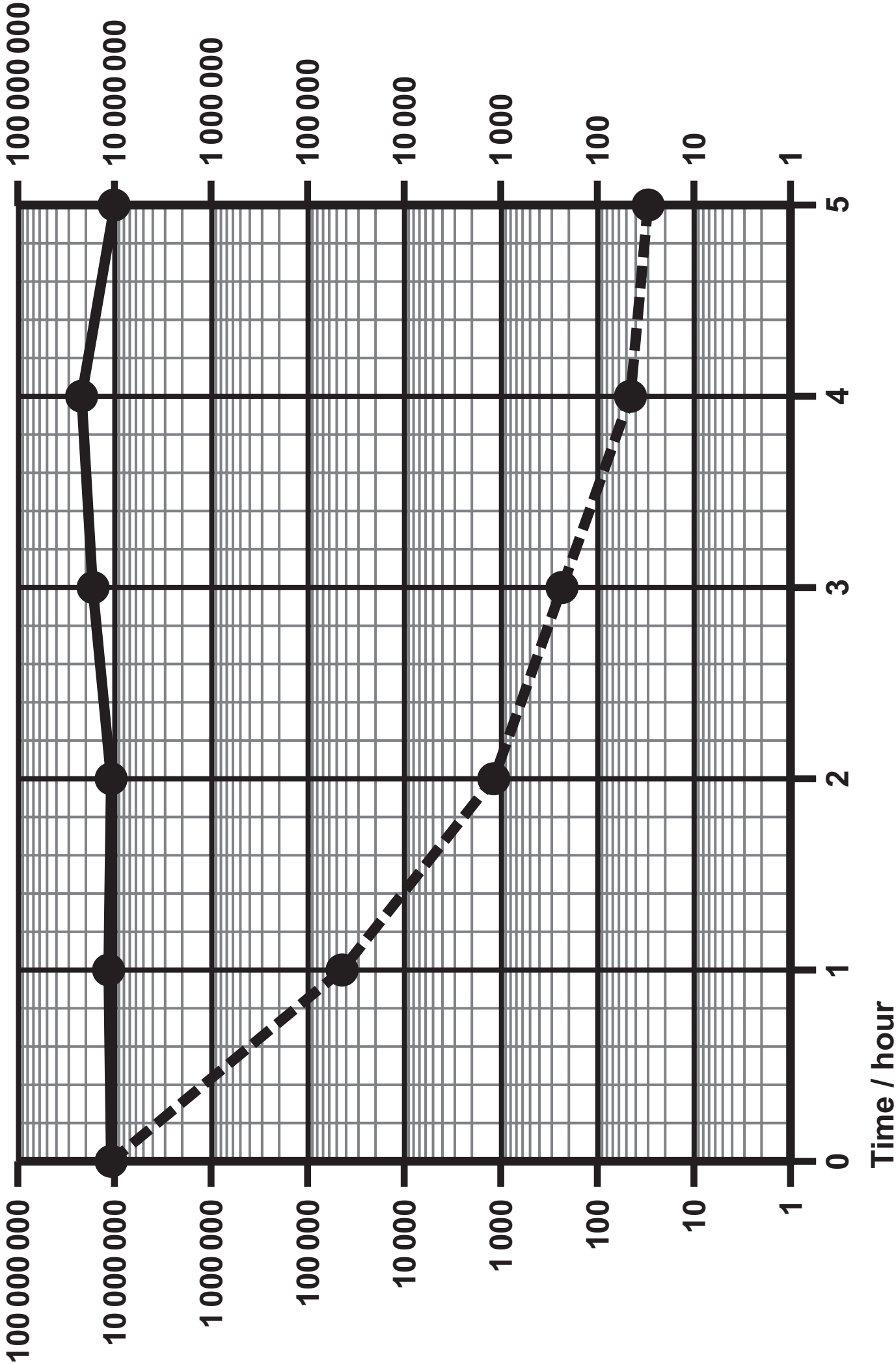

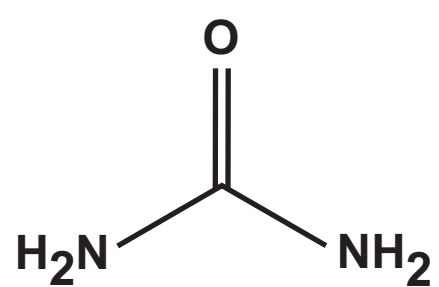
