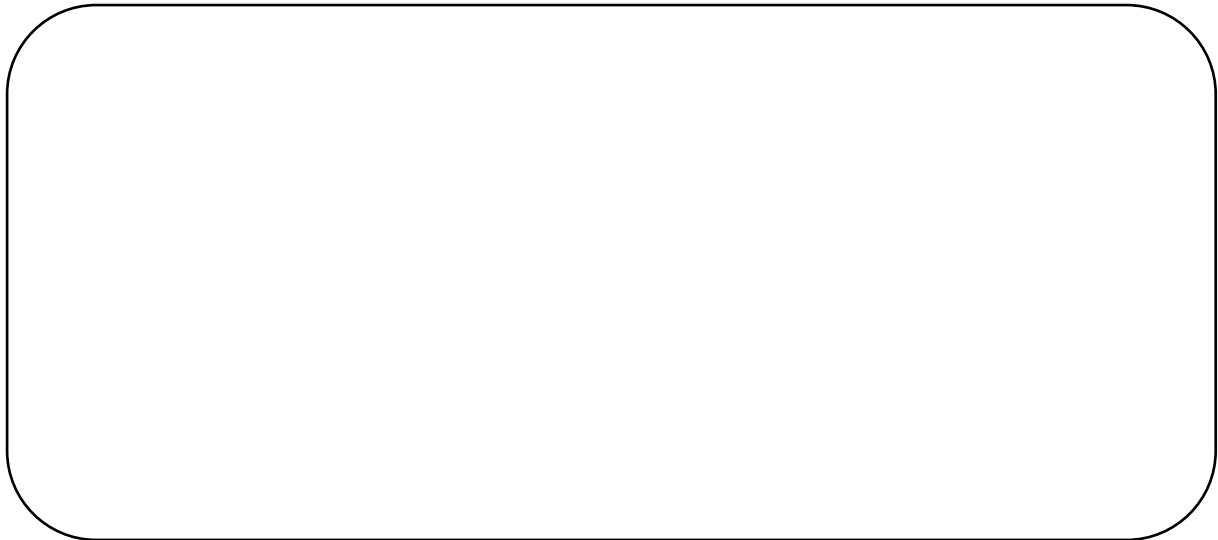

How many more books are on shelf D than shelf A?

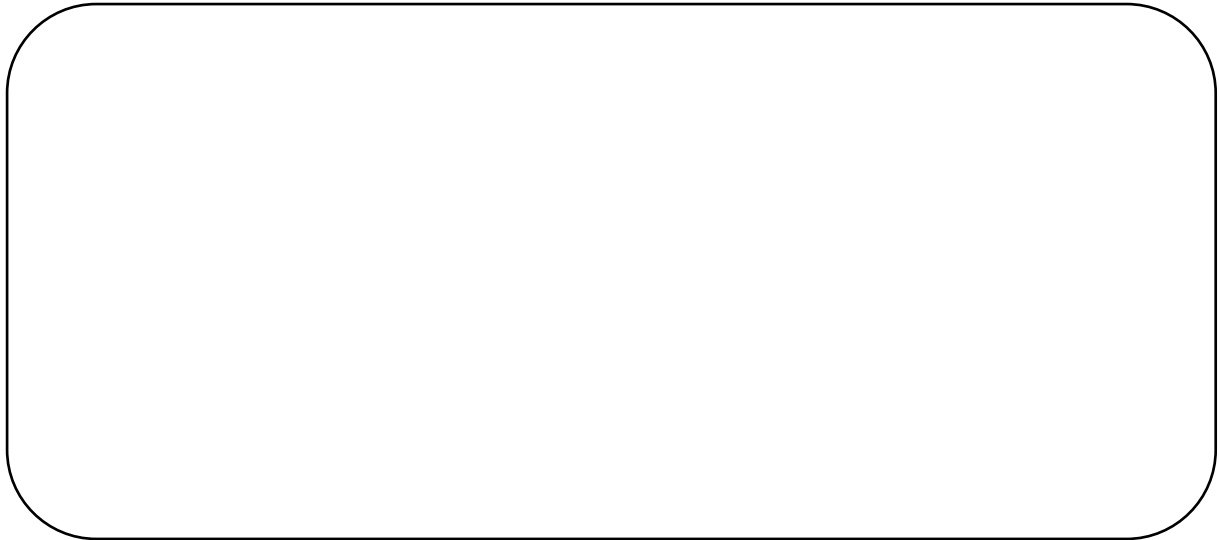


3. Sam buys a shirt from the charity shop.

Show how Maki can check her answer.

