Q1:

This multiple-choice question was attempted by nearly all of the candidates. The common mistakes were for question (ii) kısmen // gereçlerdir and (iv) kurumlara instead of the correct options.

The candidates are advised to improve their skills to listen for specific information. However, most candidates answered the question correctly.

Q2:

This second question which worth 5 marks were answered by nearly all of the candidates. The common mistakes were (i) A sosyal durumu and (ii) B milli sınırlar belirlenirken // kazanılan savaşlardan sonra instead of the correct options. The last recall question 2(v) was answered correctly by nearly all candidates.

Q3a:

These open -ended questions were answered by most of the candidates correctly. The common mistake was in (iii). The candidates need to read the questions very carefully and be sure about what information is required.

Q3b:

In this section the candidates were supposed to write very short summaries. Some of them managed to do that by writing just the main idea and were awarded the full marks, some wrote everything that was said about the main idea and lost marks.

Most questions were answered successfully. The common mistake was (ii) Yabancı dil - Some candidates instead of giving information about how easy it became to learn foreign languages, they wrote about the ways of learning languages.

Q4:

Most candidates managed to listen for specific information and answered the questions correctly.

The common mistakes;

- (a) Some candidates gave only one part of the question and was awarded only one mark.
- (b) Answered correctly by nearly all candidates. The common mistake was 'aileler bölündü'.
- (c) Those who understand the word 'dini' answered this question correctly. Those who copied the whole passage were not awarded any marks.
- (d) Many candidates managed to deduce the answer from the passage.
- (e) This recall question was answered correctly by many candidates.
- (f) This question was answered correctly by nearly all candidates.

5a)

The candidates managed to listen for specific information and identified the opinions of a sociologist about quality of life. Most of the candidates were successful. Those who did not prepare for the exam well or did not pay attention to the words such as 'in my opinion or I think' found it hard to differentiate the facts from opinions and lost marks.

5(b)

The reading passage consists of different ideas about what needs to be done to increase the quality of life. Most of the candidates managed to identify the teacher's opinions.

5 (c) The candidates wrote very good essays this year. Those who prepared the exam well knew exactly what was required to get good grades in the exam. They managed to write about two people's opinions equally by adding their own opinions and score high marks. Those who only conveyed the message of the people without mentioning their comments on them lost marks.