Number of living

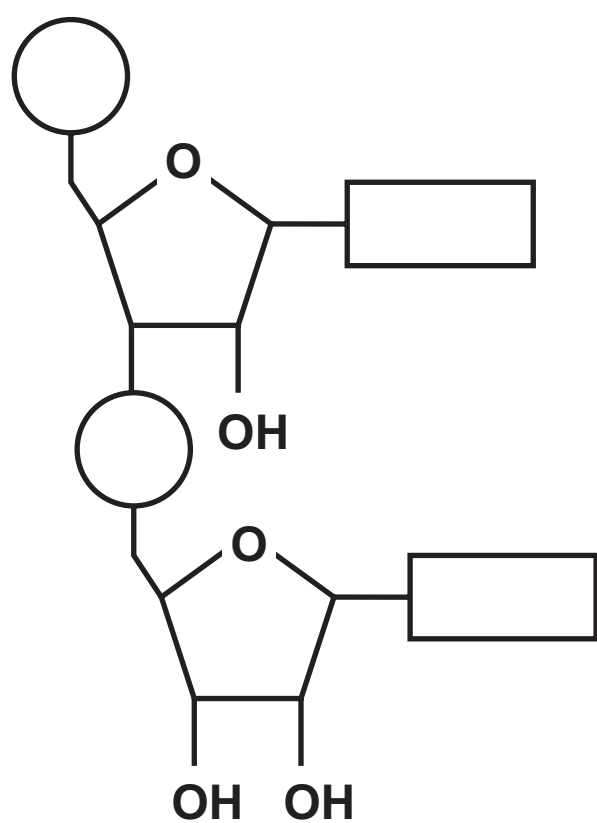

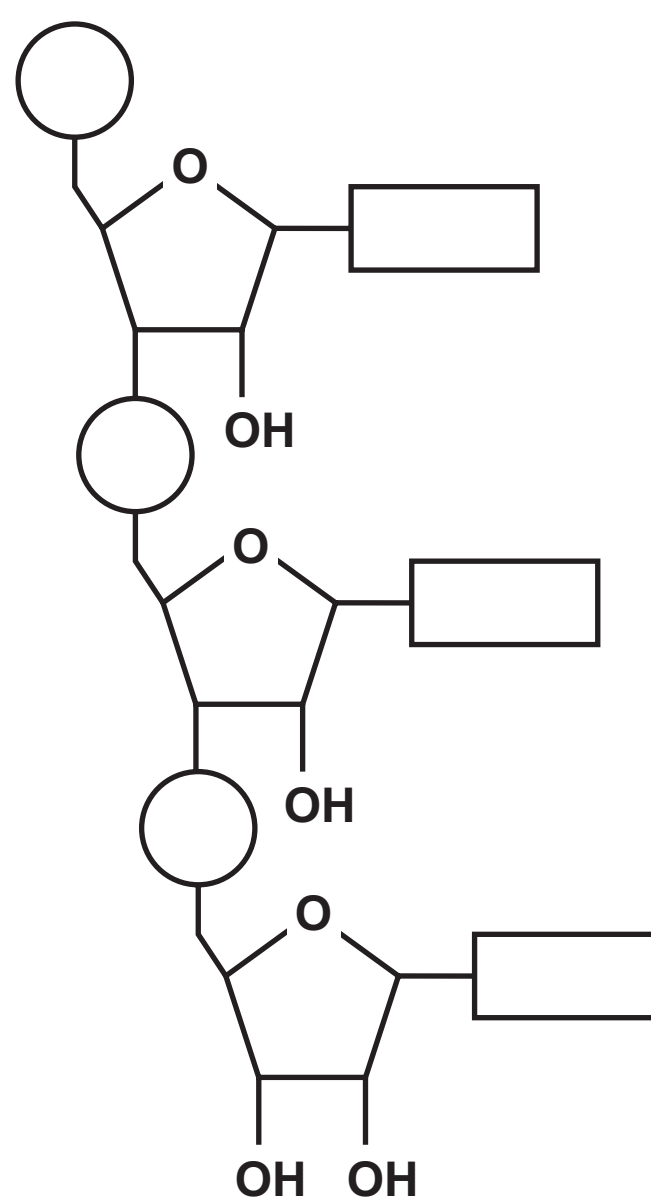
