


How do Licensed Higher Nationals work?

BTEC Higher Nationals are vocational higher education qualifications. They're equal to the first two years of a university degree and help students to move directly into jobs or further study.

If your UK-based Higher Education Institution (HEI) has **Degree Awarding Powers (DAP)**, you can offer Higher Nationals under licence. This means you stay in control of teaching, assessment, awarding and certification, while reaping all the benefits of offering a Higher National qualification.

Licence Types



Intellectual Property (IP) Licence

With this licence, your HEI can use the full range of Higher Nationals, including Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQs), as your own validated awards. You'll be responsible for quality assurance, awarding, and certification, while Pearson's content remains protected.

Trademark (TM) Licence

With this licence, your HEI designs, approves, delivers, and awards the programme as its own, using the "Higher Nationals" trademark. The course content must align with BTEC Higher Nationals only when the programme title matches or closely resembles a BTEC qualification.

Mapping the core content ensures recognition by employers and professional bodies, as well as smoother progression onto a degree. You'll have the freedom to design what works best for your students, while maintaining the trusted reputation of the Higher Nationals brand.

Licence Scope:

- You can use the name "Higher Nationals" (not "BTEC" or "Pearson").
- Covers Higher Nationals, including HTQs, at Level 4 (HNC) and Level 5 (HND).

How Licensed Higher Nationals can benefit your institution

Here's what your Licensed Higher Nationals journey will look like...

- 1. Partner Application: Submit your Centre Approval Application.
- 2. Approval Meeting: We'll review your application and set up a meeting.
- 3. Onboarding (A): Introduction to admin processes, registrations, and finance.
- 4. **Programme Approval:** Submit your Programme Approval Application with evidence.
- 5. Licence Agreement: Both parties sign the agreement.
- **6.** Onboarding (B): Get familiar with the EOL* platform.
- 7. Register Learners: Log student registrations on EOL* by the deadlines in the Fee Booklet.
- 8. Quality Assurance: Appoint your own External Examiners and follow your QA processes.
- **9. Record Outcomes:** Log student results on EOL*.
- **10. Annual Report:** Share data for the IRR**, including last year's results and forecasts for the year ahead.
