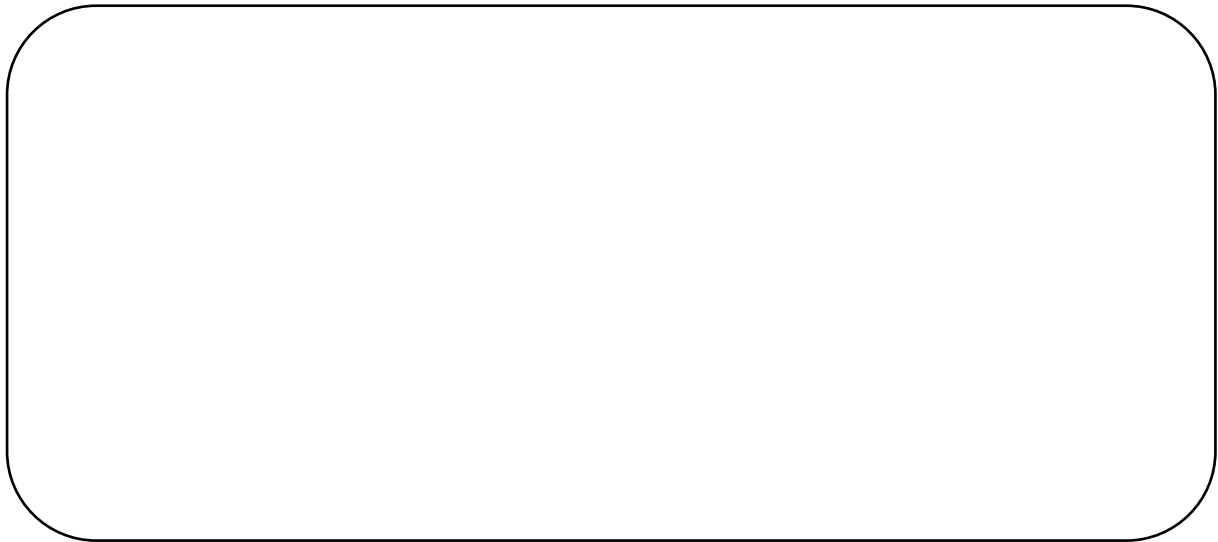

- Shelf D: 10 books

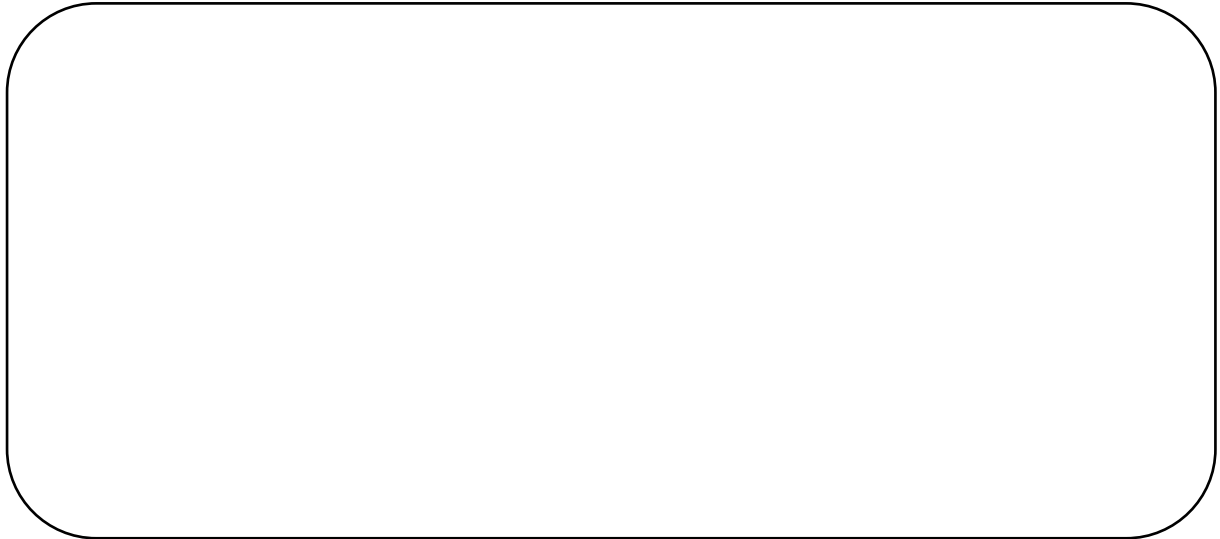
How many more books are on shelf D than shelf A?

5. Aiko borrows books from the library.

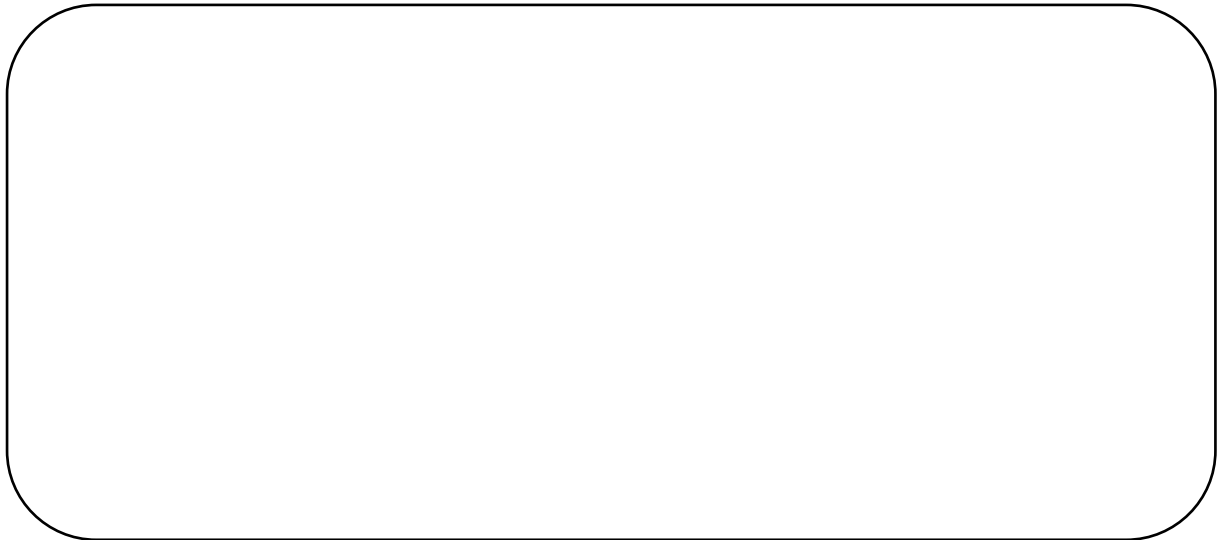
She borrows 12 books in May.
