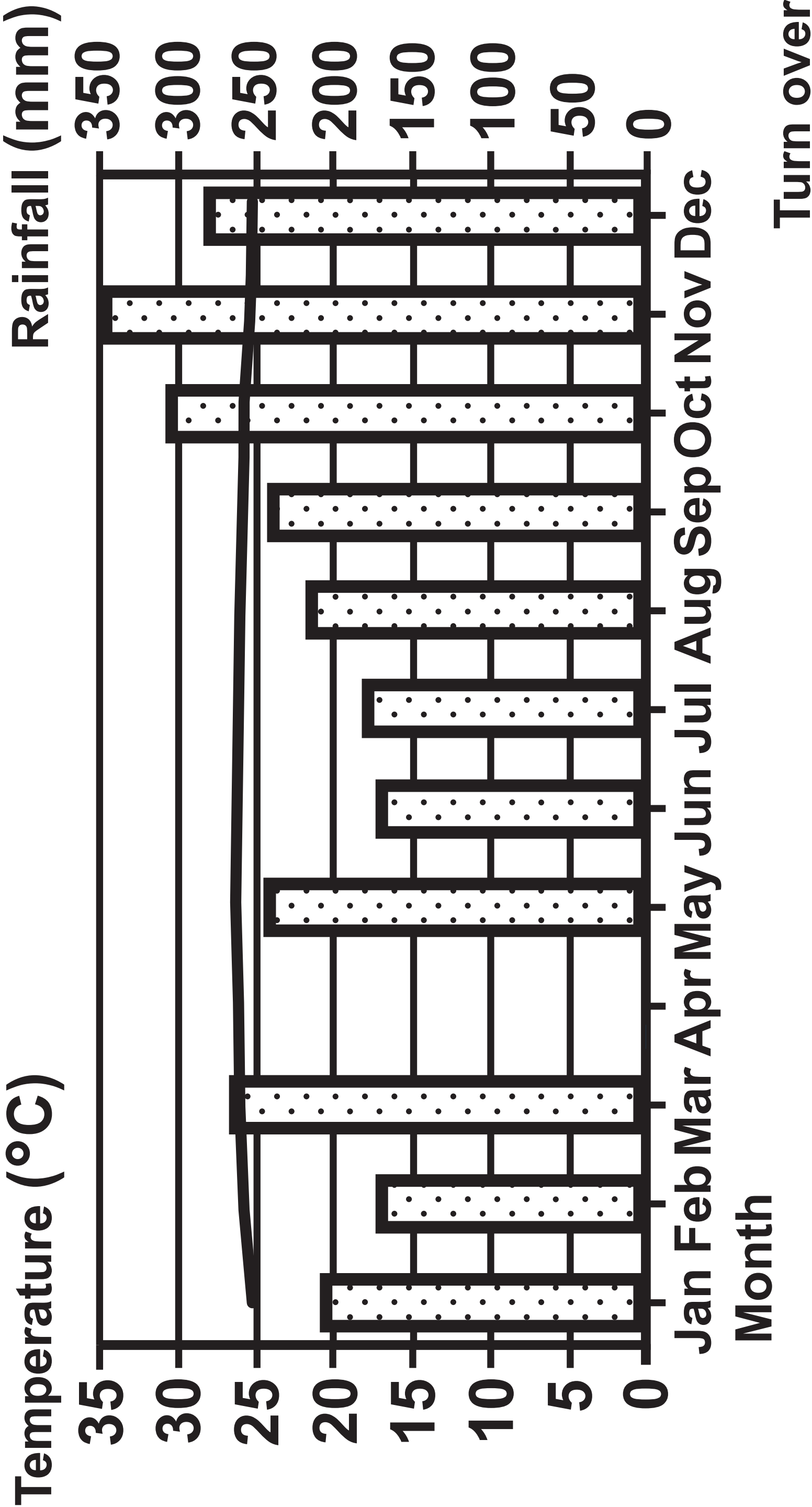

