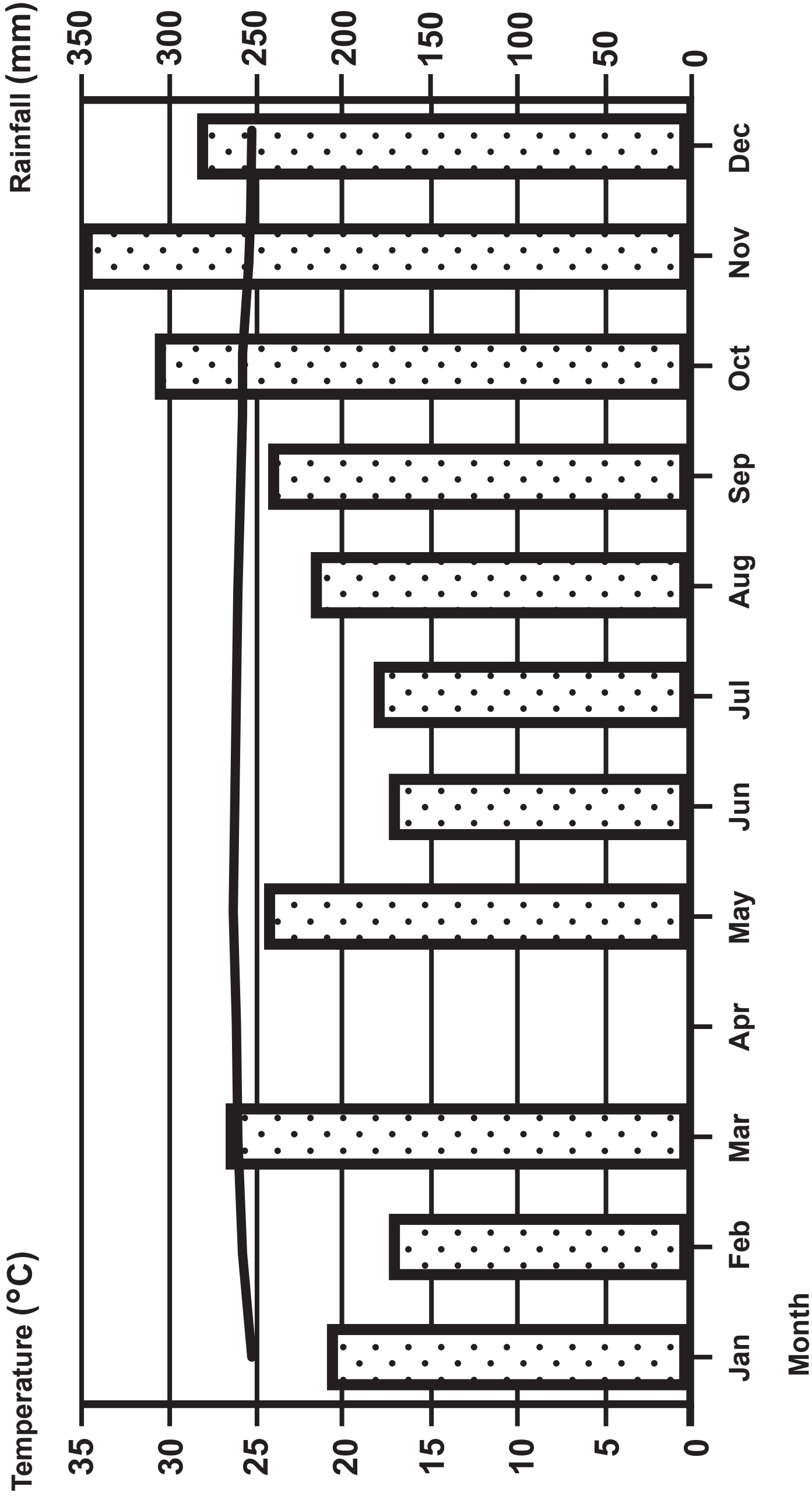

