2.1	Upper and lower case use. <b>One</b> mark for correct use of upper and lower case letters together for all items. Note: do not penalise use of upper case letters for Full name or lower case for Email address. Note: do not accept the use of upper case letters for all items as the form does not request this.	1
2.1	Award <b>two</b> marks from the following three answers: <b>One</b> mark for correct use of numbers for Telephone number. Only accept a format that includes a national/local code then number or format of a mobile number. <b>One</b> mark for correct Flat/House number plus full Street name. <b>One</b> mark for correct use of numbers for Date of birth. Note: Accept any reasonable English date format. Award maximum of <b>two</b> marks.	2
2.1	<b>One</b> mark for correct use of numbers with capital letters for Postcode.	1