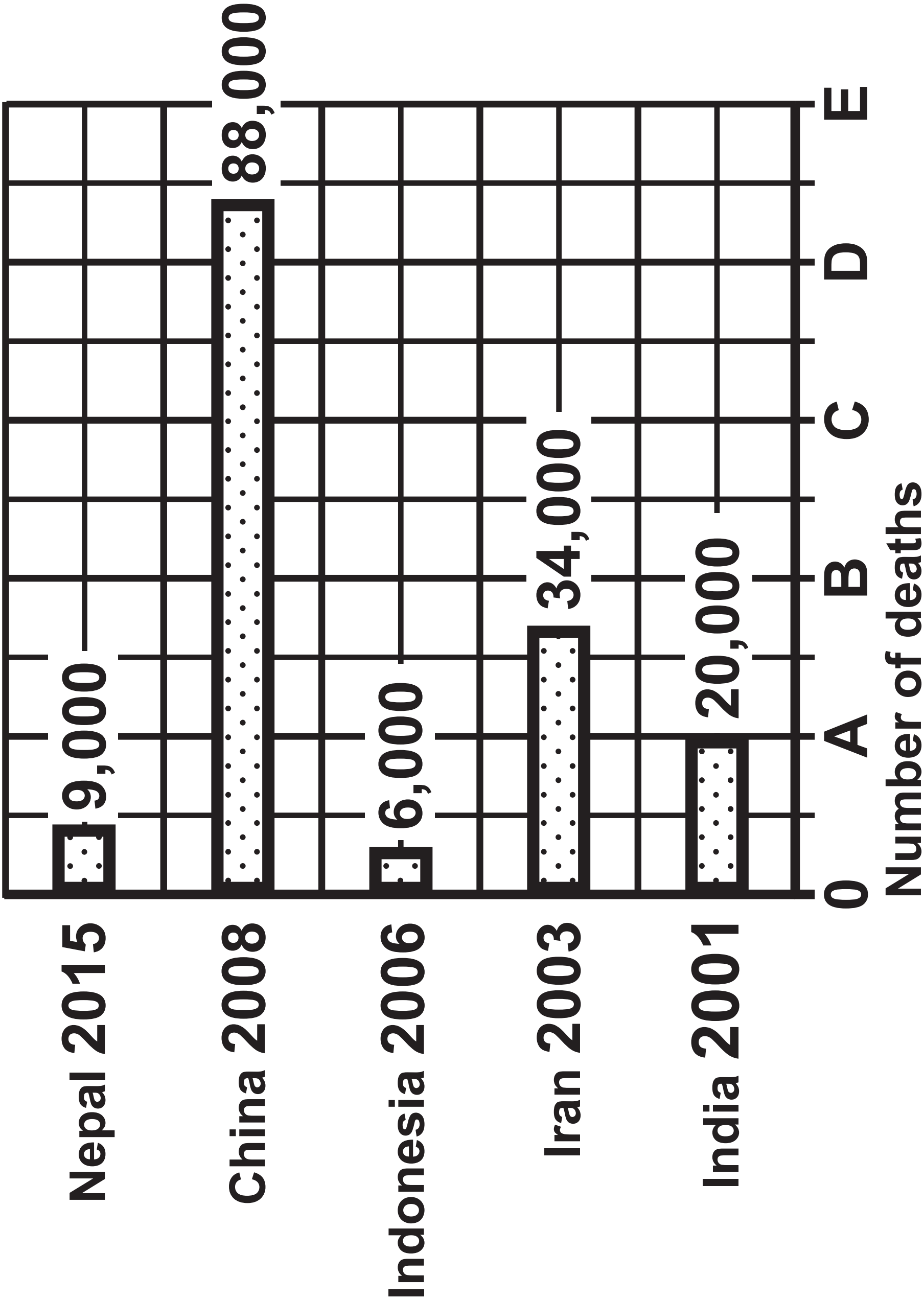
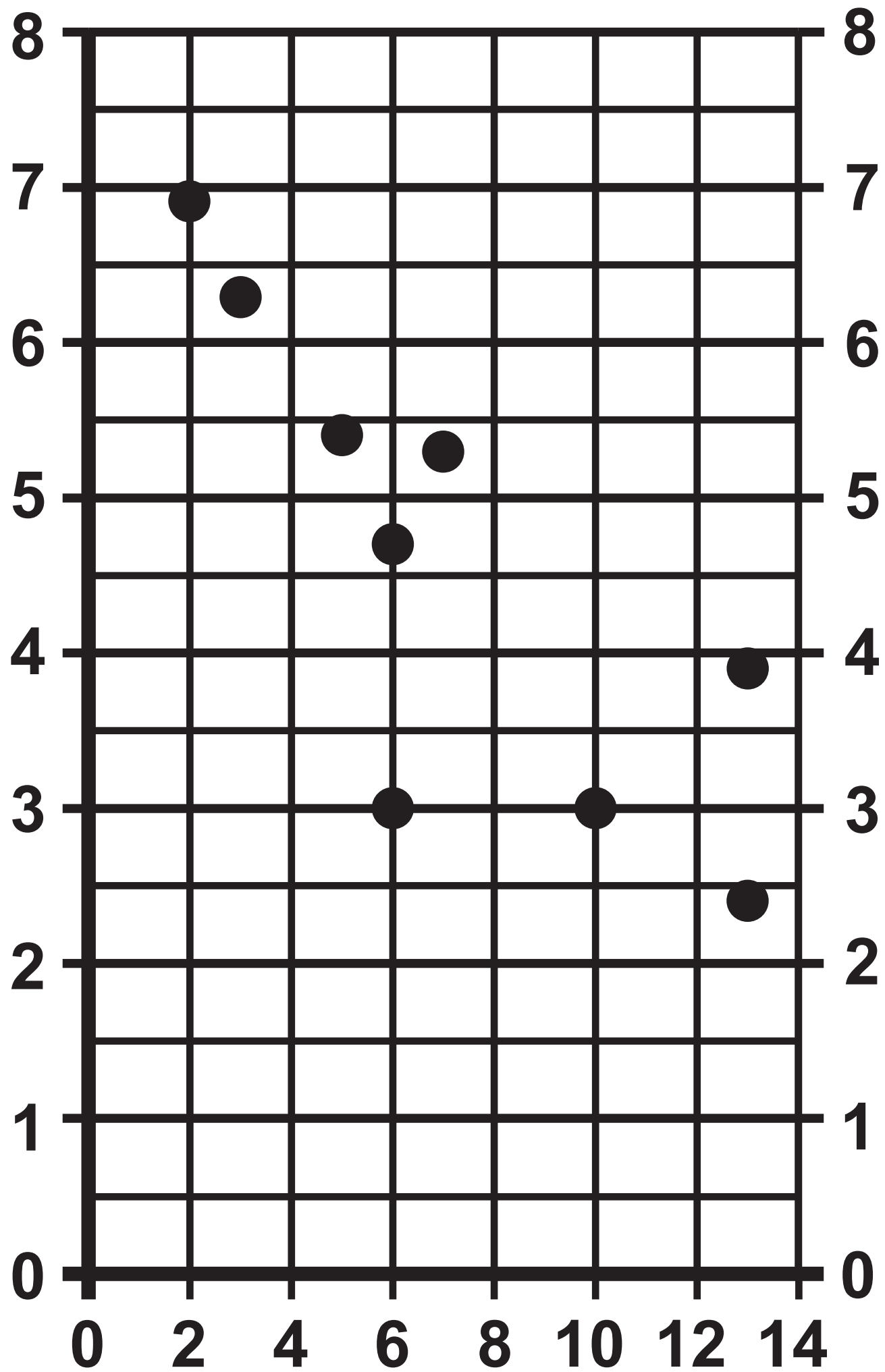

