Anton says there are 8 adults.

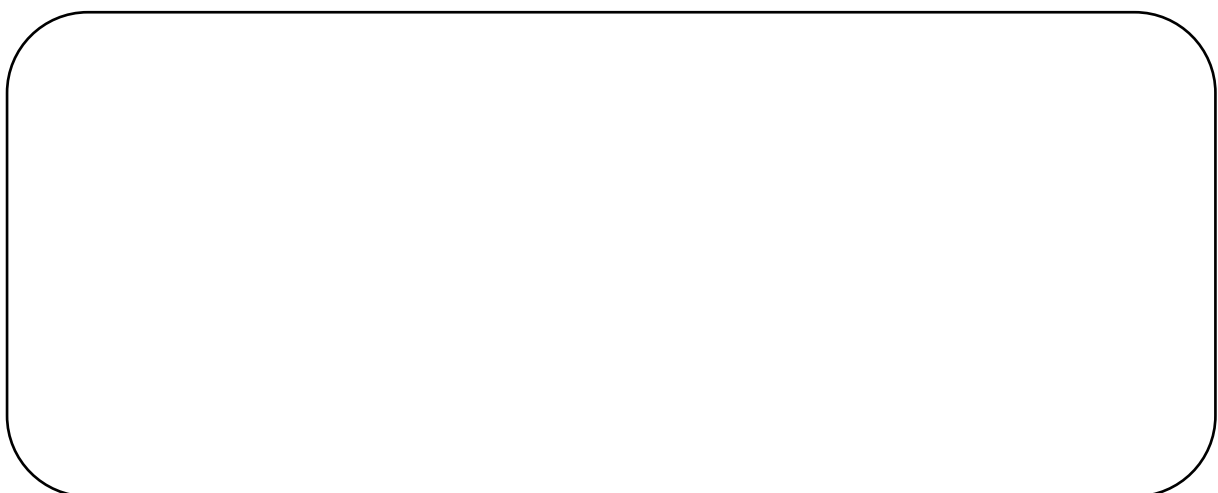
Is Anton correct?

He sees 7 patients in the afternoon.

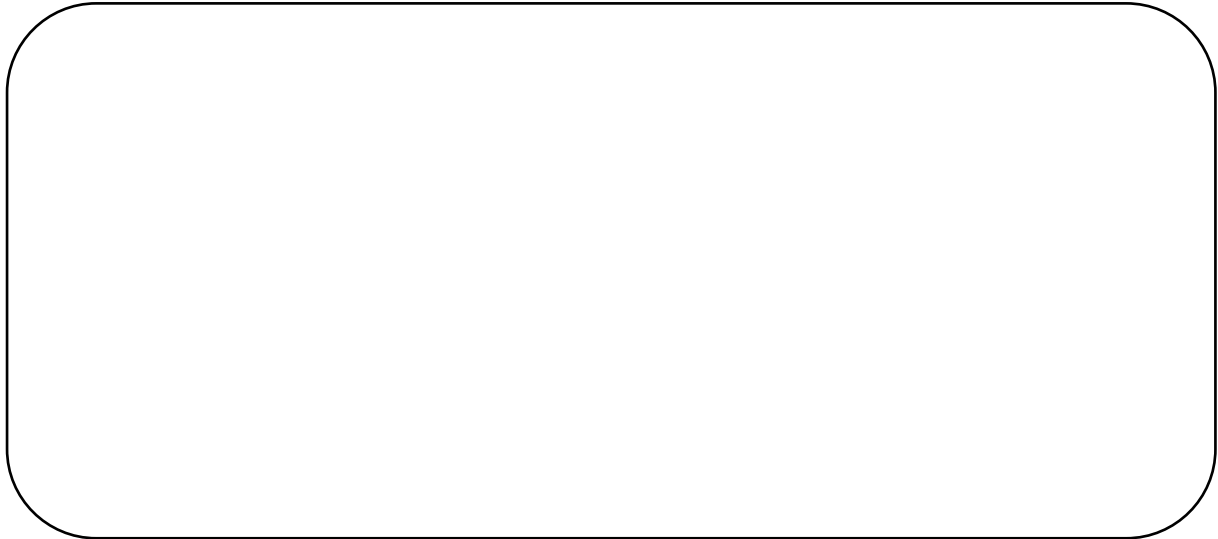
How many patients does Ao see in total?

How many prescriptions does he fill altogether?

5. Leoni is a doctor. She prescribes medicine for patients.

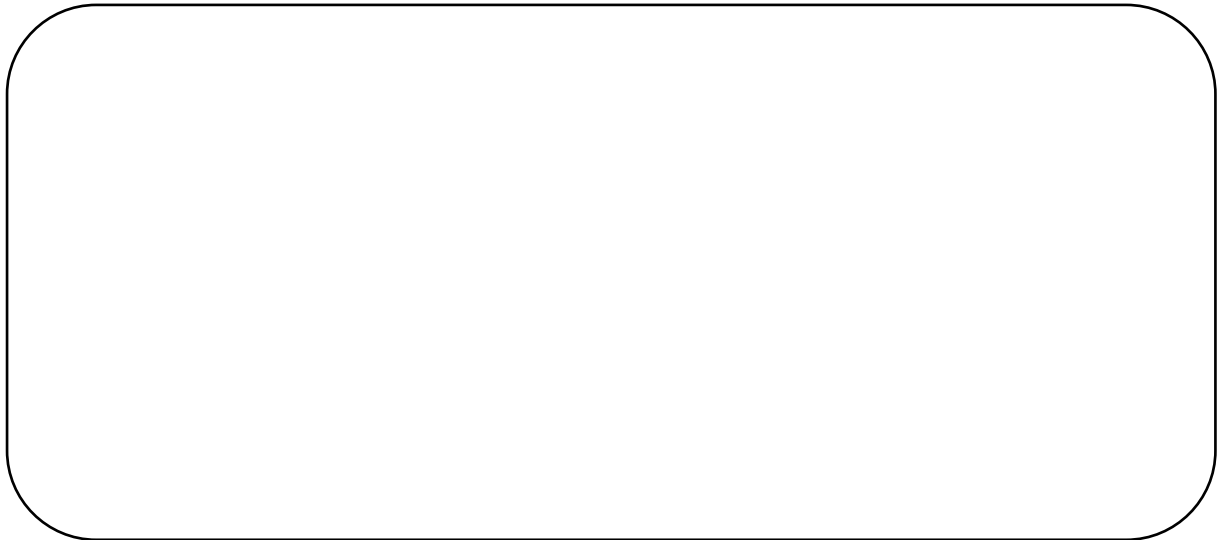
On Tuesday she prescribes 11 bottles of medicine.

On Wednesday she prescribes 7 bottles of medicine.

She thinks she prescribes 20 bottles of medicine in total.

Is Leoni correct?
