You read the following article in the local newspaper.

## See you there?

Dintone Animal Sanctuary was set up in 2005 by a group of volunteers. Today, its aim remains the same – to rescue sick and abandoned animals in the town of Dintone and the surrounding area.

The sanctuary has many supporters and has gone from strength to strength. In 2012 it was able to buy a much larger site on Rocky Road. Now, with 40 acres of land, it can take in horses and donkeys as well as the usual cats, dogs and smaller animals. With an increased number of volunteers, visitors can be shown around the sanctuary. Beside the main entrance there are two car parking spaces for people with disabilities.

The next Open Day will be held on 17 June. The theme is 'Children and Animals' and the organisers are hoping to attract even more children than in previous years. As well as puppies, there will be lambs, pony rides and face painting. There is no charge for any activity.

Children can visit the wildlife cabin that opened in 2015, which has proved popular and led to an increase in school trips. On the Open Day each child will be able to feed a hedgehog, supervised by a wildlife expert. They can see a young fox and other rescued wild animals. There will be a free children's picnic at 3pm in the wildflower meadow.

On the Open Day, all children under the age of 12 will be given free worksheets and coloured pencils. They can sit in the children's area on bales of straw, do the puzzles and colour in the pictures.

For anyone who cannot go to the Open Day, the sanctuary welcomes visitors every day between 10am and 4pm.

Dintone Animal Sanctuary would like to appoint a new Press Officer. The role of the Press Officer is to work closely with local newspapers to print our animal stories. This is important. We are able to find good homes for many of our animals when people read about them and see their photographs. We also receive increased donations to help our work and many people offer to volunteer.

Our present Press Officer, Alan Sharpe, is a former nurse who has three dogs and two cats. All his animals have been re-homed from the sanctuary and eight years ago he became our Press Officer. Alan has worked hard to develop an excellent relationship with the Dintone Daily News and with the Dintone Herald. This keeps our work in the public eye. Each weekend, the Dintone Herald has an *Animal Friends* page featuring our dogs and cats. Alan writes the stories about these animals and his wife, Judith, takes their photographs. Alan and Judith have now decided to retire and would like someone to take over.

The new Press Officer will continue Alan's work. The successful applicant must be able to write effectively and be able to commit between four and six hours per week. Although we increasingly use social media for publicity, some of our supporters rely on newspapers to keep informed. Having press coverage has helped us to re-home many of our older, less active animals.

The personal qualities of the new Press Officer are important. The successful applicant must care about animals, be outgoing and have a positive attitude. They need to be able to communicate well and look for solutions to problems. This is voluntary, unpaid work so the Press Officer must be passionate about rescue.
