## Marking The Script

For part one of the marking, the learner needs to get any two of the three parts correct to get the full two marks. In this case the learner has got all three (name, address and email address correct), so should receive two marks.

The final mark is for the correct use of upper-case and lower-case letters. In this instance, the learner has made errors in the name and the postcode sections, so would not gain this mark.

The learner would get two out of three marks.
