## Marking The Script

For Question 1, the learner would receive three out of the four marks. The first one is incorrect.

For Question 2, the learner would receive two marks out of two. We are assessing capital letters and full stops, and the sentence does meet the bare minimum criteria for what is a sentence.

For Question 3, the learner would receive one mark out of two. In this question we are not assessing spelling or punctuation, so those errors can be ignored. However, the learner has failed to notice that the second sentence needs to start with the word I.
