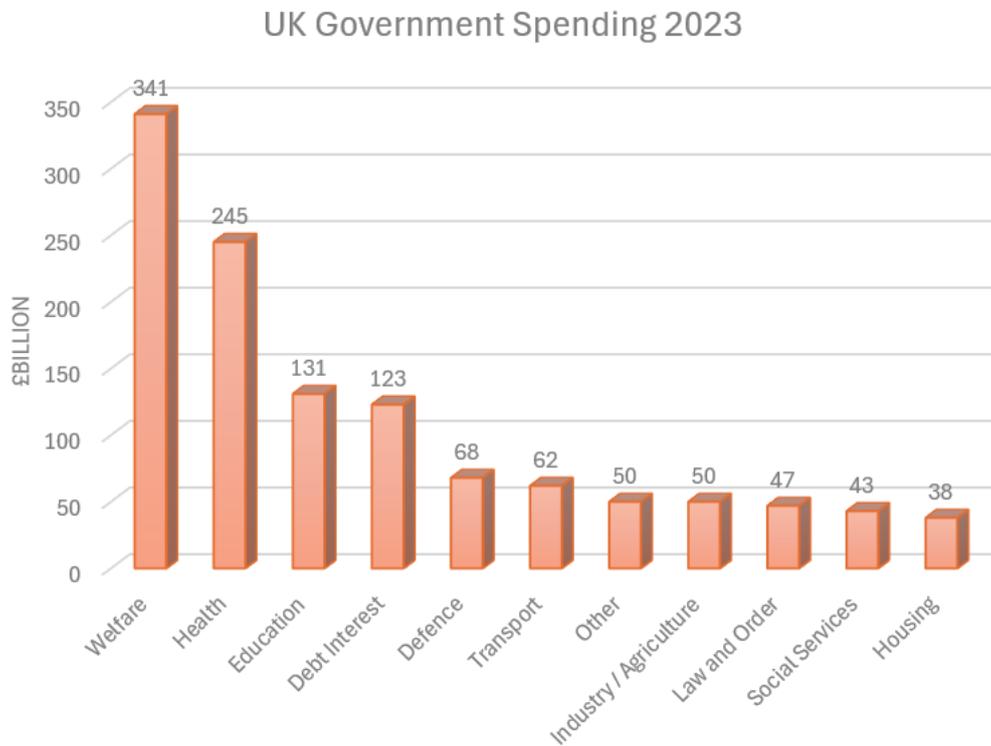


## Functional Skills Maths | Level 1 and 2 Government Spending

6. Using estimation, what fraction of the total Government spend was on debt interest? Simplify the fraction.

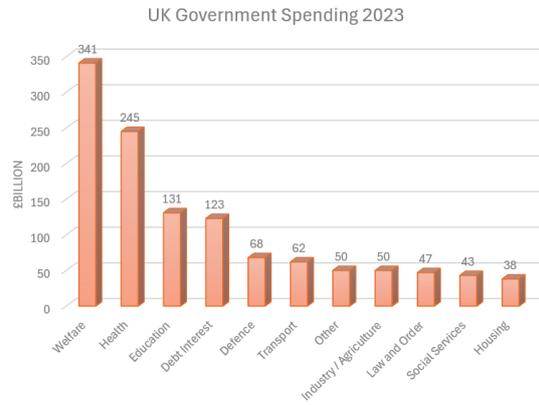
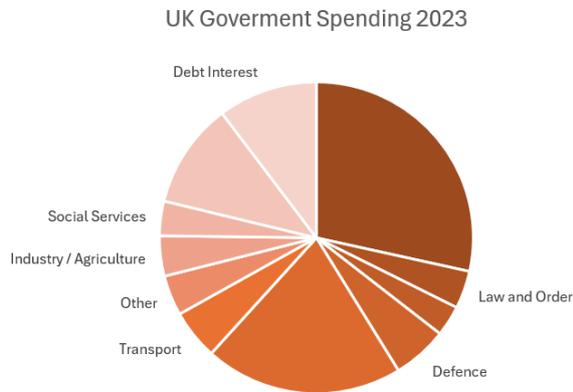
7. If education spending increased by 15%, what would be the new total Government spend on education?
