

Edexcel Level 4 Award in Intermediate Incident Command in Fire and Rescue Services (QCF)

There has been an amendment to the above qualification, ie change in QN number due to the replacement of unit 'Intermediate Incident Command in Fire and Rescue Services' (F/502/9128) with unit of same title (T/503/9001). Skills for Justice have changed learning outcome LO8 to a performance outcome so that it now reflects the requirements of the related assessment criteria. The change will take immediate effect for new learner registrations made on or after the 1st May 2012. For existing learner registrations, centres are encouraged to move their learners to the new unit requirements where this is advantageous for them to do so.