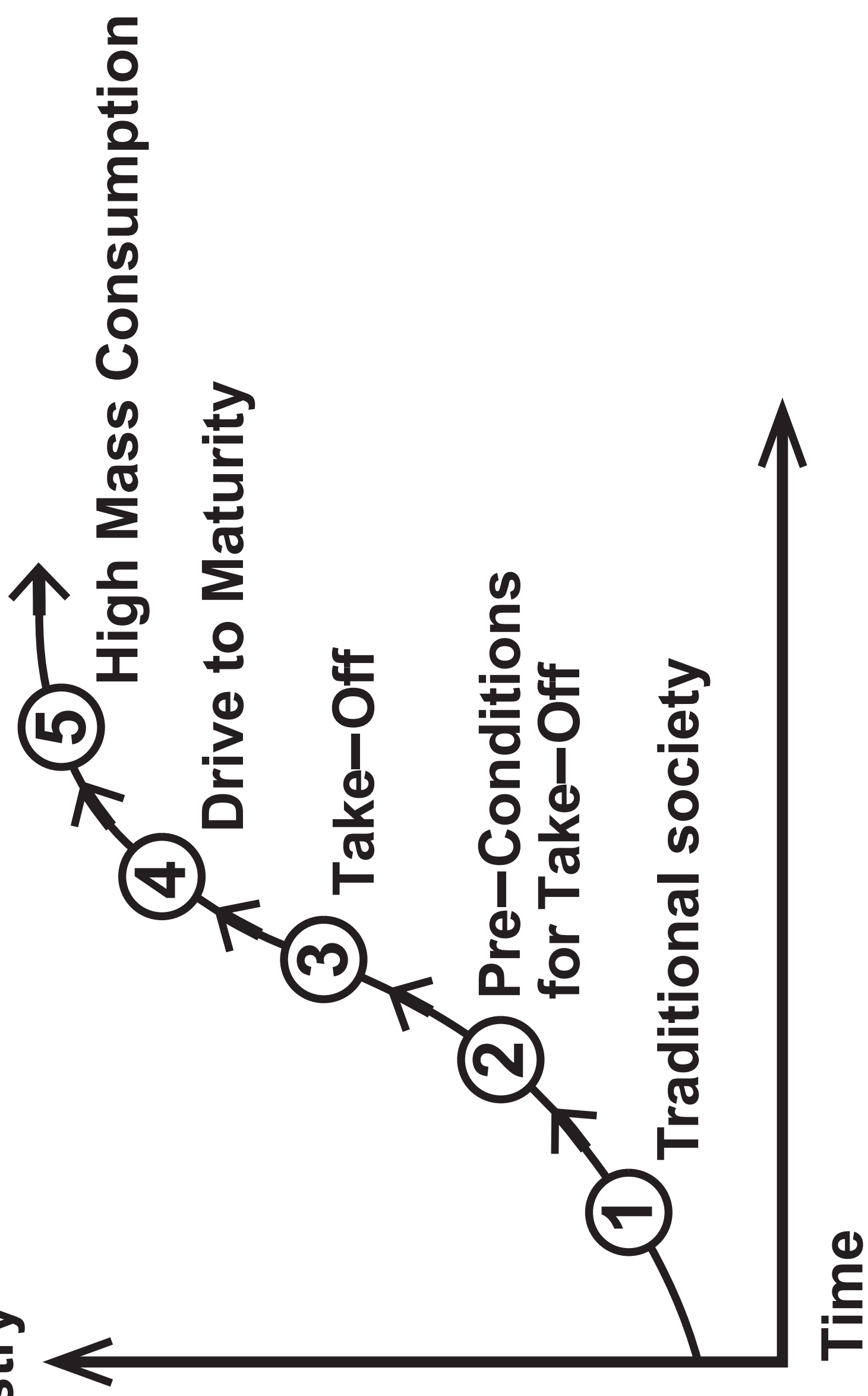

