Bowl a strike



Lessons Learnt

Lessons Learnt

- All three learners were able to pick out a similarity.
- There were more issues with providing supporting quotes. Learners need to ensure that these quotes are written full enough to get the marks.
- One useful activity with these texts would be to get the learners to find as many similarities as they can – as per the mark scheme – then systematically work through the texts to get the evidence.
- Another idea would be for the learners to work in pairs, with one text each. They read then discuss with each other to find similarities and the supporting evidence.