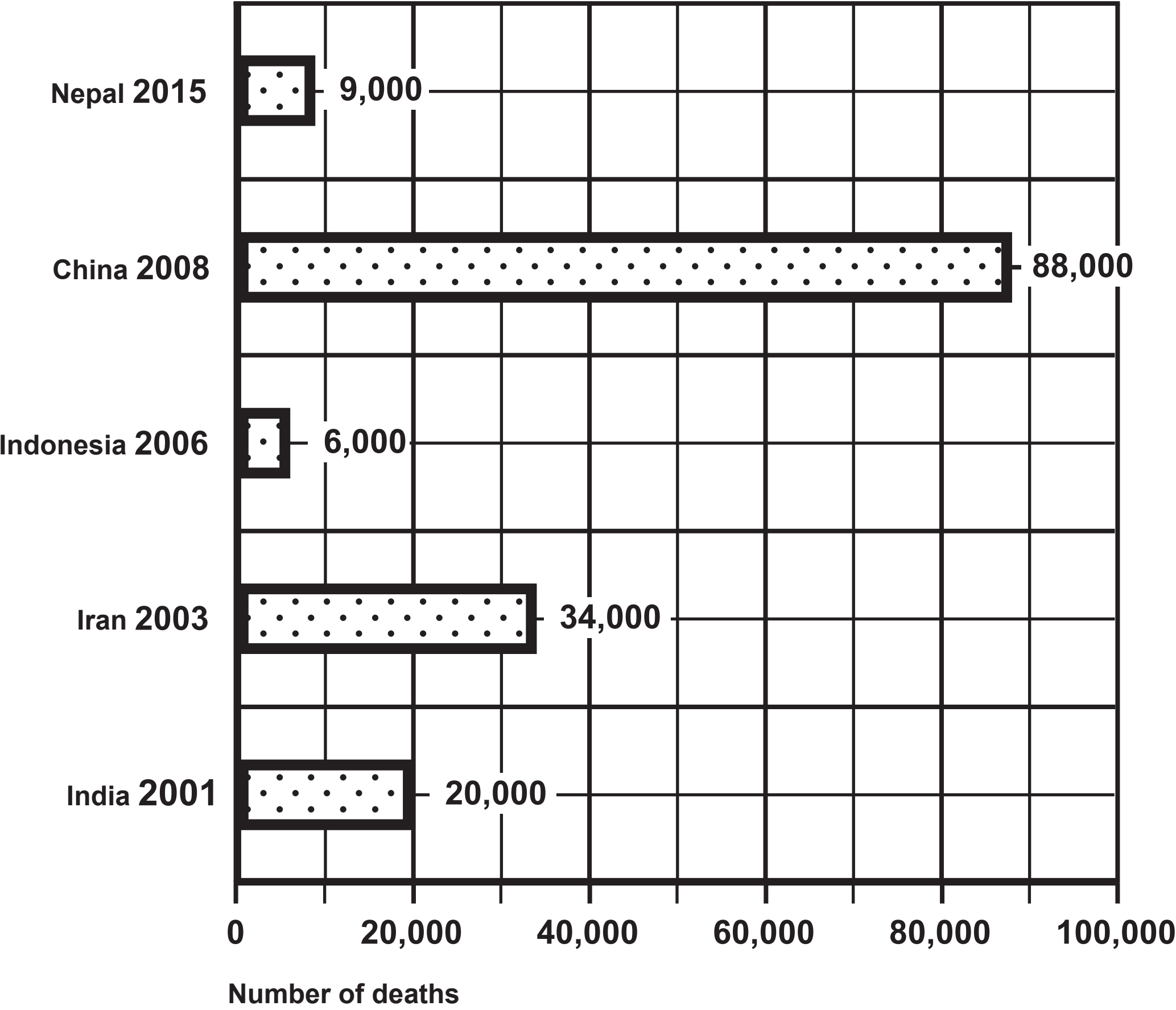

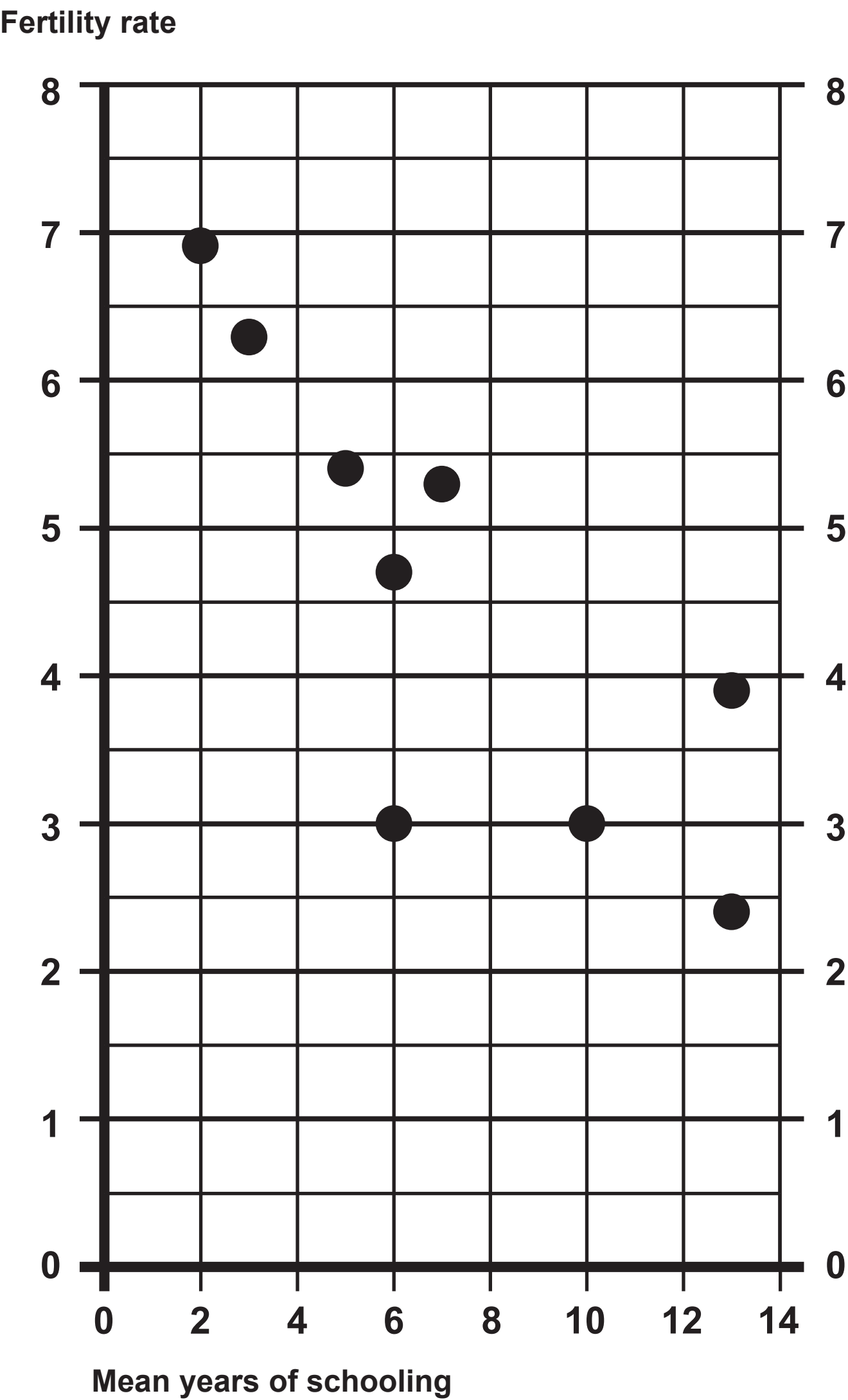

