

Edexcel BTEC Foundation Learning qualifications in Hospitality - amendment to specification

Issue 4 of the specification for the Foundation Learning qualifications in Hospitality has now been superseded by Issue 5, due to incorrect information regarding the minimum credit to be achieved at the level of the qualification for the following qualifications:

- Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Award in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF)
- Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Certificate in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF)
- Edexcel BTEC Level 1 Award in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (QCF)
- Edexcel BTEC Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (QCF).

This has now been rectified in the rules of combination for these qualifications in Issue 5 as follows:

- For the Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Award in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF), the minimum credit to be achieved at the level of the qualification (Entry 3) is 6 credits (page 6 of the Issue 5 specification)
- For the Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Certificate in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF), the minimum credit to be achieved at the level of the qualification (Entry 3) is 8 credits (page 7 of the Issue 5 specification)
- For the Edexcel BTEC Level 1 Award in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (QCF), the minimum credit to be achieved at the level of the qualification (Level 1) is 6 credits (page 8 of the Issue 5 specification)
- For the Edexcel BTEC Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (QCF), the minimum credit to be achieved at the level of the qualification (Level 1) is 8 credits (page 9 of the Issue 5 specification).

The Level 2 unit *Food Safety in Catering* has also been added as an optional unit to the rules of combination for the Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Award in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF) and the Edexcel BTEC Entry Level Certificate in Introduction to the Hospitality Industry (Entry 3) (QCF).
