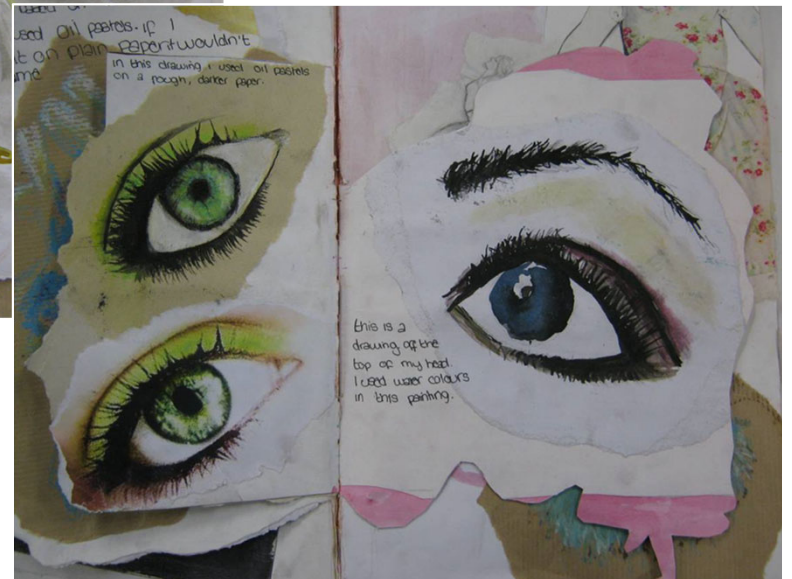


In these paintings I used different types of water colour. I really like it but if I was to do another one I think I would use oil pastel.

this is a rough drawing of an eye using a coloured rough paper



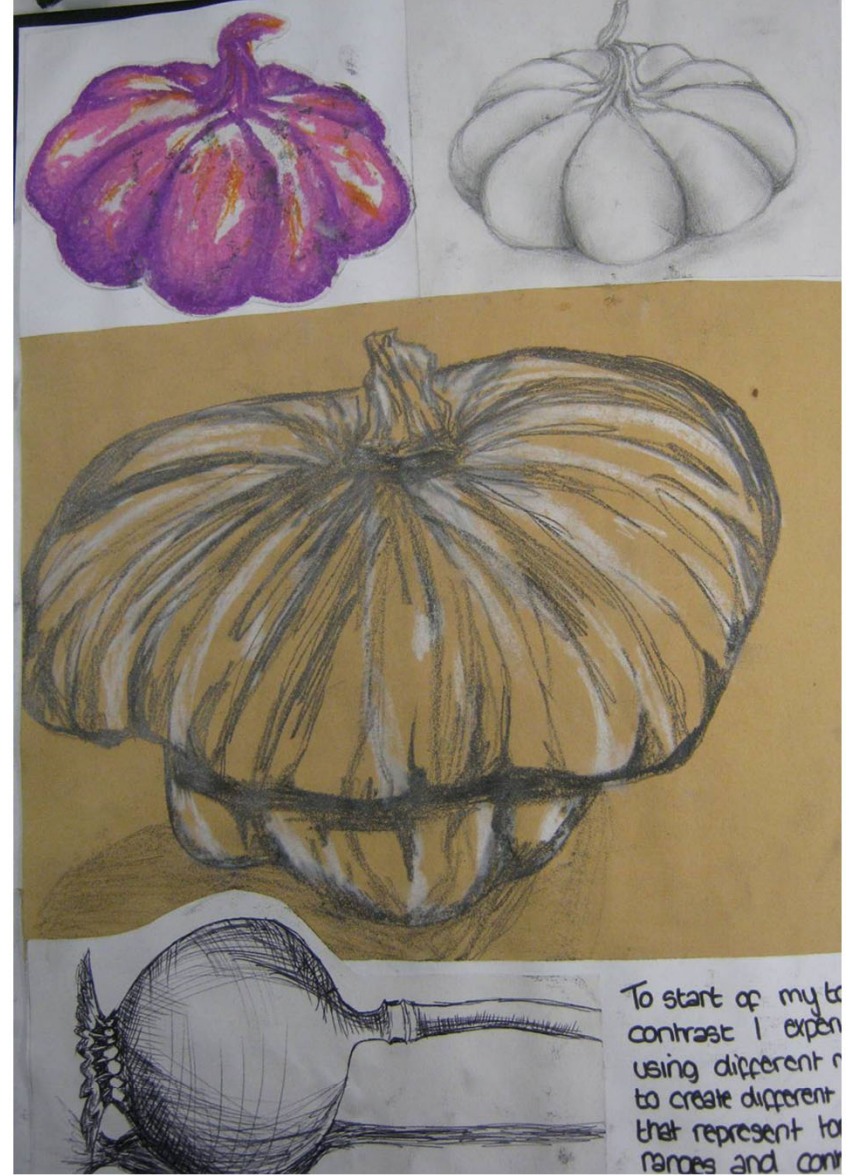
I used oil pastels - if I used it on plain paper it wouldn't be the same. In this drawing, I used oil pastels on a rough, darker paper.

this is a drawing of the top of my head I used water colours in this painting.