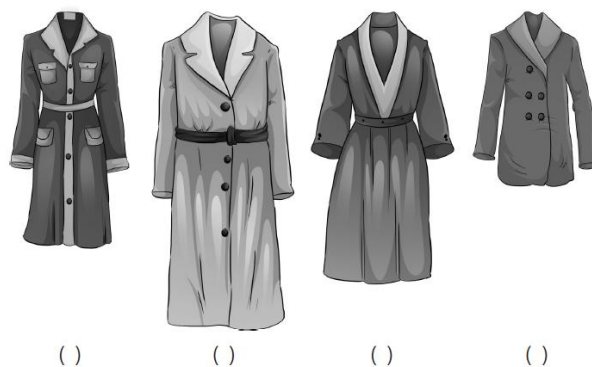
6. Leon volunteers in a charity shop.

Which coat does the customer choose?

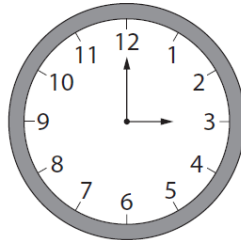

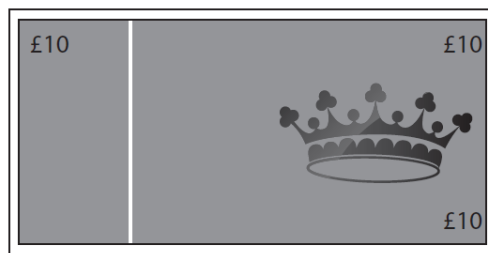

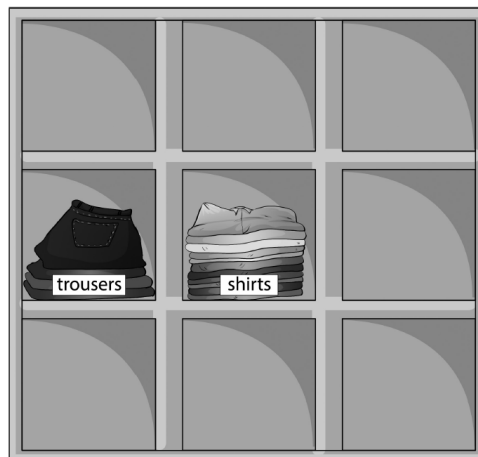

