1.1	<p>The <b>text</b> has an appropriate format to describe the scene in the picture, including an appropriate heading.</p> <p>Note: accept any relevant heading in the context of a library/students working in a library.</p>	1
1.2	<p>All <b>three</b> sentences use an appropriate word order, a correct verb form/adverbial time reference/noun phrases/prepositional phrases, where required, to convey the desired information.</p> <p>Allow <b>two</b> grammatical errors.</p>	1
1.2	<p>Candidate includes at least <b>one</b> compound sentence.</p> <p>Do not penalise if candidate uses a higher-level conjunction such as 'although', 'however', etc.</p>	1
1.3	<p>Candidate uses at least <b>two</b> appropriate adjectives.</p> <p>Award <b>one</b> mark per adjective used correctly.</p> <p>Award a maximum of <b>two</b> marks.</p>	2
1.4	<p>Candidate uses punctuation and capitalisation correctly as boundary markers for the <b>three</b> sentences.</p>	1
1.5	<p>Candidate uses upper and lower case letters correctly in the <b>three</b> sentences.</p>	1
1.6	<p>Candidate spells words correctly in the <b>three</b> sentences.</p> <p>Allow up to <b>two</b> spelling errors in total.</p>	1