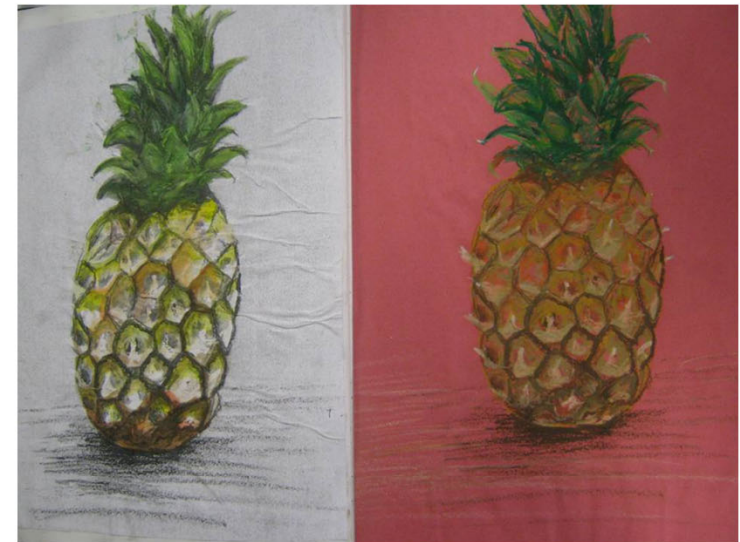
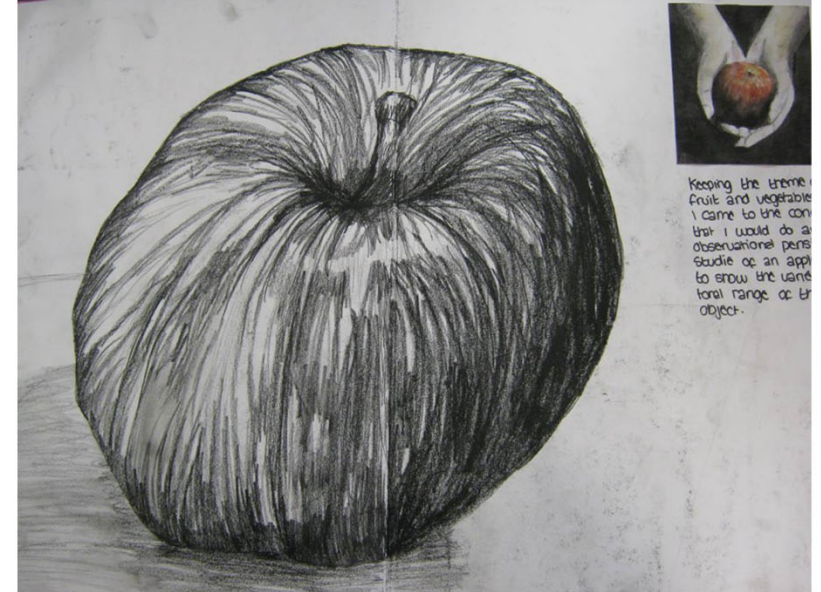

