### SUBJECT PAGES

Where Tutors can access All Subjects, students only need access to one. They will see My Subject in their navigation, this includes an overview of the subject area, a suggested path of activities and in some cases, RSS feeds.

### SHORT COURSES

You can find further support in the Short Courses section with study skills modules and digital literacy learning paths. These modules have been created to support academic development and can be used in the classroom.

### FORUM

All users can access the forum, it is a place for you to engage with other users from around the world and discuss common themes about your subject. There is a separate student and tutor forum, allowing centre staff to discuss teaching practices.

### BLOG

This is your space to gain insights into Higher Education and subjects; review leading educational sector profiles and hear from colleagues in Pearson. The Higher Nationals Blog is now open for submissions! Have your story published on our website.

## PROGRESSION HUB

## ACCOUNT TYPES

### TUTOR

If you are an approved centre for delivering BTEC Higher Nationals, and are a teacher/centre staff, you can sign up using the Tutor role. You'll need to enter your centre name to get access to the platform.

### STUDENT

A BTEC Higher National student can sign-up to access their subject content by selecting the role Student. They'll need to enter their qualification and centre name to get access to the relevant content.

### GUEST TUTOR / STUDENT

If you are not yet approved, or just curious about what content is available, you can get guest access to HN Global. You do not need to enter any BTEC Higher Nationals details and can still access content on the platform.

If you are centre staff, please select Guest Tutor, and if you are encouraging your students to check out the resources, please advise them to create a Guest Student account.