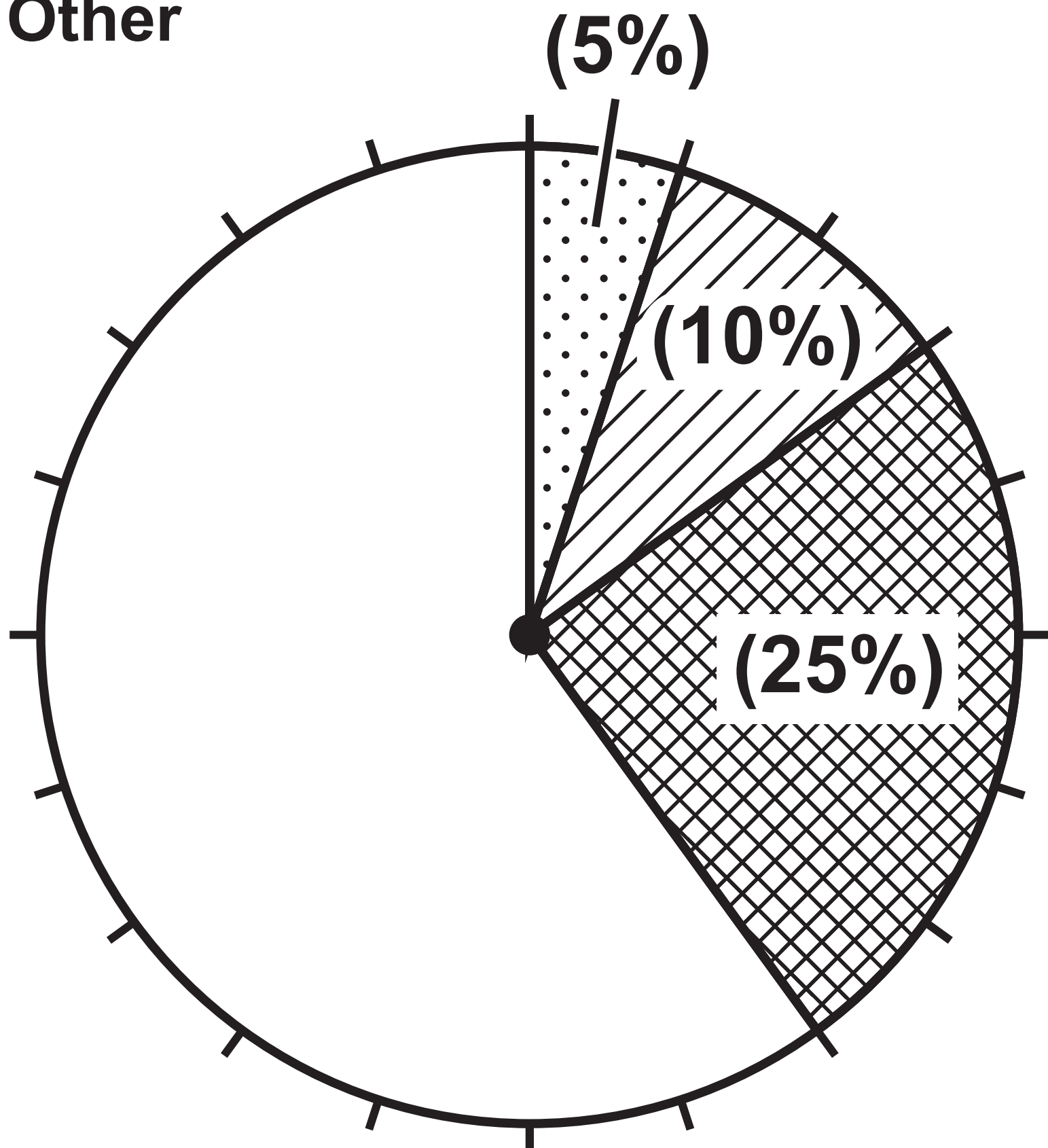

KEY: [dotted] 1980 [diagonal