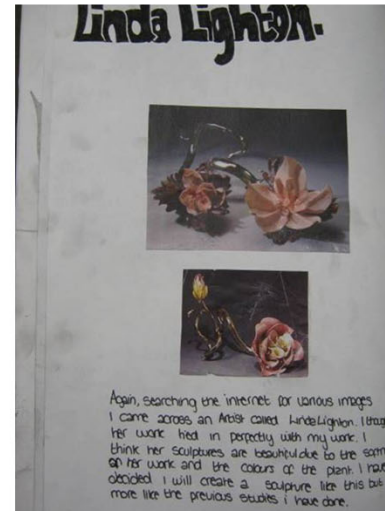
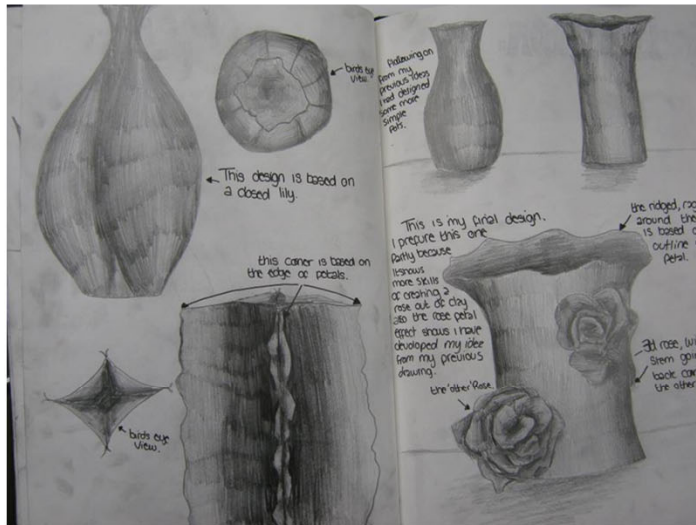
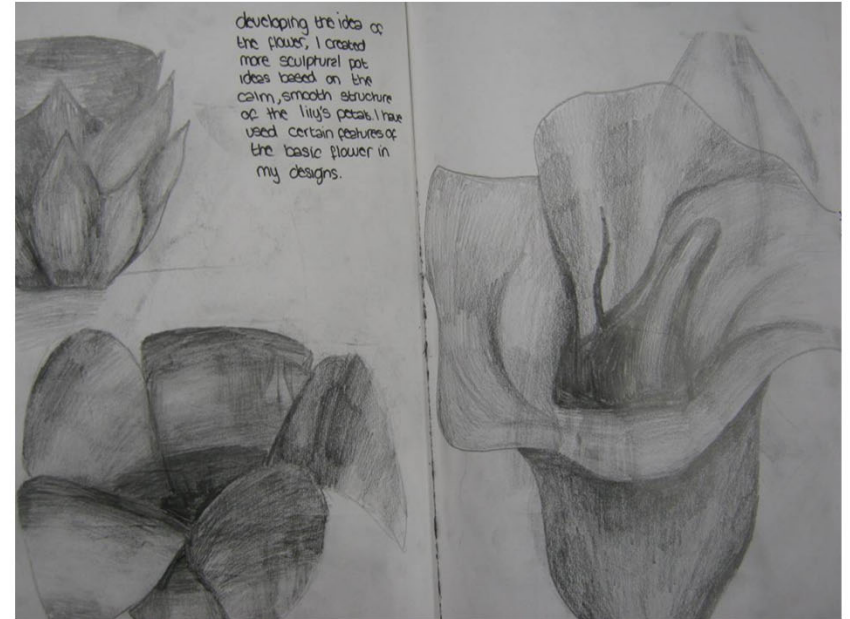
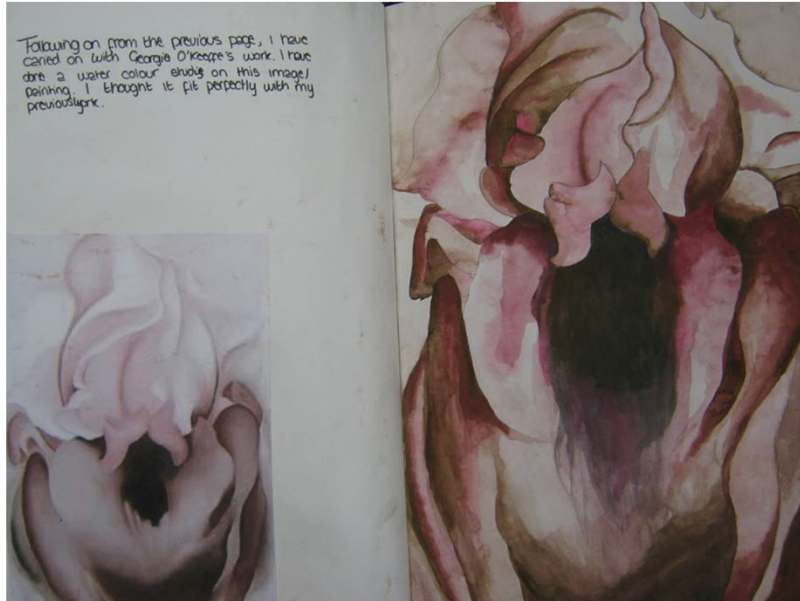


# Georgia O'Keeffe
