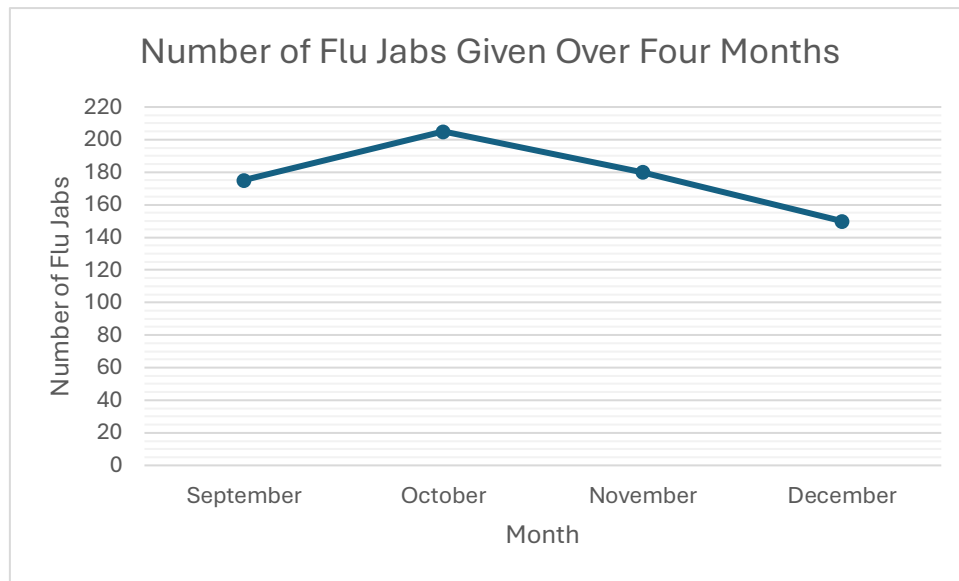

He has drawn a graph of the number of flu jabs he gave over four months.



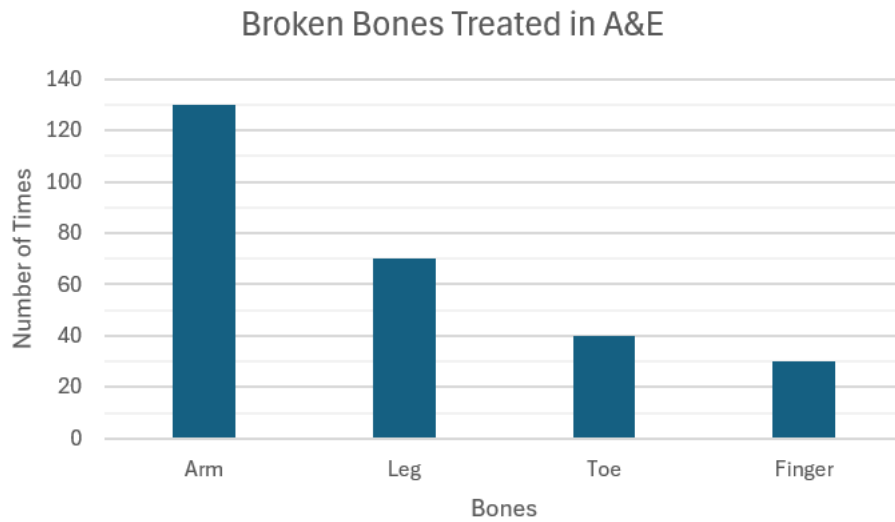
Ira thinks that the total number of flu jabs in October and November is greater than 400.

He has a chart of the broken bones that were treated last month.

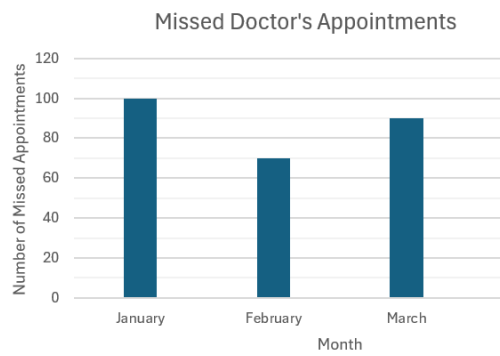


Facundo says half of all the broken bones treated were arms.