lines] 2000 [cross-hatch] 2020

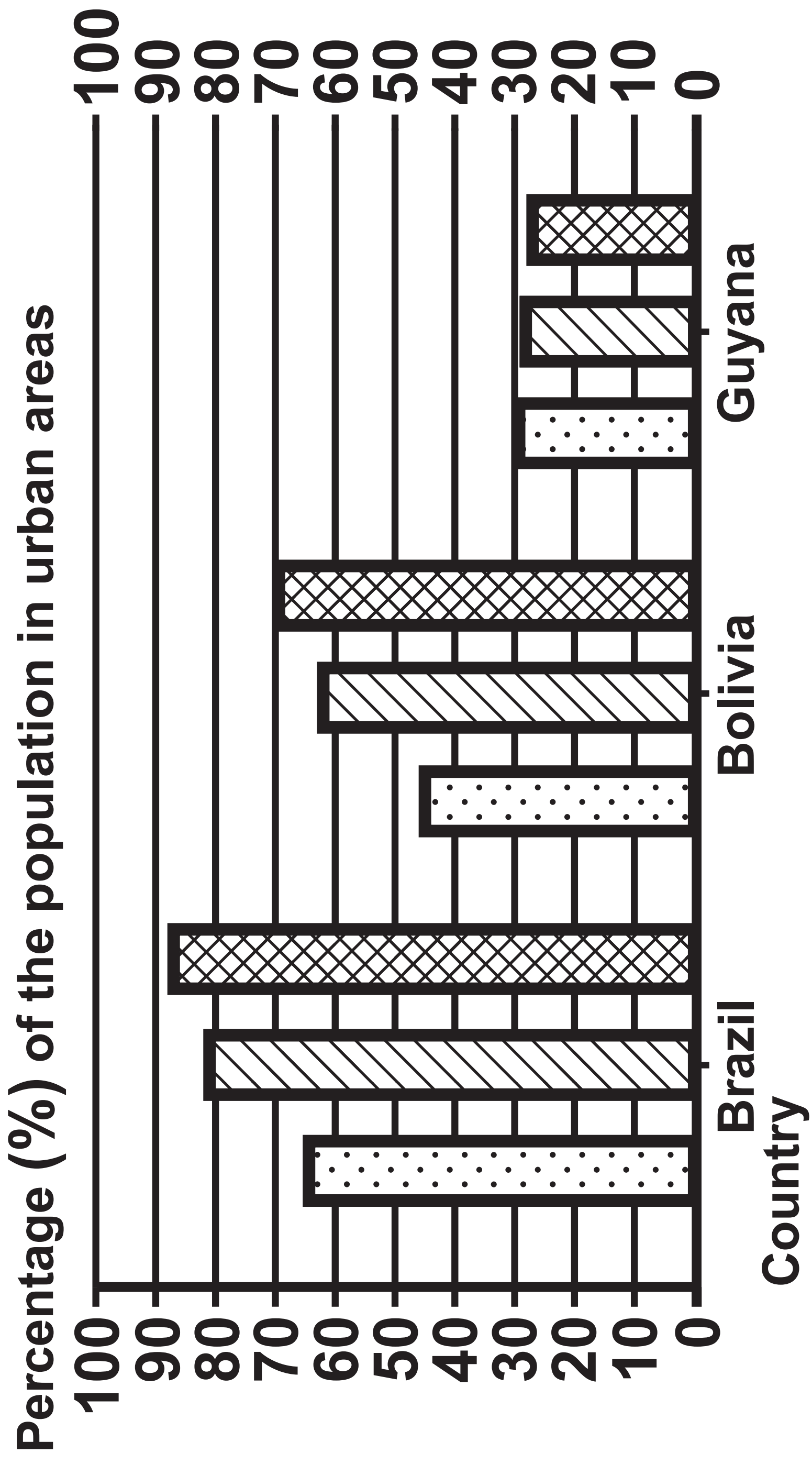

