

		Award 1 mark if all four letters are written in upper case in any order.

2	E1.12	Jack lives in England.	1
		Award 1 mark for the correct sentence using the capital 'E'. Do not penalise other copying errors.	

Question	Target	Composition criteria	Mark
3	E1.16	Award 1 mark each for stating:	4
		one thing they like about the town (1)	
		a second thing they like about the town (1)	
		 one thing they don't like about the town (1) 	
		 a second thing they don't like about the town. (1) 	
		For E1.16, marks should be awarded if the information has been communicated in a way that can be understood. Errors that do not detract from this should not be penalised.

	E1.11	Award 1 mark for at least one sentence with the correct use of a capital letter at the start and full stop at the end.	1
	E1.13	Award 1 mark for correct use of lower case letters. Allow one error.	1
	E1.15	Award 1 mark for correct spelling. Allow two errors if at least one sentence has been written.	1
