3. Jacob books a climbing activity for him and his friends.

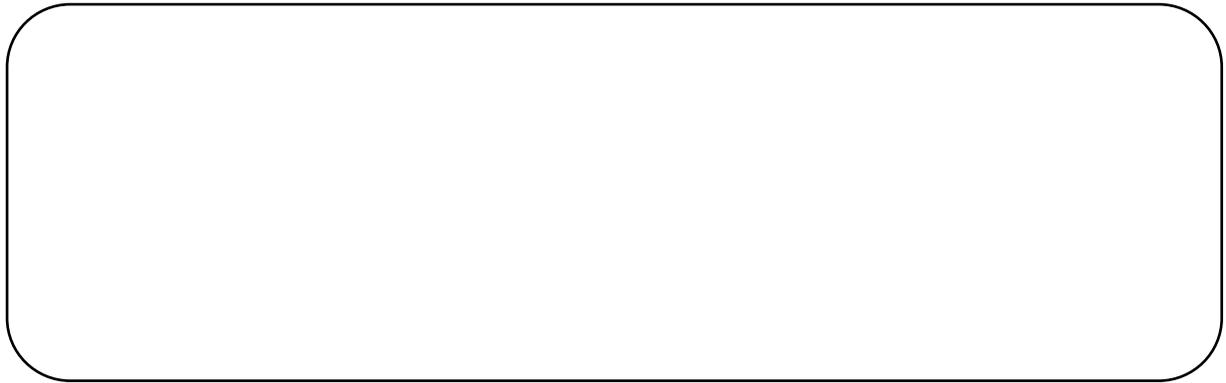
He knows how many people in total will go.

How can you work out how much they will save?

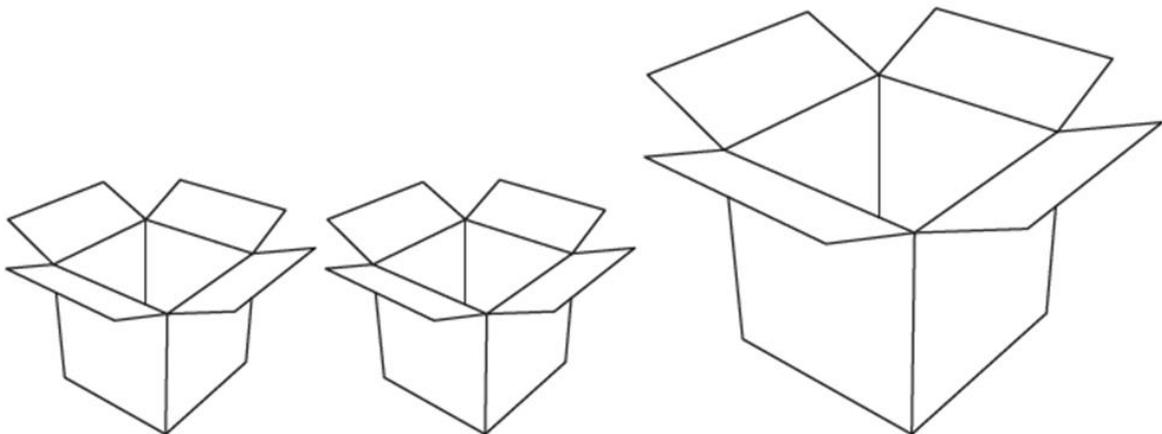


5. Abi is putting books on shelves in her shop.