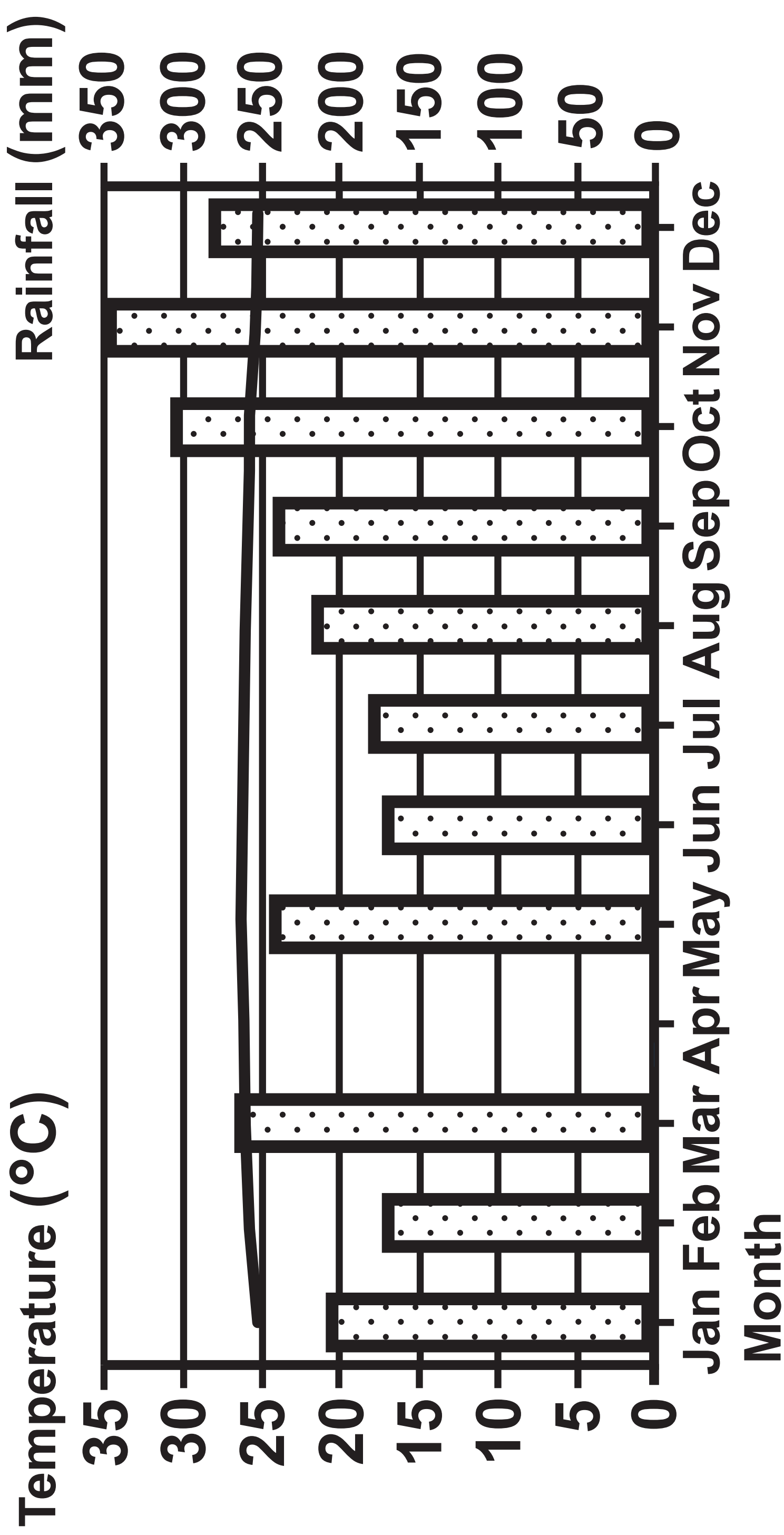
