

GCSE English Language 1EN0 and 1EN2 (2.0) results: Making sure your students have the information they need for possible resits


Students who wish to resit 1EN0 or 1EN2 carrying forward their Spoken Language Endorsement (SLE) result are entered for '1EN0 T' or '1EN2 T'. In order for a centre to use this entry code, they need to have seen evidence that the student achieved 'Pass', 'Merit' or 'Distinction' on their previous attempt at the 1EN0/1EN2 SLE (or the SLE result from another awarding organisation's 9-1 GCSE in English Language). For this reason, it is important that centres opt in to receiving printed Candidate Statement of Provisional Results (CSPR) or provide them for students themselves.

The entry deadline for the November 2023 exam series is 4 October 2023. Students will not receive their hard copy GCSE certificates (which also provide evidence of SLE achievement) for the June 2023 exam series before 8 November 2023. This means that students wishing to resit in November using 1EN0 T or 1EN2 T require alternative evidence.

SLE video samples

Centres submit separate video samples for 1EN0 and 1EN2 (30 video recordings for each). A videorecording is not required for students who are using the 1EN0 T or 1EN2 T entry codes, but these codes may only be used if evidence of a pass on the SLE has been seen by the entering centre.

The CSPR provides the result achieved for the SLE, as is shown (circled in blue) in the sample below:

Students should be informed that they need to retain the CSPR and take it with them if enrolling at a college so that the new centre has the details they need to make an entry for 1EN0 T or 1EN2 T.

Using the same UCI when making resit entries

The student's UCI (circled in red) is also shown on the CSPR. Centres entering a candidate for a resit for 1EN0 T or 1EN2 T need to use the same UCI so that the student's previous SLE result can be retrieved.

How do I opt into hard copy CSPR?

- Log into Edexcel Online
- Select 'GCSE' from the qualification drop-down on the left.
- Select 'Results'
- Select 'Results'
- Select 'Report Delivery Options'
- Tick the 'Paper' box for 'Candidate Statement Provisional Results'.

What is the deadline for opting into paper CSPRs?

31 July 2023 for June 2023 results.

Can I also download a student's CSPR from Edexcel Online?
