

Question style for 1ENO November 2017 and summer 2018

This table provides an overview of the question style used in the November 2017 and summer 2018 question papers. The questions are abbreviated.

In summer 2019, amendments to paper 2 will come into effect. Where a question is highlighted on this grid it reflects the updated question style. Updated versions of each paper that has previously been sat or made available will replace the original versions on the website in September 2018.