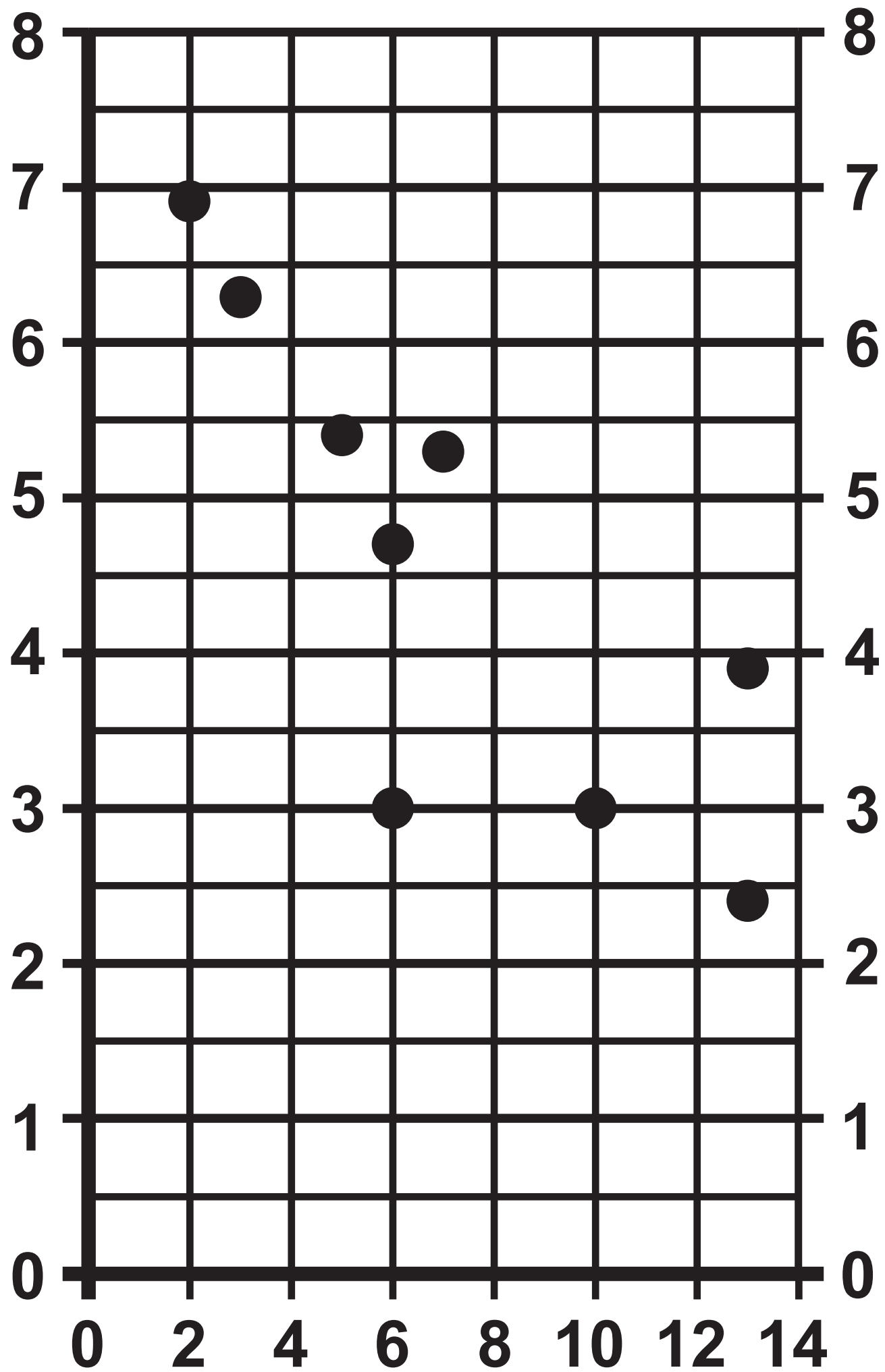

Fertility rate