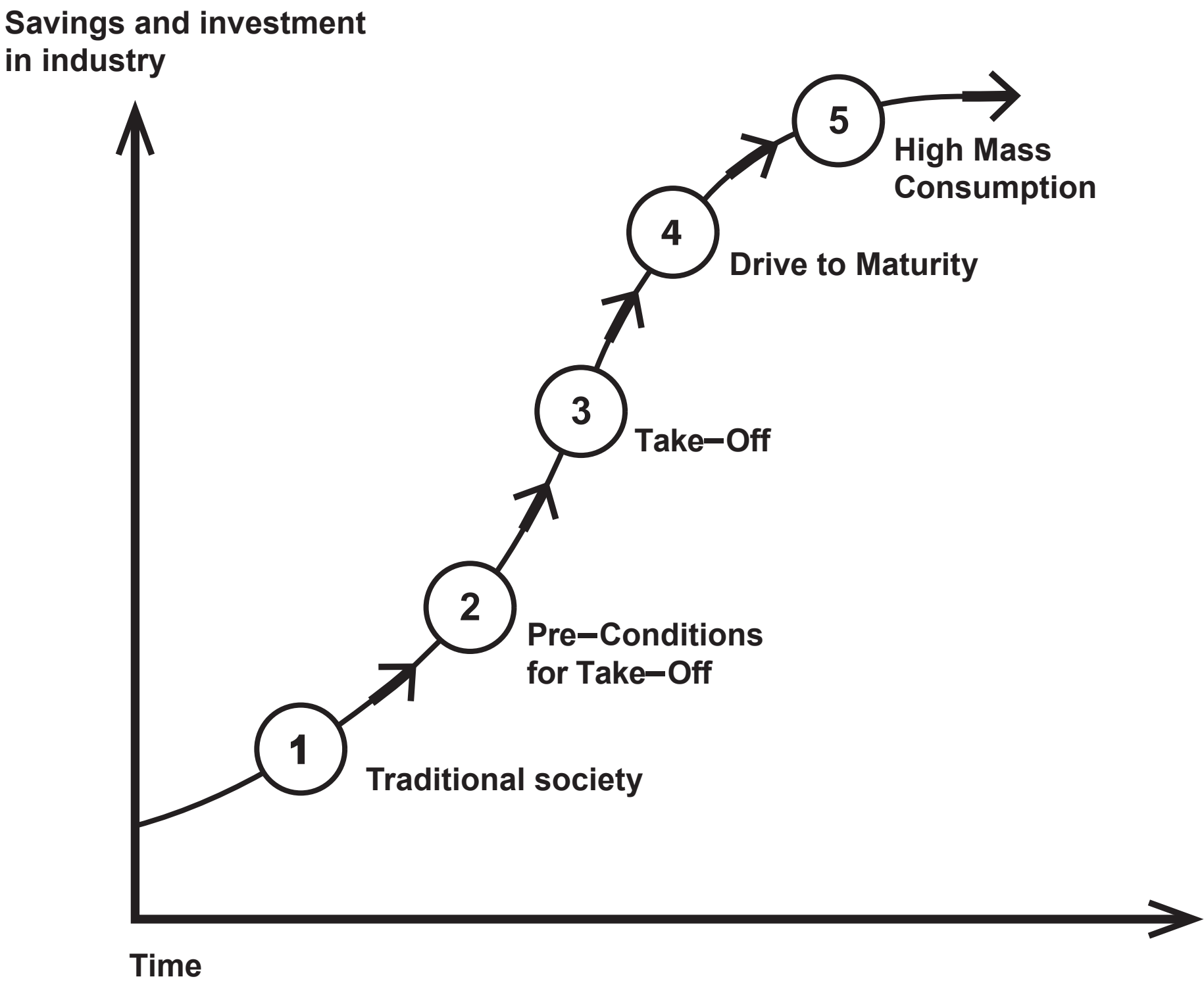

