
If I could make this piece a bit better, I would change the two pieces that are covered in black paint. I think changing it up could make the whole piece a lot tresher and cleaner.




Figal Piece plan


I blought of the idea of balancing with another piece I made or the bottom left, It all started off with Barriors and a piece by Ne






I draw some more designes related to the one I researched about, It it looked more similar than the one I drew before I think it turned out ok, it will be better if I deffinish the whole piece.




I used packaging northways to make this model, the connections between piece to piece are connected by nives, this design is bely difficult to acher so I might need to switch up my designs in order for this to work.

Each of Andre's eight sculptures in the Equivalent series Consists of a rectangle rectangular arrangment of 120 five-bricks. Although the shape of each sculpture is different, they all have the same height = mass and volume.





Ecorpelia Parker




This piece by Cornelia is very unique, it feels is something I am working towards to what it feels like, the way everything is not connected and it feels like it Cxploded.












Final coursework evaluation

them into 1 piece.


Designs



Outcome of first practical




Fort this piece, I used clay and wire to create this effect, the challenge was figuring out how to put the black stripes on, I over came the challenge by using some masking tapes,





