	<p>Share lesson objectives</p> <p>Introduce the lesson and share learning objectives and outcomes.</p>	5 mins
	<p>Using ICT to communicate</p> <p>Ask students to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • set up an email folder called SB82 • complete Skill Builders 8.2 with just three contacts who have email addresses they can access in this lesson • reply to incoming messages (one reply per email only) • move all emails linked to the Skill Builder into the new folder 	10 mins
	<p>Using ICT to collaborate</p> <p>Take students through section B Collaborative working (page 9)</p> <p>Through discussion cover:</p> <p>Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) or Managed Learning Environment (MLE)</p> <p>social networks - have students used them for other purposes, e.g. learning?</p> <p>Skype or other such global systems</p> <p>shared online spaces</p> <p>For all, ask some about their own experiences, the pros and cons.</p> <p>Ask students to spend 10 minutes researching Google docs:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. what features does it have that support collaborative working? 2. how do you manage information and keep control of your own information when using Google docs? <p>For the second question refer students to Study Module 2.</p>	20 mins
	<p>Feedback</p> <p>Ask students to report their findings and discuss them as a group.</p> <p>Finish the activity by asking how students can stay safe when using ICT to collaborate.</p>	10 mins

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	<p>Plenary</p> <p>Remind students of the learning objectives and recap on what they have learnt in this and the previous lesson.</p> <p>Conclude with the Skill Check, Knowledge Check and what students can expect in the test.</p>	10 mins
Homework	<p>Ask students to:</p> <p>(1) tidy up their mailbox, e.g. delete mail folder SB82</p> <p>(2) create and save a one-page text document with</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a table listing in descending order of importance five advantages and five disadvantages of online collaborative working• a personal statement saying whether or not they would use ICT to collaborate if they could do it face-to-face - and why.	30 mins
