## Student Guide Level 2 BTEC First Certificate

### What is the Level 2 BTEC First Certificate in Vehicle Technology?

The BTEC First Certificate in Vehicle Technology is designed for people who are interested in working with motor vehicles, and who wish to develop a grounding in the necessary skills and understanding to help them either enter employment or move on to further vocational education and training.

The qualification has been designed to be flexible, allowing you to focus on your interests and explore new areas, and to enable you to take other subjects alongside your BTEC First Certificate. There are two core units and a range of specialist units to choose from, which will provide you with a total of 180 guided learning hours. Areas you may wish to focus on could include: routine vehicle maintenance, engineering skills for vehicle repair or vehicle valeting.

### Where will this qualification take me?

#### Employment opportunities

Following completion of the BTEC First Certificate in Vehicle Technology, successful candidates may use their qualification as a stepping stone towards entering employment in the vehicle repair and maintenance industries.

#### Further vocational and academic qualifications

The achievement of the BTEC First Certificate has the equivalence of 2 GCSEs graded A\*-C. If you achieve an overall pass grade or better in the BTEC First Certificate in Vehicle Technology, it is possible for you to progress further to a BTEC First Diploma in Vehicle Technology, or to enrol on another Level 2 programme, such as a relevant NVQ, or to move on to a higher level qualification such as the Level 3 BTEC National Certificate in Vehicle Technology.

## How long will it take me to complete this qualification?

Generally speaking, it will take one academic year to complete but it may be studied for shorter or longer periods; the length of the course is largely dependant on the centre where you study.

## What are the entry requirements?

The entry requirements for the Edexcel Level 2 BTEC First Certificate in Vehicle Technology are laid down by individual centres. You should have the interest and potential to succeed in achieving the qualification and ideally be able to show you have a standard of literacy, numeracy and general education equivalent to four GCSEs graded D-G, or you should be able to show you have undertaken suitable work experience or have completed a Level 1 or 2 qualification.