- Other

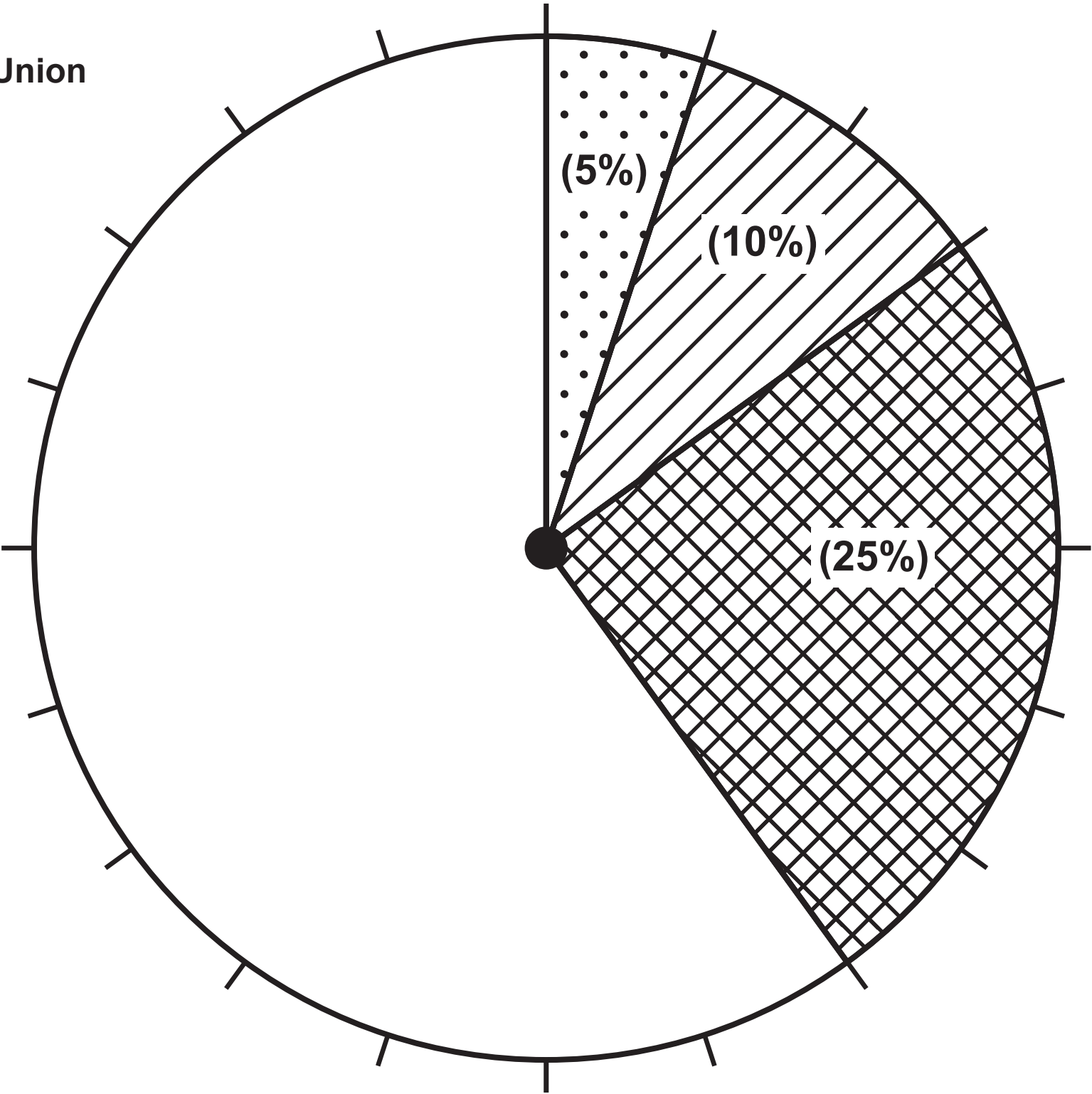

