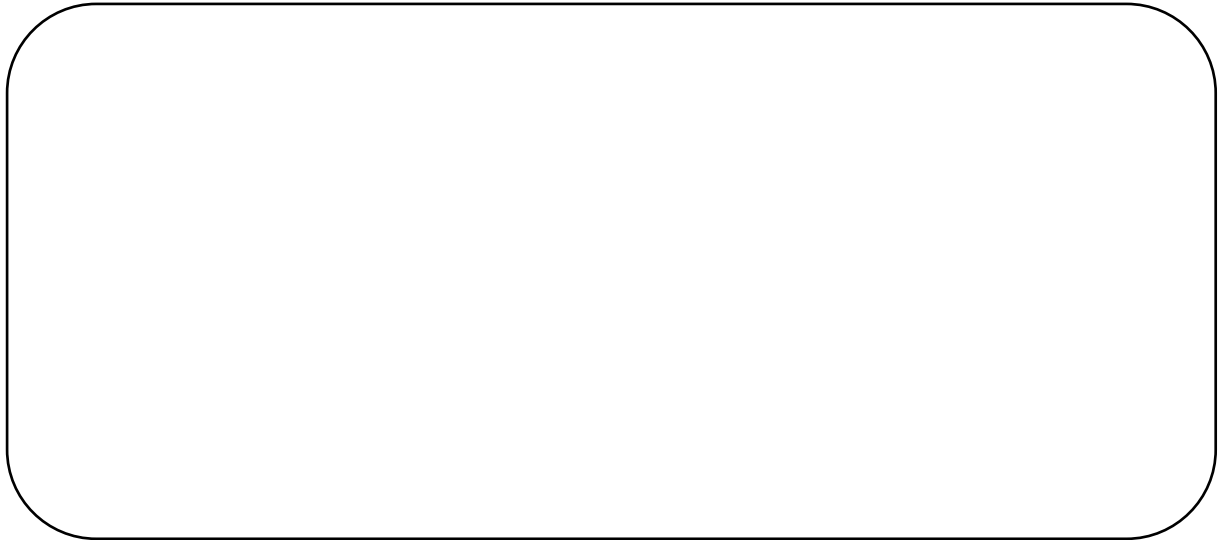

How many historical novels does she borrow in a year?

4. Tim enjoys reading.

He keeps a record of how many pages he reads.

469 pages read

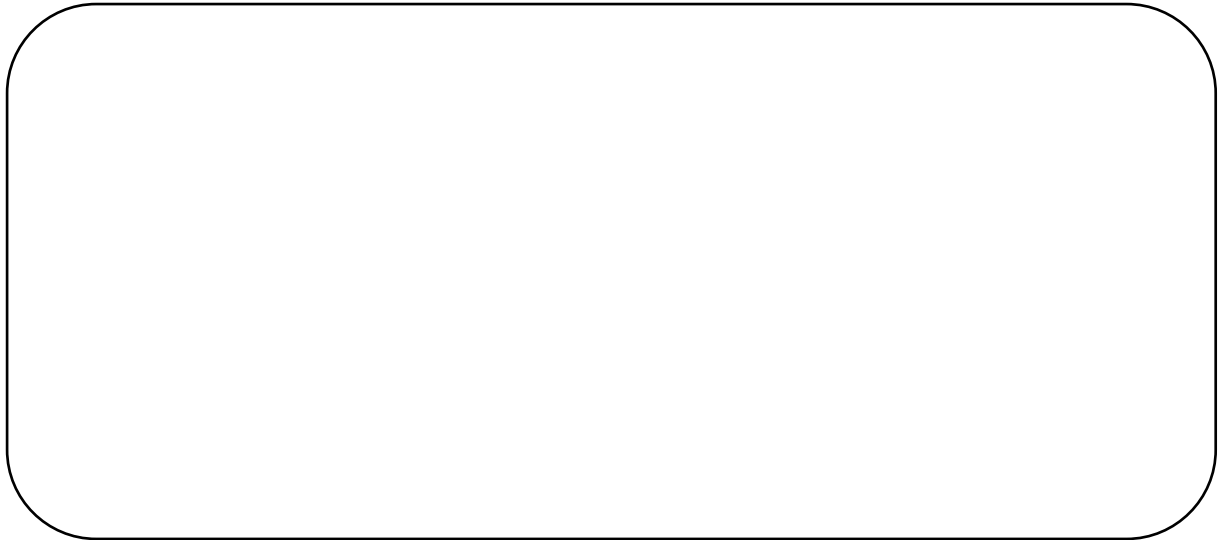
How many pages does he read in total?