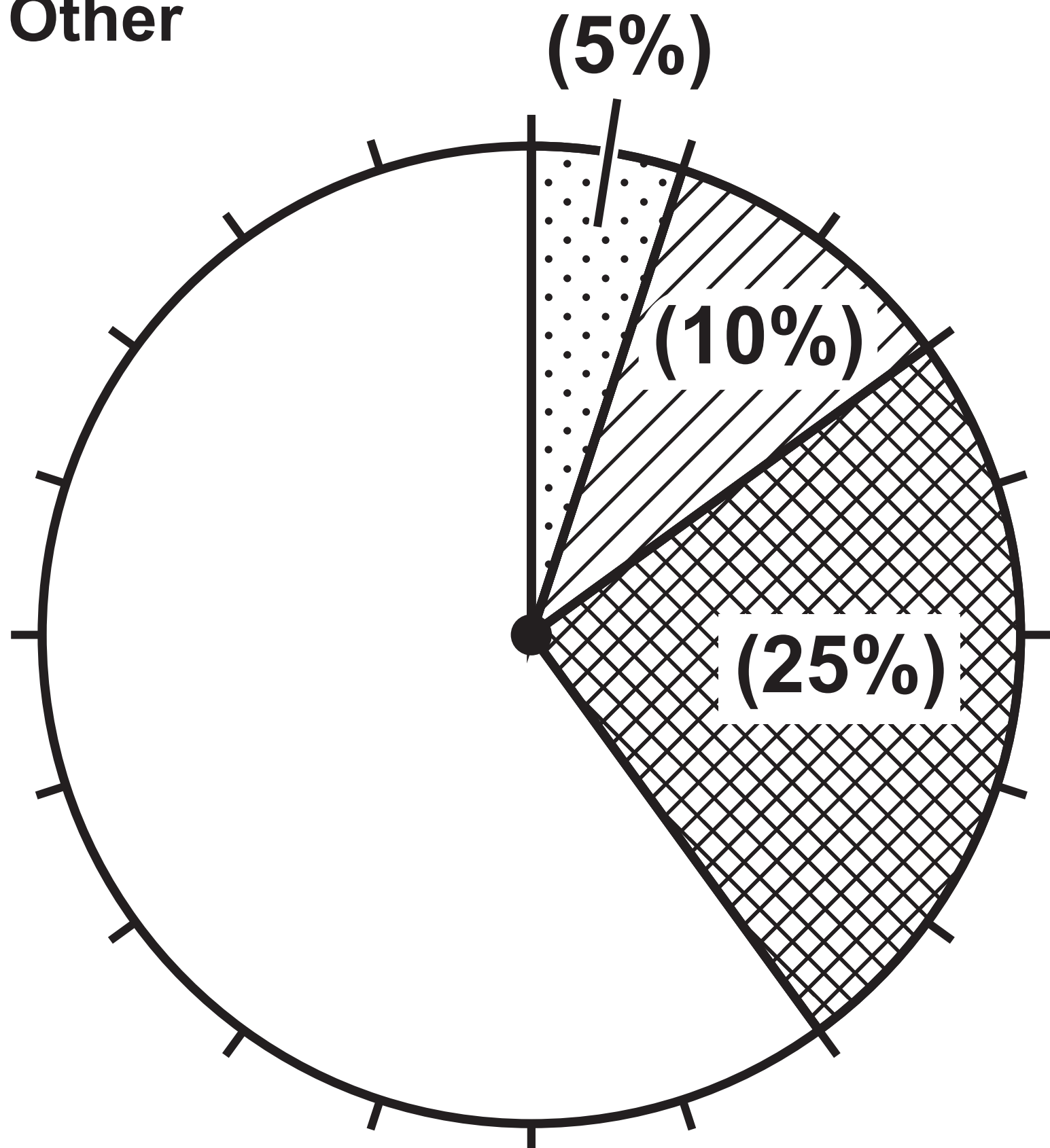
Mean years of