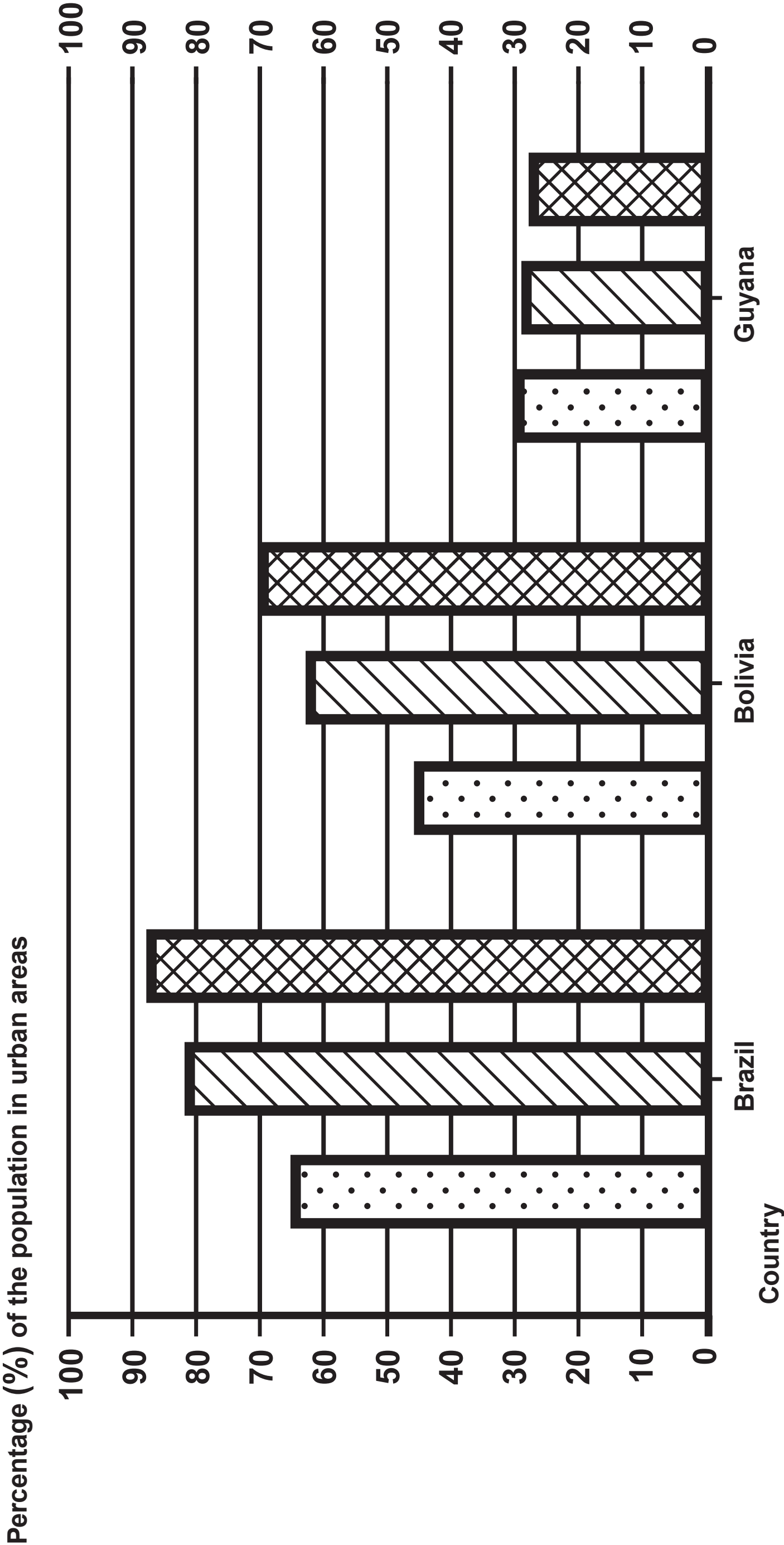

