Q What is this qualification?

- A A 60 guided learning hour competency-based qualification that:
- helps students develop a thorough knowledge and understanding of concepts in number and measure
 - is available at Levels 1 and 2.

Q Who can take this qualification?

- A This qualification is funded and approved for:
- pre-16 and 16-18 year-olds in England
 - schools and colleges in Wales.

Q Which students is it suitable for?

- A The Edexcel Awards in Number and Measure suit students who:
- need to develop their basic mathematical skills and build confidence in the subject before progressing to GCSE Mathematics
 - want to gain a qualification which demonstrates their mathematical ability.

Q Why does this qualification make sense for my students?

- A This qualification makes sense for students because:
- the content is a sub-set of the GCSE Mathematics content
 - it helps to build students' confidence when using mathematics
 - it is available at Level 1 and Level 2, with clear progression between the levels
 - it helps develop a proficiency in number and measures to support progression to further studies, the workplace or training.

Q When is this qualification available for teaching and when is the first examination?

- A You can start teaching this qualification now. It is assessed through one written paper available each summer.
