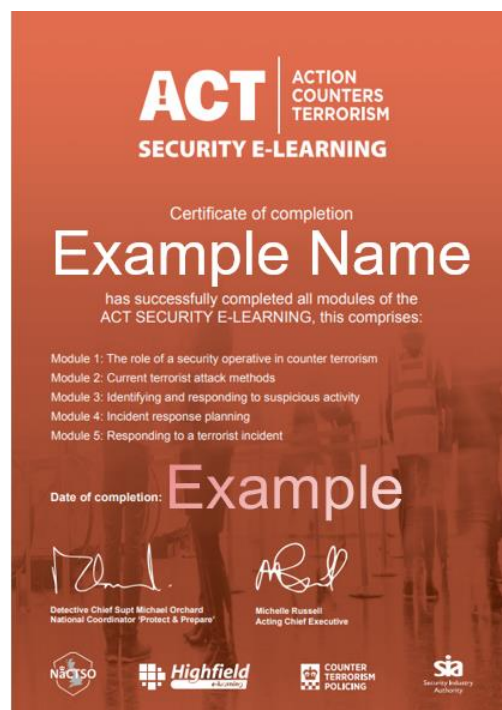
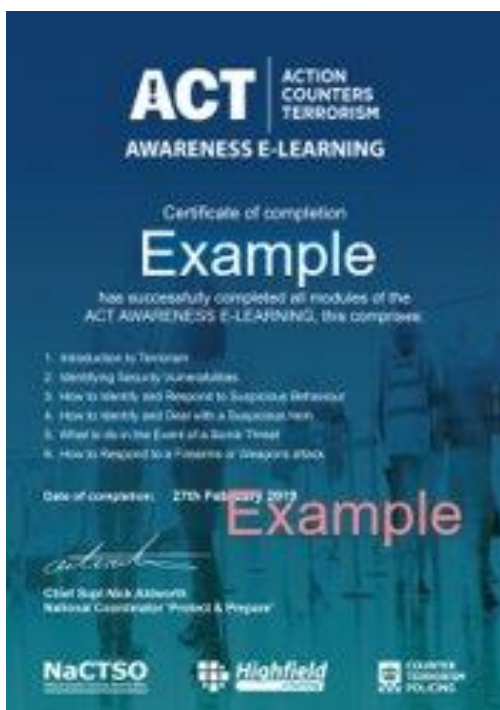


**ACT Awareness** and **ACT Security** are the only e-learning courses approved by the SIA as part of the licence-linked qualifications and top-up training. No other self-directed learning can be used to cover the terror threat awareness session.

Once both e-learning courses are completed, they cover the entire content of the terror threat awareness unit for the licence-linked qualifications and top-up training.

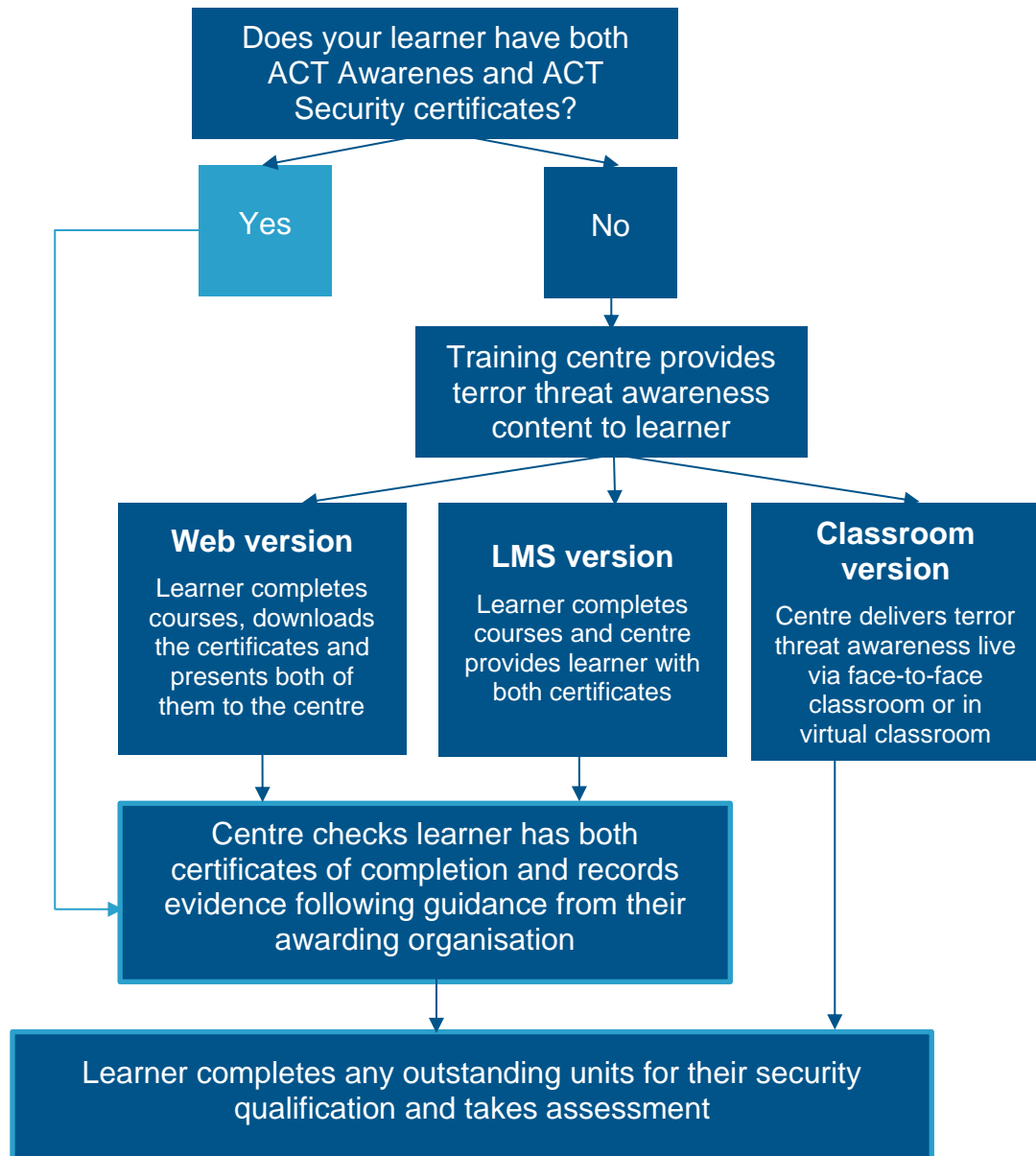
If a learner presents you with evidence of completion (i.e. both course certificates), you can allow them to take the terror threat awareness top-up test.



You will need to follow your awarding organisations procedure for providing evidence that learners have successfully completed both programmes. If the learner doesn't have evidence, you can ask them to take both e-learning courses or deliver the course yourself face-to-face.

The e-learning course is free and flexible. Users can complete each course in one session or across several sessions by saving their progress at the end of each module.

#### How to access the course:
