Steps to entering

One

Prepare a performance piece

Have a discussion with your learners about which routines or performances they have most enjoyed and feel they are strongest in - you could use a piece from a previous unit.

Things to remember:

- Read the terms and conditions.
- The winner(s) of the competition will have approximately 3 minutes to show their talents.
- Please note, group submissions should be limited to 10 performers (maximum).
- If you're entering more than one submission to the competition, please ensure a separate email is sent with completed entry and consent forms.
- We may use the video recording you send in for the event or, dependent on government guidelines, invite you to the studio to perform.

Three

Fill in our Showstopper Challenge entry form

This details who your learners are and the performance they're entering with, please fill this in carefully and correctly.

Get copies of signed consent forms (which are on our website) obtained from the parents or guardians of all the performers.

Two

Film your BTEC learners

Record your learners performing their piece (bear in mind, you don't have to send us your first recording!).

The video you are sending should be in costume and make-up due to the possibility of an online event.

If you use music that is still in copyright during your performance there is a chance it may be muted during the live stream and when we post the recordings of the ceremony on YouTube. We would therefore recommend sourcing tracks from a copyright free source such as the Adobe Royalty Free Stock Music Library.

Submit your video and entry form to btecawards@pearson.com by Tuesday 11 May 2021

Your video (which should be 3 minutes maximum) can be sent in via a YouTube link, a Google Drive link, via WeTransfer / Dropbox or as an attachment on the email (in MOV/MPEG-4/WMV format).
