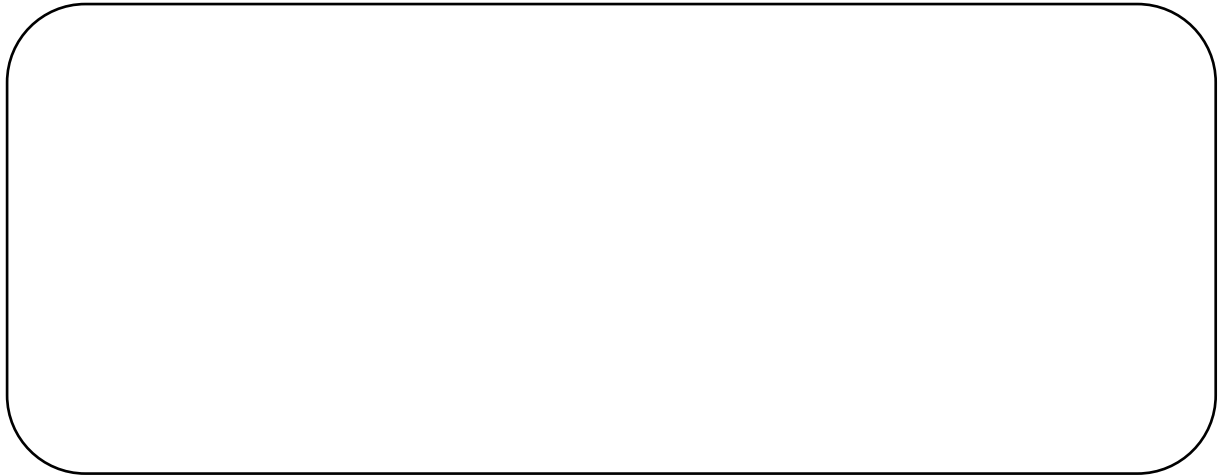

How many patients can be seen at the surgery in a week?



3. Pascal has been prescribed some tablets.

He needs to take three tablets, three times a day.

There are 50 tablets in the packet.

How many full days of tablets does Pascal have?

How many tablets are left?

4. Lucy has recorded her heart rate to show her doctor.

Resting Heart Rate
58bpm

Active Heart Rate
126bpm

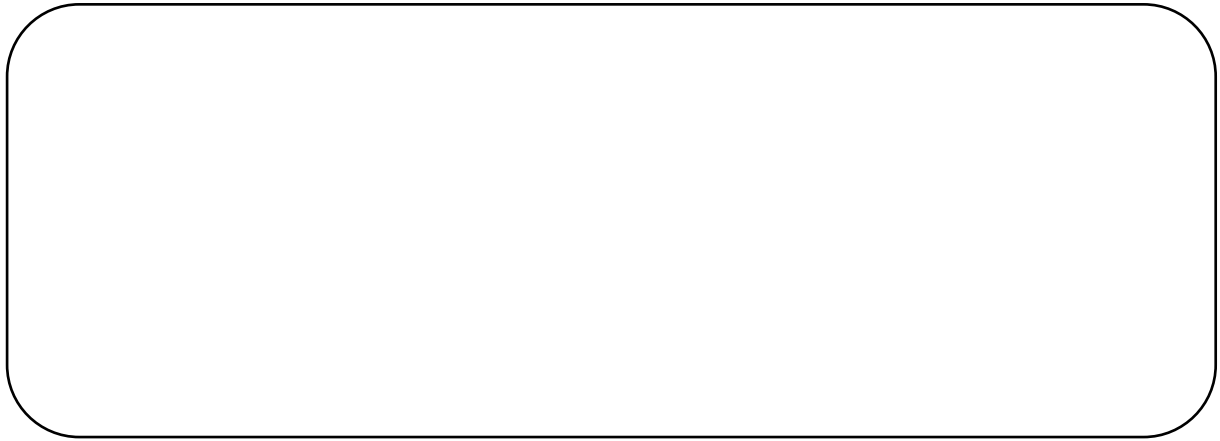
What is the difference between Lucy's resting heart rate and her active heart rate?

5. Andi's doctor recommended that she drinks at least 1000ml of water each day.

Andi keeps a record of how much water she drinks for 28 days.

Andi says she drank less than 1000ml of water on a $\frac{1}{4}$ of the days.

How many days did Andi drink less than 1000ml of water?