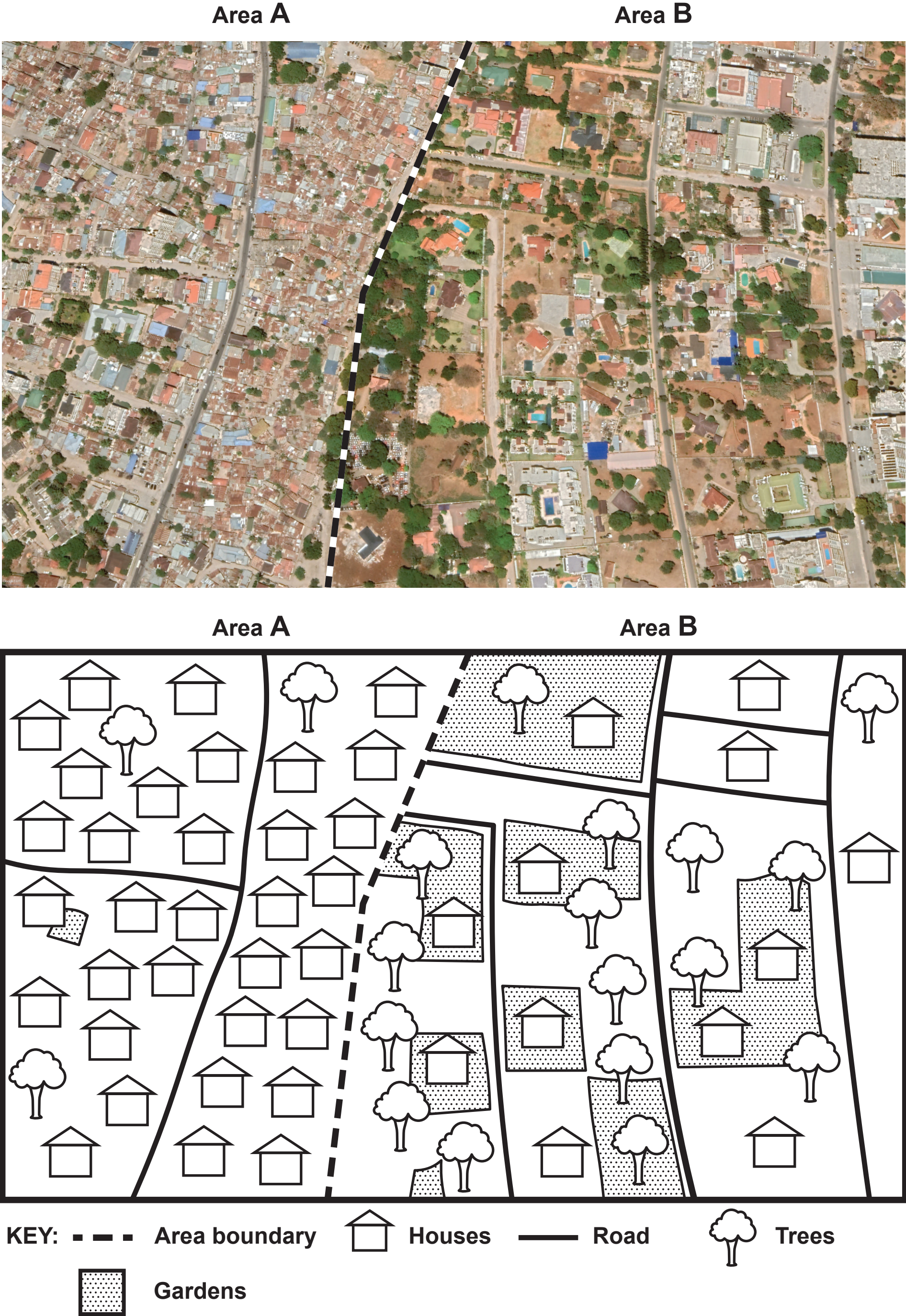

