As a Higher Education Institution, we will recognise the following qualifications as fulfilling entry requirements to a range of our higher education courses in related subject areas, either by meeting entry requirements in their own right or being accepted alongside other qualifications at the same level:

- BTEC Level 3 National Foundation Diploma in Forensic Investigation
- BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in Forensic and Criminal Investigation
