Recording Task

Produce a stereo mix of the song *Time Is Running Out* by Muse.

You should create a mix that sounds as close as possible to '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav'.

Use only the audio files that have been provided by Pearson on the website.

For some parts, multiple takes have been provided. You may wish to compile these takes into a single track or you may need to use more than one to replicate production features.

The structure of the song should not be changed in any way. The fade out should match '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav'. Ensure the silences at the beginning and at the end do not exceed 1 second.

The audio files have been recorded at 118.305 bpm.

You must demonstrate competencies in use of EQ, dynamic processing, effects, stereo, balance and blend.

These tracks have been produced without any processing allowing you to make appropriate choices in your mix to replicate production features of '9MT001_Muse_Time_ls_Running_Out.wav'.

Align '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav' with bar 1 beat 4.

Align all other audio files to begin at the start of bar 1.

You must:

- ensure your recording is free from unwanted distortion and noise
- replicate, as far as possible, the stereo field, EQ, dynamic processing, effects and production features of '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav'
- ensure your fade out matches '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav'.

You may:

- compile performances from more than one audio file
- correct occasional performance mistakes or omissions using short sections of the audio provided.

You must not:

- include additional audio in your mix
- include additional MIDI or virtual instruments in your mix, with the exception of the bass
- use virtual instrument player or drum replacement software
- substitute alternative recordings for any of the audio provided
- use samples from '9MT001_Muse_Time_Is_Running_Out.wav' in your mix.

You must be in sole charge of the mixing process. Group working or sharing of DAW files/templates between candidates is not permitted.

You must submit your recording digitally in the format detailed in the Administrative Support Guide, found on the Pearson website.
