Respond to opinions	<i>LR E3.6 Respond appropriately to other points of view</i>	Award: 1 mark for responding to agree/disagree with a point of view. 1
Answer questions clearly	<i>SC E3.3 Make requests and ask questions to obtain information in familiar and unfamiliar contexts</i>	Award: 1 mark for answering question clearly 1
Make statements clearly	<i>SC E3.4 Express clearly statements of fact and give short accounts and descriptions</i>	Award: 1 mark for making statements clearly for some of the discussion. 2 marks for making statements clearly for most of the discussion. 2