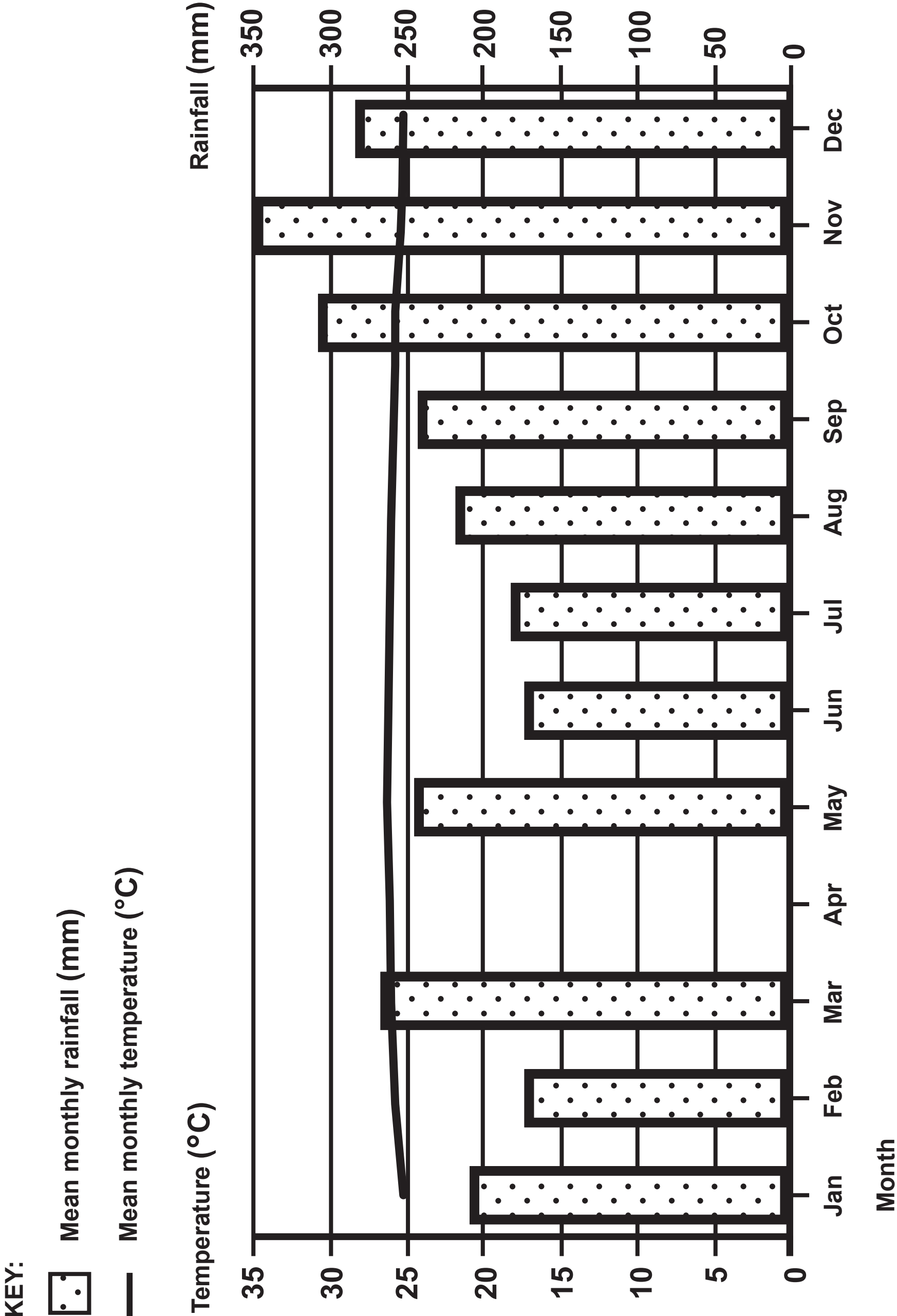

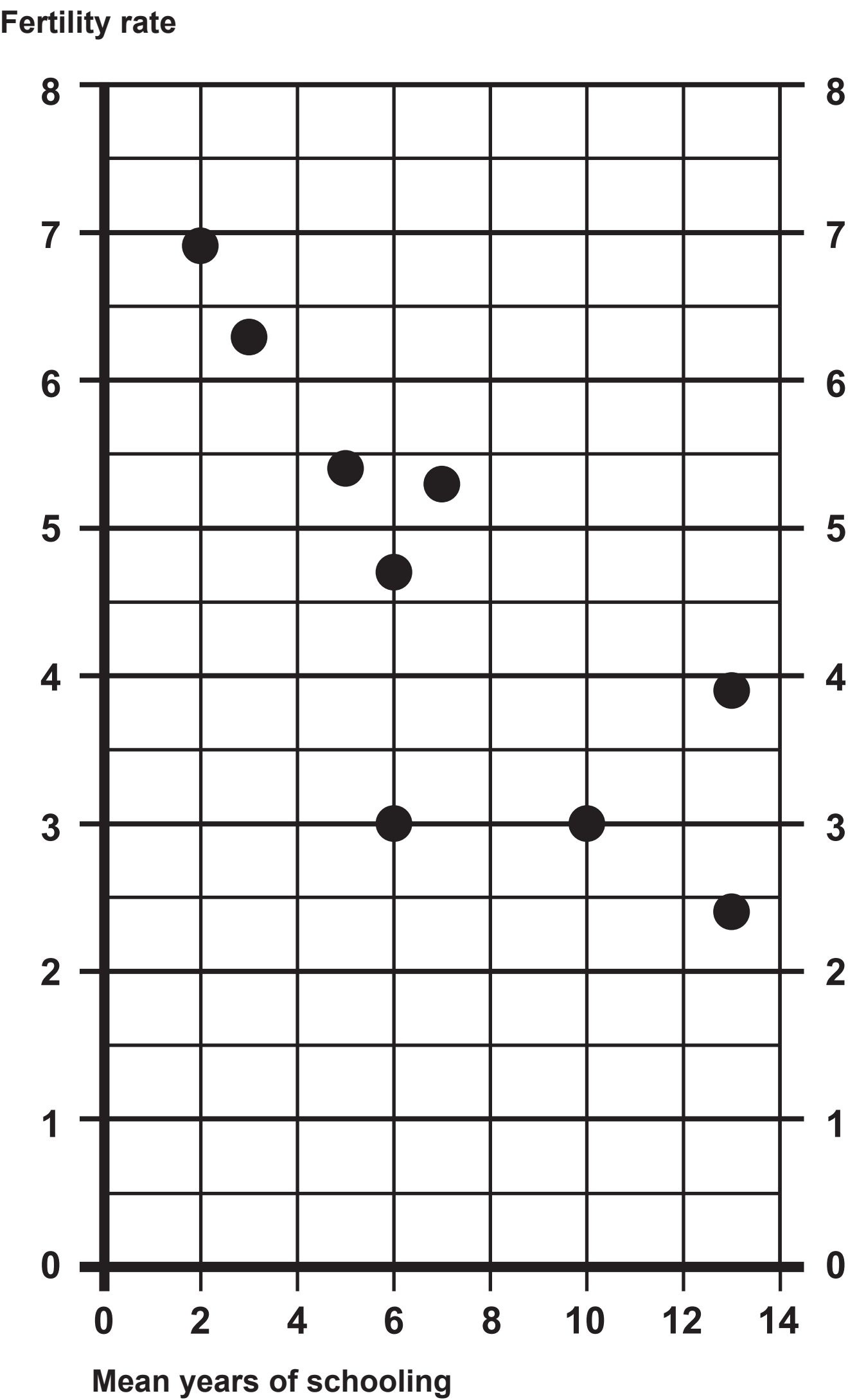
