Available for first teach September 2025, the BTEC Level 2 Technical Occupational Entry for Recreation Assistants (Diploma) (QN 610/4253/5) will replace our current:

- Pearson BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Sports Industry Skills (Sport and Active Leisure Recreation Assistant) (QN 603/6137/2)