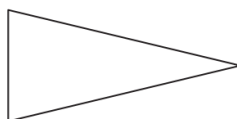

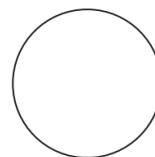

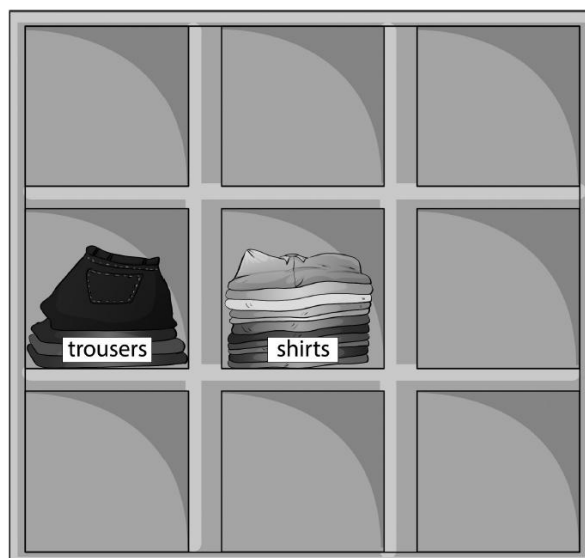

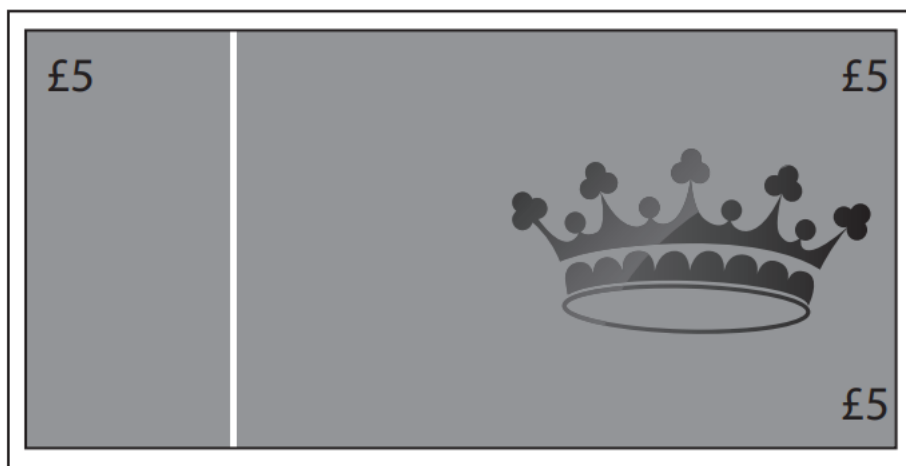

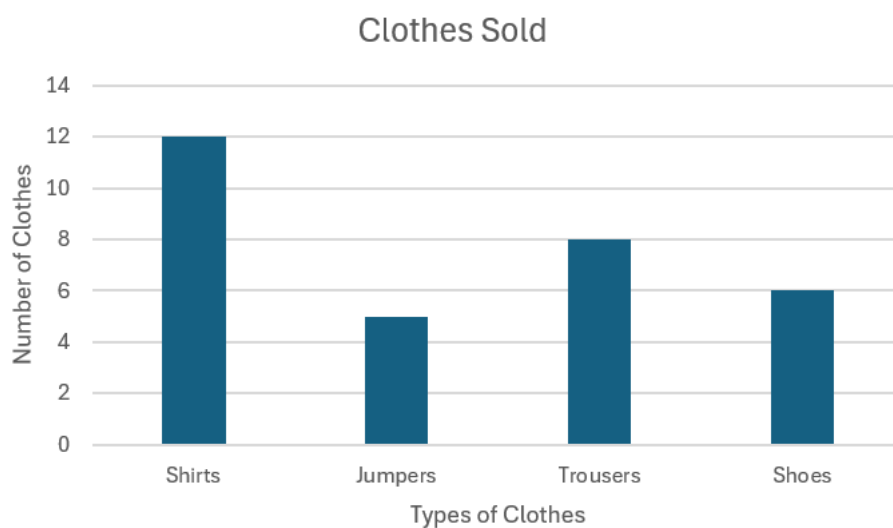

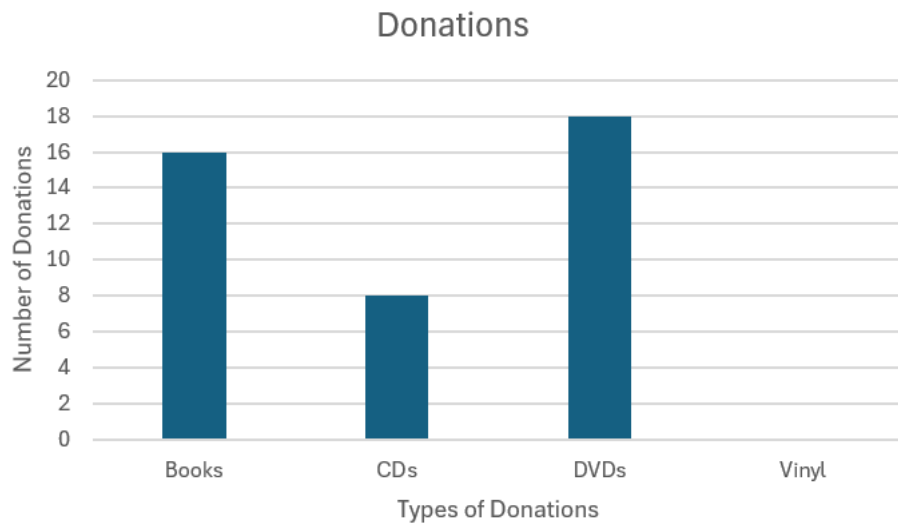
