

## Revised forms for controlled assessment

## Controlled assessment: Speaking

Following feedback from summer 2010, and to reduce the amount of form-filling for you, a **new combined mark sheet/authentication form\*** has been produced for the speaking unit. This replaces the form in the specification and you should use the latest combined form.

\*If you have already completed previous versions of the new form, it is still possible for you to submit these by **May 15 2011**. You will need to complete the **new forms for all future controlled assessment submissions**.

## Controlled assessment: Writing

Please note that the Controlled Assessment Authenticity Record Sheet: Writing that appears in the specification has also now been replaced by a **new Candidate Mark Sheet for Unit 4: Writing**. This includes authentication statements and space for you to insert the task titles as well as space for Edexcel examiners to insert marks. Please use the new form or transfer information from the previous version of the form. Your cooperation is much appreciated, as the introduction of the new form will help to streamline the overall administration process both for teachers and for examiners.
