Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in Children's Play, Learning and Development (Early Years Educator)

We welcome the inclusion of external assessment in these qualifications. Also, the introduction of a larger mandatory core, comprising over half of each qualification, will provide students with a solid foundation.