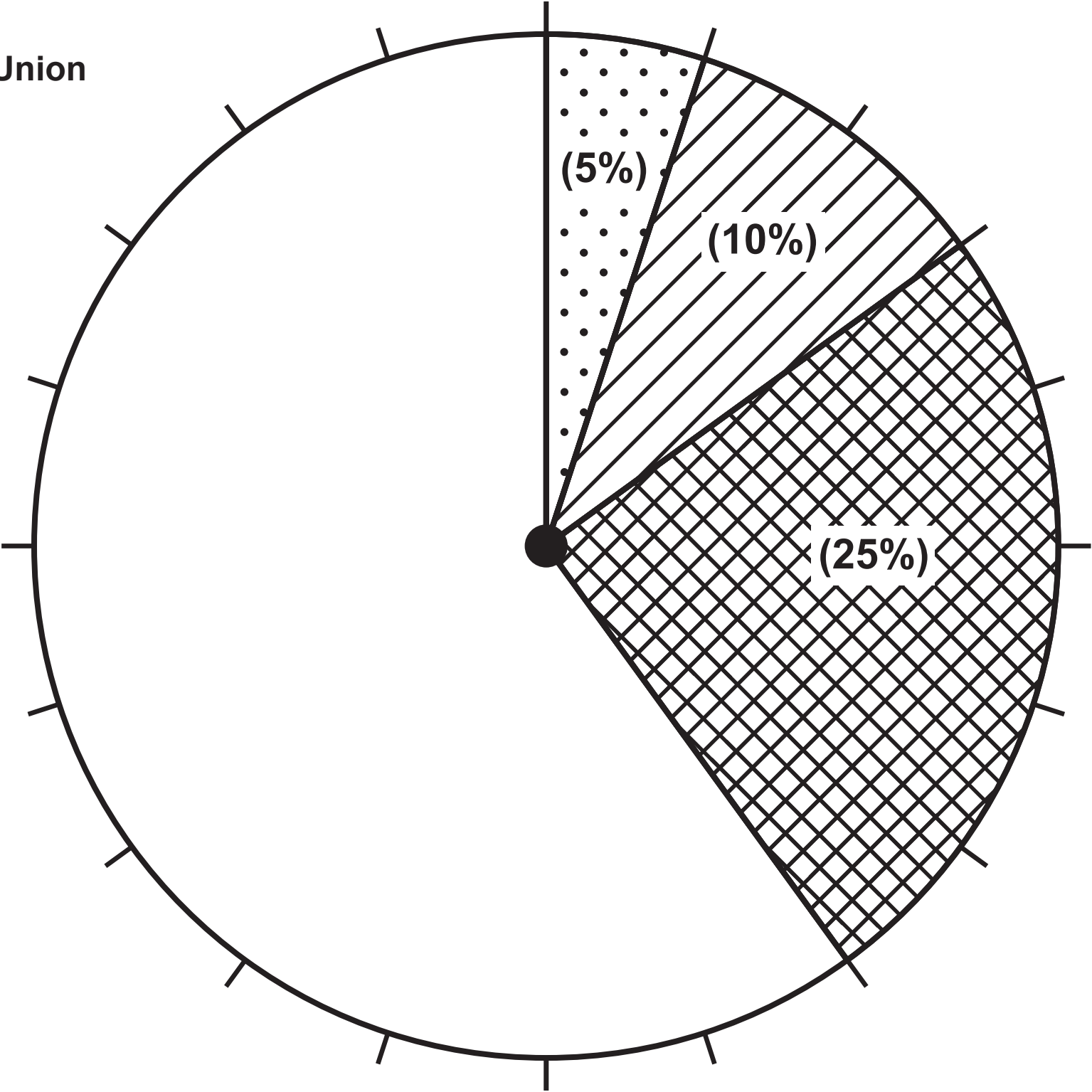
